TODAY'S GAME: Sugar Land evened the series at two games apiece after an 8-1 triumph last night ... Albuquerque has won five of its last seven ... Gabriel Hughes is expected to make his lsotopes and Triple-A debut after his call-up from Double-A Hartford while A.J. Blubaugh is expected to take the hill for the Space Cowboys.

TV BROADCAST: Tonight's Isotopes game will broadcast on True Crime Network, which can be found on channel 7.3 throughout the state of New Mexico and locally on Xfinity 387 and Sparklight 29... Over the remainder of the 2025 season, 12 Isotopes games will broadcast on KOAT/True Crime Network.

ONE RUN: Albuquerque plated just one run yesterday, eighth time in 2025 the club was limited to one run or fewer (last: May 13 vs. Tacoma, one run).

ONE RUN, ONE HOMER: The Isotopes' lone run last night came on a Yanquiel Fernandez solo homer, second time this season the club's only run of a game came via a dinger (other: March 29 at Sacramento, 5-1 loss, Ryan Ritter, 1st inning).

RISP: Albuquerque went 0-for-8 with runners in scoring position Friday, the 11th time in 2025 and second this series the club has not registered a hit with a runner in scoring (also: May 28, 0-for-6).

RUN DIFFERENTIAL: The Isotopes have a -11 run differential in 2025. Through May 31, 2024, the club's run differential was -135.

HOMERS ALLOWED: The lsotopes permitted three homers last night and have relented multiple homers in three-straight games (11 total). Allowed multiple homers in three-straight three times in 2025 (last: five, May 16-21).

HOMERS: The Isotopes have hit 16 homers in their last five games (seven Sunday at Reno and nine over the first four games of this series).

SERIES: Albuquerque has split the first four games of a series eight times over the club's nine six-game sets in 2025 (exception: May 20-22 at Reno, lost first three) ... The lsotopes have held a 3-2 series lead three times (last: May 13-17 vs. Tacoma).

MARGIN: Last night was the eighth time the club has lost by seven-plus runs on the year and third time against Sugar Land (also: May 28, seven, and April 13, seven).

OPPOSING STARTER: Sugar Land's Jason Alexander (6.0 IP, 1 R) tossed the eighth quality start for an opposing hurler in 2025 last night, sixth this month (last: Tommy Henry, May 22 at Reno).

RIT: Ryan Ritter extended his career-long hit streak to 15 games last night, longest active in PCL. During streak is slashing .441/.493/1.015 with nine doubles, three triples, eight homers and 22 RBI.

-Longest hit streak by an Isotope since Greg Jones (18, Aug. 25-Sept. 15, 2024).

-During hit streak leads MiLB in average, hits, total bases, homers, RBI, OPS and slugging ... Has 21-game on-base streak, second-longest active streak in PCL ... Has 11 multi-hit games in his last 14 games and team-leading 18 in 2025 ... Has an extrabase hit in 13 of his last 14 contests.

-In May, slashing .372/.438/.894 with 10 doubles, three triples, 11 homers and 26 RBI after hitting .224 over first 26 games. During month, leads PCL in OPS, slugging and total bases, tied for first in doubles and triples and second in homers, RBI and average.

KESTDADDY: Keston Hiura had his contract selected by Colorado today ... At the time of his call-up, has active 22-game on-base streak, longest active in PCL ... Had a hit in 20 of 22 games played in May ... During the month, slashed .345/.427/.726 with a triple, six doubles, eight homers and 22 RBI.

YF: Yanquiel Fernandez extended his hitting streak to 11 games with a double and eighth homer of the year last night. During stretch is slashing .432/.490/.636 with six doubles, one homer and six RBI ... Longest hitting streak since a 13-gamer from May 31-June 16, 2023, with High-A Spokane ... Has eight multi-hit games during stretch.

STERLIN: Sterlin Thompson collected his 11th multi-hit contest of the year yesterday and ninth in May. During the month, is slashing .371/.470/.686 with six doubles, two triples, four homers and 14 RBI ... Among PCL leaders during Month in OPS (2nd), OBP (2nd) and slugging (3rd) ... Has a walk in six-straight, tied for the longest streak in PCL this season.

BRAX: Braxton Fulford has a hit and extra-base hit in four-straight games ... Has a hit in 22 of 27 games started with Albuquerque.

