LAST TIME OUT: The Cyclones were shut out for the sixth time in 2024 in Wednesday afternoon's 4-0 defeat vs. Aberdeen...RF **Nick Morabito** (2x5) and 2B **Jeffrey De Los Santos** (2x4) each registered multi-hit games for Brooklyn...LF **Kellum Clark** was 1-for-2 with 2 walks in his High-A and Cyclones debut...DH **Francisco Alvarez** went 0-for-3 with a walk in his second rehab game...C **Austin Allen** was 0-for-3 with a free pass in his first MiLB rehab outing...RHPs **Preston Johnson** (4.0 IP), **Luis Sánchez** (1), **Yaqui Rivera** (1), and **Kyle Virbitsky** (2.1) combined on the six-hit shutout for the IronBirds...C **Adam Retzbach** was a home run shy of the cycle, going 3-for-3 with a single, double, triple, and a walk.

GET YOUR NEW YORK SPORTS HERE! The Brooklyn Cyclones matchups against the Aberdeen IronBirds on Thursday and Friday will be broadcast live on SNY...The Cyclones' 16-3 defeat vs. Hudson Valley on May 23 was also aired on the Mets' flagship TV station...At the moment, the Cyclones final 2024 broadcast on SNY will take place on August 21 vs. Jersey Shore.

TURN UP THE TRUMPETS! RHP **Edwin Díaz** will be the fifth player to join the Cyclones on a Major League rehab assignment in 2024 on Thursday...C **Francisco Alvarez**, RHP **Drew Smith**, RHP **Tyler Megill**, and RHP **Sean Reid-Foley** have also appeared on Coney Island this season...The 30-year-old is expected to throw one inning...Díaz was placed on New York's 15-day injured list on May 29 with right shoulder impingement...In 20 relief appearances in 2024, the Puerto Rico native 1-1 with a 5.40 ERA (12 ER in 20.0 IP), five saves, seven walks, and 30 strikeouts...Díaz is a two-time All-Star and has taken home both the American League and National League Reliever of the Year award...The right-hander was acquired by the Mets with 2B **Robinson Canó** and cash considerations from the Seattle Mariners in exchange for RHP **Gerson Baubista**, OF **Jay Bruce**, RHP **Justin Dunn**, OF **Jarred Kelenic**, and RHP **Anthony Swarzak** on December 3, 2018...C **Austin Allen** has also joined Brooklyn from the Florida Complex League on a minor league rehab assignment...The 30-year-old signed with New York as a minor league free agent on January 16 and has appeared in 57 Major League games between the San Diego Padres and Oakland Athletics, hitting .195 (23-118) with two home runs.

YOU'LL GET NOTHING AND LIKE IT: RHPs **Dakota Hawkins** (5.0 IP), **Joey Lancillotti** (1.0), and **Joshua Cornielly** (3.0) combined on the first nine-inning no-hitter in Brooklyn Cyclones history in Tuesday's 3-0 win vs. Aberdeen...The only previous no-hitter came on August 23, 2009, when RHP **Brandon Moore** tossed a seven-inning no-no in a 5-0 win during Game 1 of a doubleheader at Aberdeen...It is just the third no-hitter in Minor League Baseball in 2024...LHP **Chayce McDermott**, RHP **Nolan Hoffman**, and RHP **Kaleb Ort** combined on a 2-0 no-hitter for Baltimore's Triple-A Norfolk on May 3 vs. Nashville...RHP **Dylan Cumming**, RHP **Nick Sinacola**, and LHP **Seth Corry** of San Francisco's High-A Eugene combined on a 4-0 no-no on April 17 vs. Vancouver...Tuesday's effort was the first no-hitter by a Mets minor league affiliate since RHP **Joander Suárez** hurled a seven-inning one on September 7 at Hartford...It was also the first nine-inning no-hitter thrown in the borough of Brooklyn since RHP **Sal Maglie** tossed a no-no for the Dodgers against the Philadelphia Phillies on September 25, 1956, at Ebbets Field.

SHUT OUT THE LIGHTS: The Cyclones' pitching staff earned its seventh shutout victory in Tuesday's 3-0 no-hit win vs. Aberdeen...On Sunday, Brooklyn earned its sixth of the season in a 7-0 triumph at Jersey Shore...The Cyclones had a season-high 23.2 consecutive scoreless innings since two out in the fifth inning on Saturday snapped on 3B **Mac Horvath's** one-out RBI single in the third inning on Wednesday...The Cyclones have shut out opponents in back-to-back games twice in 2024...Brooklyn's blanking of the BlueClaws on Sunday marked the team's first shutout since May 4's 4-0 and May 3's 2-0 wins vs. Aberdeen...The seven shutouts are tied for the most in the South Atlantic League and tied for the third-most in Minor League Baseball...In 2023, the Cyclones set a franchise record with 11 shutouts.

