Today is the finale of a six-game series between the Lansing Lugnuts and the Fort Wayne TinCaps, and the sixth of 15 meetings between the two teams in 2026. Lansing went 2-4 at Fort Wayne in 2025, but has won four of the first five games of this series to clinch its first ever six-game series victory in the Summit City.

Yesterday: Lugnuts 12, TinCaps 4. **Davis Diaz** collected four of Lansing's 16 hits and **Kyle Robinson** allowed one run on two hits in five innings to lead the Nuts' second rout in a four-day span. Diaz, **Jared Sprague-Lott** and **Dylan Fien** each delivered two-run doubles while **Casey Yamauchi** went 3-for-6 with a two-run single. Alex McCoy and Jake Cunningham homered for the TinCaps in defeat.

On Deck: After a day off tomorrow, the Luggies return to Michigan's state capital to play host to archrival/defending league champion West Michigan from Tuesday, April 14, through Sunday, April 19, at Jackson Field.

Happy Birthday! Today is OF **Rodney Green, Jr.**'s 23rd birthday, a celebration he shares with former Lugnuts teammate/A's top prospect southpaw **Gage Jump**, currently excelling for Triple-A Las Vegas, and Athletics assistant general manager **Billy Owens**.

Prospecting: The Nuts have the No. 8 (**Devin Taylor**), No. 16 (**Steven Echavarria**), No. 19 (**Zane Taylor**), No. 26 (**Nate Nankil**) and No. 30 (**Bobby Boser**) prospects on MLB Pipeline's Top 30 rankings of Athletics prospects.

Milestone Watch: Lansing is 12 wins away from the 2,000th win in Lugnuts history and 4 players away from 1,000 players all-time.

Starting Strong: Lugnuts starters have a 1.06 ERA, allowing four runs in 34 innings (and just two runs in the last 33 innings).

Transaction: Outfielder **Pedro Pineda** was placed on the Temporarily Inactive List entering today's series finale.

On a Tear: C/INF **Davis Diaz** is 9-for-15 this week and is now leading the Midwest League with a .500 batting average as well as ranking 2nd in OBP (.609), tied for 2nd in runs (8, with teammate **Bobby Boser**) and 2nd in OPS (1.276). Meanwhile, INF **Casey Yamauchi** is 1st in the circuit in slugging (.778) and tied for 1st in RBI (8), 4th in OPS (1.228) and 5th in batting average (.389).

All-Around Excellence: The Lugnuts rank 1st in team ERA (2.30); 1st in fielding (1 error in 188 chances, .996); and 2nd in batting average (.259). The Nuts have outscored the opposition by 29 runs this season, thanks to topping Fort Wayne by a combined 34-8 this week.

All Aboard: Shortstop **Bobby Boser** and left fielder **Devin Taylor** have reached base in all seven Lugnuts games.

Mound Dominance: 2022 Lugnut **Mason Miller** has tossed 28 2/3 consecutive scoreless innings as the Padres' closer, the longest current streak in baseball and five innings away from tying Cla Meredith's San Diego franchise record. Miller's 79.2% strikeout rate to open the season is the highest for a pitcher through seven appearances since 1900. The Angels' **Jordan Romano** (2016 Lugnut) is off to an impressive start himself; batters are 0-for-15 with two walks against Romano in six scoreless appearances this year. The Phillies' **Tim Mayza** (2015 Lugnut) has also posted six scoreless innings, allowing just two hits and one walk while striking out nine in 7 2/3 innings.

Cooperstown Bound: 18-year-old **Carlos Beltrán** was in the very first Lugnuts starting lineup on April 5, 1996. Over the course of his ensuing 20-year career, he was voted 1999 American League Rookie of the Year, was named a nine-time All-Star, won three Gold Gloves, two Silver Sluggers, the Roberto Clemente Humanitarian Award, and the 2017 World Series. This summer, on July 27, Beltrán will be inducted into the National Baseball Hall of Fame in Cooperstown, becoming the first Lugnut to be enshrined.

Major League Nut: The 201st Lugnut to reach the Major Leagues, 2023 Lugnuts catcher **Daniel Susac**, is 6-for-8 through five games with the Giants. Susac debuted on April 1 and hit safely in his first five at-bats, setting a new Giants modern-day franchise record and coming up one shy of the Major League modern-day franchise record set by Boston OF Ted Cox in 1977. Susac was originally taken in the Rule 5 Draft by Minnesota and traded to San Francisco.

APRIL 12TH IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2010: Balbino Fuenmayor went 5-for-5 with a solo home run in a two-run eighth, and the Lugnuts overcame a 3-0 deficit for a 4-3 win at Great Lakes.

2011: Drew Hutchison made his season debut with 11 strikeouts in seven scoreless three-hit innings, and the Lugnuts wiped out a 2-1 deficit with three runs in the 9th for a 4-2 victory at South Bend.

2012: The Lugnuts win their seventh straight game to start the season, a new team record, with closer Ajay Meyer stranding the potential game-tying run at third base in a 3-2 win against West Michigan.

2018: A day after allowing eight runs in the seventh inning at Fort Wayne, the Lugnuts exploded for 11 runs in the seventh to blow out the TinCaps, 13-4. The first 12 Nuts all reached base in the inning, six against reliever Henry Henry and six against reliever Spencer Kulman, including seven walks and two Henry balks. The Nuts drew 13 walks in total. It was the third time in franchise history that the Lugnuts had scored 11 runs in an inning.