AMADOR: Adael Amador played in his first game with Albuquerque last night since April 11 and went 0-for-4.

PCL LEADERBOARD: Ryan Ritter is 1st in runs (43) and slugging (.625), 2nd in homers (15), XBH (30), total bases (120) and OPS (1.035), T-5th in walks (33), T-6th in RBI (38) and triples (3), 7th in OBP (.410), and T-7th in hits (57) ... Warming Bernabel is T-6th in doubles (15) ... Sterlin Thompson is T-6th in triples (3).

NUCLEI NOTES

SKIPPER: Pedro Lopez enters his 21st year as a minor league manager and third guiding the Isotopes. He is the eighth manager in club history ... Spent 2021 as Albuquerque's hitting coach and 2022 as its bench coach ... Notched his 1,000th career managerial victory June 4, 2023 at Salt Lake, 7-1 ... Managed in the Texas Rangers (2001-05, 2007) and New York Mets (2011-19) organizations while claiming the 2014 Eastern League Championship with Double-A Binghamton. Lopez was drafted in the 21st round by the San Diego Padres in the 1988 MLB Draft and spent 13 years in the minor leagues, reaching Triple-A on four occasions.

CHRIS MICHALAK: Begins his third season as Isotopes pitching coach ... Pitched for the Albuquerque Dukes in 2000, followed by stints with the Isotopes in 2004 and 2008 ... Started second-to-last game in Dukes history, giving up two runs in 6.0 innings during Game 4 of a PCL First Round playoff series at Memphis Sept. 9, 2000 ... Appeared in 61 Major League games (24 starts) over five seasons with the Arizona Diamondbacks (1998), Toronto Blue Jays (2001) Texas Rangers (2001-02) and Cincinnati Reds (2006) ... 12th round selection by the Athletics in 1993 ... Has been in the coaching ranks since 2009, including stops as the pitching coach for the Hagerstown Suns (2010-11), Potomac Nationals (2012-13) and Harrisburg Senators (2018-20 and coached in the Washington Nationals organization from 2021-22.

MICHAEL RYAN: Enters his second year with the Rockies organization as the Isotopes bench coach ... The former outfielder played in 33 games for the Isotopes and hit nine homers during the 2008 campaign. He and Michalak were teammates on that squad for four days in late July ... Entered the coaching ranks in 2012 as a coach for the Double-A Altoona Curve (Pirates). He then managed in the Pirates organization at three levels for seven seasons with stops at Single-A West Virginia (2013-14), High-A Bradenton (2015-16) and Double-A Altoona (2017-19), while winning the Florida State League in 2016 and Eastern League in 2017. Ryan compiled a 221-197 managerial record with Altoona—the most wins for a manager in Curve history ... He also managed in the Cubs organization (High-A South Bend, 2021 and Double-A Tennessee, 2022-June 2023) ... A 5th round draft pick by the Minnesota Twins in 1996, played in 149 MLB games over parts of five seasons with the Twins (2002-05) and Angels (2010) ... Last Angels player to wear 27 prior to Mike Trout's call-up in 2011.

AARON MUNOZ: Takes over as Isotopes hitting coach after Jordan Pacheco was named one of two new hitting coaches for the Colorado Rockies on May 12 ... Began the 2025 season as the hitting coach for the ACL Rockies ... Spent nine seasons (2016-2024) as the Rockies bullpen catcher ... Was Isotopes bullpen catcher in 2015 ... Originally drafted by the Blue Jays in the 34th round of the MLB Draft ... Played parts of four seasons in the Minor Leagues (2011-14), making it to Double-A.

SPLIT-SEASON PLAYOFF FORMAT: For the third-straight year, the Pacific Coast League will use a split-season format to determine playoff participants. With one 10 team division, the first half winner (concluding June 22) will host the second half winner (beginning June 24) in a three-game set. The winner will then face the International League champion for the Triple-A Championship in Las Vegas, NV, on September 27.

BALLS AND STRIKES: The Challenge System, in it's third full year in the PCL, will be used exclusively for every game this season. Under this system, the home plate umpire will call balls or strikes while each team has the opportunity to challenge the umpire's call with two challenges per game, retaining one for each successful challenge.