NECK AND NECK DOWN THE STRETCH: Including Thursday, 13 games remain in the First Half of the South Atlantic League season...The Cyclones are tied with Jersey Shore for second in the North Division...Brooklyn is 3.5 games back of first-place Greensboro...The Grasshoppers hold the lead in the division even though they did not play an in-division opponent until this week, as the Jersey Shore BlueClaws travel to North Carolina.

MARVELOUS MORABITO: OF **Nick Morabito** has been as good as any offensive player in Minor League Baseball in 2024...Morabito is fifth in Minor League Baseball in on-base percentage (.466)...He is also sixth in batting average (.348) and tied for 11th in stolen bases (25)...Since making his South Atlantic League debut on May 7, the former second-round pick is third in the league lead in steals (14) and tied for fifth in runs scored (20).

CROWN HIM! In last Wednesday's win over Jersey Shore, OF **Stanley Consuegra's** RBI double in the fourth inning made him the new Cyclones all-time hits leader (172), breaking a tie with OF **Alex Ramirez**...The 23-year-old is atop

vs. ABERDEEN: Brooklyn returns home for a six-game series against the Orioles' High-A affiliate...Aberdeen possess six of Philadelphia's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: OF **Enrique Bradfield Jr.** (5), INF **Mac Horvath** (11), LHP **Luis De León** (17), RHP **Jackson Baumeister** (18), RHP **Carter Baumler** (28), and C **Creed Willems** (29)...The Cyclones captured the first meeting at Maimonides Park, winning 4-of-6...In 2023, Brooklyn went 7-5 against Aberdeen on Coney Island and 3-3 at Leidos Field...Dating back to 2002, Brooklyn leads the all-time series since 2021, 131-116 (.530).

the Cyclones' ranks in numerous other offensive categories as well, including extra-base hits (78), home runs (35), and RBI (114)...He is also one double (37) from matching Ramirez's franchise mark (38)...On the final day of the 2023 regular season, he broke a tie with C **Francisco Alvarez** for Brooklyn's single-season home run record (23)...Consuegra also surpassed Alvarez (22) for the franchise record in career home runs on August 23 at Asheville...The Dominican native also broke the franchise's single-season record for extra-base hits (42) and tied the mark for RBI (63) set by **Ronny Mauricio** in 2021.

SUPER STANLEY: Not only did OF **Stanley Consuegra** set the franchise hit record last Wednesday afternoon, the 23-year-old is in the midst of his best offensive stretch of the season...Consuegra is on an eight-game on-base streak and has a hit in 14 of his last 16 games since May 17 at Bowling Green...During that time, he's hitting .304/.418/.714 with a 1.132 OPS during that time...The Dominican native has scored 12 runs and added five doubles, six home runs, and 13 RBI...Consuegra has raised his batting average by 46 points (.171 to .217) and his OPS by 215 points (.519 to .734) during the stretch.

START ME UP: The Cyclones' starting rotation has been one of the best in Minor League Baseball in 2024...Brooklyn holds the best ERA for starting pitchers in the South Atlantic League at 2.85...The Cyclones have the only starting staff with a sub-3.00 ERA in the circuit and hold a mark 0.48 runs better than the next team (Aberdeen; 3.33)...That ERA is also second at the High-A level and fifth among full-season MiLB squads...Arizona's High-A Hillsboro holds the best mark in the minors and the level (2.30).

HOME COOKING: The Cyclones enter play on Saturday with a 17-9 record at Maimonides Park, but a 11-16 record in opposing ballparks...So far in 2024, Brooklyn is a perfect 4-0 in home series...The 'Clones haven't lost a home series since Hudson Valley took four of six from August 15-20, 2023...Brooklyn holds the sixth-best home ERA (2.53) in Minor League Baseball...Arizona's High-A Hillsboro (2.27) has the lowest mark at the High-A level, while Texas' Single-A Down East leads MiLB (2.16)...In visiting parks, the Cyclones' ERA is 4.80.

BUZZIN' ON THE BOARDWALK: INF **Wilfredo Lara** and INF **Junior Tilién** are heating up over the last few weeks...In his last 14 games since May 19, Lara is hitting .286/.375/.469 with an .844 OPS, adding a double, a triple, two home runs, and seven RBI...Tilién enters Wednesday on a team-season-long 15-game on-base streak since Game 2 of May 16's doubleheader at Bowling Green...The 20-year-old has posted a .259/.379/.333 line with a .712 OPS, adding four runs scored, two doubles, a triple, four RBI, and 10 walks...The 15-game streak is Brooklyn's longest since INF **William Lugo** reached in 18-straight from August 23, 2023, until April 6, 2024.

