TONIGHT'S STARTING PITCHER

RHP Patrick Copen (2-0, 1.72 ERA)

- T The 24-year-old was selected by the Los Angeles Dodgers in the 7th round of the 2023 draft out of Marshall University.
- T He is the #29 ranked prospect in the Los Angeles Dodgers organization according to MLB Pipeline.
- T In his professional career, Copen is 14-11 with a 3.40 ERA in 55 games (52 starts) while giving up 174 hits, 97 runs, 87 earned runs, 5 home runs and 150 walks with 274 strikeouts in 230.1 IP.
- T In 2025, Copen pitched for Great Lakes and Tulsa. He was a combined 4-7 with a 3.59 ERA in 27 starts while giving up 85 hits, 55 runs, 47 earned runs, 2 home runs and 84 walks with 152 strikeouts in 117.2 IP.
- T In his 17 starts for Tulsa in 2025, Copen was 1-6 with a 4.52 ERA while giving up 63 hits, 43 runs, 35 earned runs and 52 walks with 75 Ks in 69.2 IP.
- T In his three starts in 2026, Copen is 2-0 with a 1.72 ERA while giving up 10 hits, 4 runs, 3 earned runs and 9 walks with 22 Ks in 15.2 IP.
- T In his 20 career starts for Tulsa, Copen is 3-6 with a 4.01 ERA while giving up 73 hits, 47 runs, 38 earned runs, 1 HR and 61 walks with 97 Ks in 85.1 IP.
- T In his last start against Arkansas on April 17, Copen pitched 4.1 innings and gave up 7 hits, 4 runs, 3 earned runs, and 2 walks with 5 strikeouts.
- T Copen has not allowed a run in 6.1 IP on the road this season.
- T He is tied for the fifth most strikeouts in the TL with 22.
- T Copen currently ranks sixth in the TL among qualified pitchers for the lowest opponent average at .179.
- T Fourteen of Copen's 22 strikeouts have been against right-handed hitters who are batting .172 in 29 ABs. Six of his 9 walks issued have also been against right-handed hitters.
- T Copen has a 1-2 record with a 3.11 ERA in nine career starts at ONEOK Field. In his 11 Double A starts on the road, he is 2-4 with a 4.72 ERA.
- T Copen has allowed only five home runs in his professional career with three occurring in his 19 career starts with High-A Great Lakes. His lone home run allowed with Tulsa was to Wichita's Ben Ross on September 7, 2025, at Equity Bank Park.

GAMEDAY NOTES

- T The Drillers are currently on their best start since 1996, when Tulsa also started 13-4 under all-time winningest manager Bobby Jones. A win tonight will be the best start to a season in Drillers franchise history since the franchise was founded in 1977.
- T After game two's extra-innings win last night, the Drillers have a team batting average of .500 in their two extra innings played and have scored nine runs. Both lead the TL.
- T In 2025, Tulsa finished 4-2 against the RoughRiders and had a team batting average of .274 and a team ERA of 3.46.
- T Tulsa has five comeback victories this season. The Drillers are also 11-2 when scoring first and have scored first all eight road games.
- T In 25 plate appearances when trailing in a game this season, Kyle Nevin has a .455 batting average, the second best in the TL, with 10 hits, 2 HR, 10 RBI and 2 walks. Nevin has also drove in 17 runs, which is tied for the third most in the TL.
- T The Drillers pitching staff has recorded double-digit strikeouts in ten of their 17 games this season.
- T Tulsa has allowed the most runs to score in the second inning in the TL with 24 for a 12.18 ERA in that inning. San Antonio has allowed the second most with 19.
- T George is tied for the third most runs scored in the TL with 17. He is also tied for the most stolen bases in the TL with 12 and ranks second for batting average at .411. George has also recorded a hit in 11 straight games and 19 total during that span.
- T Tulsa's pitching staff has issued the second most walks in the TL with 97.
- T Tulsa's starting pitchers have recorded nine of the 17 decisions and have a 5.37 combined ERA. The relievers are 8-0 with a combined 4.07 ERA. The relievers have walked 58 hitters in 77.1 IP, and the starters have walked 39 in 68.2 IP.
- T The Drillers have a .317 team batting average against left-handed pitching, which is the highest in the TL. George (.533), Josue De Paula (.450), and Zyhir Hope (.444) are all batting over .400 against left-handed pitching.
- T Tulsa's pitching staff has held opponents to a .207 batting average for the season, the lowest in the TL.
- T De Paula and George have each driven in a run in three straight games. Joe Vertano has scored a run in four consecutive games and De Paula, George and Nevin have each scored a run in three straight games.

DRILLERS SWEEP DOUBLEHEADER— The Tulsa Drillers swept the Frisco RoughRiders with a 5-0 win in game one and a 12-6 victory in game two of Wednesday's doubleheader at Riders Field. The Drillers controlled game one thanks to Adam Serwinowski's outstanding start. The lefthander retired the first 14 hitters he faced and finished with six scoreless innings with eight strikeouts and no walks. Three of the Drillers five runs scored in the first inning on a wild pitch and a two-run single. Two more RBI singles accounted for Tulsa's final runs, hit by Kendall George and Josue De Paula. In game two, the Drillers erased a five-run deficit by scoring 11 consecutive runs. The comeback began in the fourth inning when an error and a groundout produced two runs. Tulsa tied the game in the sixth when George hit a two-RBI single and Kyle Nevin followed with an RBI double. In the eighth, the Drillers scored six more runs using two singles, a bases-loaded walk and a three-run double to secure the victory.