LARRUPIN' LORUSSO: INF **Nick Lorusso** has quietly been one of the top hitters in the South Atlantic League in 2024...Amongst South Atlantic League batters, Lorusso tied for third in triples (3), ninth in slugging (.491), tied for eighth in RBI (27), and tied for ninth in extra-base hits (19)...The Connecticut native saw his season high 11-game hitting streak come to an end in last Friday's loss...During the streak the ninth-round selection slashed .318/.423/.659/1.082...In that time, Lorusso added a double, a triple, four home runs, and eight RBI...The 11-game hit streak was the longest for a Cyclone in 2024 and the best since INF **Jett Williams** hit in 12-straight contests from August 12-25, 2023.

ATOP THE HEJ-ES: RHP **Josh Hejka** earned his first save of the season on May 5 vs. Aberdeen, making his Cyclones' franchise-record-setting 48th pitching appearance in the process...The 27-year-old broke a tie with **Hunter Parsons** (47) for the most pitching appearances in Cyclones franchise history...In his 56 career outings for Brooklyn since 2019, Hejka has accumulated a 5-1 record with a 2.46 ERA (25 ER in 91.1 IP) and 5 saves, walking just 22 and striking out 79.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline...The 'Clones have three of the Top 30 per BA: **Kade Morris** (21), **Jonah Tong** (22) and **Calvin Ziegler** (29)...Ziegler is currently on the full-season injured list...Plus four of the Top 30 per MLB: Tong (20), Ziegler (23), **Wilfredo Lara** (24), and OF **Nick Morabito** (26).

LAST TIME OUT: Picked up his second-straight victory on May 25 vs. Hudson Valley...Did not allow a run on two hits over a career-high-tying 6.0 innings...Issued one walk and struck out a career-high 13...Charged with three balks...Tossed 90 pitches and 62 strikes (68.89%)...Relieved by RHP **Dakota Hawkins** to start the top of the seventh with the Cyclones leading 7-0...Brooklyn went on to defeat the Renegades, 7-3.

PROSPECT RADAR: After a stellar 2023 season, De La Cruz was deemed the New York Mets' No. 39 prospect entering the 2024 campaign by *Baseball America*.

FELIP-IN' AMAZIN': The 23-year-old celebrated his birthday by shutting out Hudson Valley on May 25 over 6.0 innings with a career-high 13 strikeouts...De La Cruz was one shy of the single game Brooklyn franchise record of 14 set by LHP **Mike Cox** (8/25/01 vs. HV) and RHP **Brad Holt** (7/24/08 vs. VER)...He was the first Cyclone to strike out 13+ hitters in a single contest since RHP **Rob Gsellman** accomplished the feat on August 24, 2013, at Vermont...De La Cruz is the sixth Cyclones pitcher ever to hit the 13 punchout threshold and the third to strikeout 13 or more in 6.0 or fewer innings... Among South Atlantic League pitchers with 40.0+ innings of work, the southpaw is sixth in ERA (2.68).

WELCOME TO BROOKLYN: The 22-year-old joined the Cyclones from Single-A St. Lucie last year on August 22 and thrived over three starts...De La Cruz accumulated a 2-1 record with a 2.45 ERA (5 ER in 17.0 IP) with five walks and 17 strikeouts...The southpaw hurled quality starts in two of his three starts, including going all six innings in the lid-lifter of a doubleheader on August 31 at Greenville...After allowing a leadoff home run, De La Cruz retired 18 of the final 19 batters he faced, including sitting the last 11 down in order...The southpaw was credited with a complete game, the first for a Brooklyn pitcher since RHP **José Butto** accomplished the feat, tossing six innings in a seven-inning loss at Aberdeen in Game 1 of a twinbill on June 30, 2021...After making his SAL debut on August 23 at Asheville, De La Cruz ranked third in the circuit in WHIP (0.94), fifth in batting average against (.183), and sixth in ERA (2.65).

FLORIDA STATE FELIPE: De La Cruz was among the best strikeout artists in the Florida State League in 2023... Among FSL pitchers with 90.0 or more innings pitched, the 22-year-old led the circuit in strikeout rate (28.7%)...The southpaw also led the league in strikeouts-per-9 innings (11.36) and swinging strike rate (15.5%), while ranking 2nd in xFIP (3.68)...In 21 appearances (19 starts) with St. Lucie, De La Cruz was 3-6 with a 4.68 ERA (47 ER in 90.1 IP), 41 walks, and 114 strikeouts.
