**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels lost to the Erie SeaWolves, 5-3. Erie opened the scoring with a solo homer by Drew Ward in the bottom of the second inning and added a second run in the fourth with an RBI double by Dane Myers. The Flying Squirrels tied the game, 2-2, in the fifth with a two-run single by **Diego Rincones**. Kerry Carpenter gave the SeaWolves a 4-2 lead with a two-run double in the fifth. The Flying Squirrels closed the score to 4-3 in the top of the eighth with a sac fly by **Heath Quinn**, but Dillon Dingler pushed the lead back to two runs with a solo homer in the bottom of the inning. Richmond starter **Matt Frisbee** allowed four runs (two earned) over 5.2 innings with seven strikeouts.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels play the third of a six-game series against the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. Richmond has gone 31-36 against Southeast Division opponents this season, including a 14-17 mark on the road. This series is the last set of the 2021 season. The Flying Squirrels hosted the SeaWolves at The Diamond from August 17-22 and went 5-1, winning the final five games. The Flying Squirrels had won six straight games against the SeaWolves prior to Wednesday's loss. Today marks the latest into the calendar the Flying Squirrels have ever played a regular-season game.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have won 12 of the last 18 games since August 18. They are in fourth place in the six-team Double-A Northeast Southwest Division, 12.0 games behind first-place Akron. For the season, the Richmond offense is ranked eighth in the league with a .239 batting average. The pitching staff is ranked third in the league with a 3.98 ERA for the season.

**THE SEAWOLVES** have lost six of the last 10 games. They went 2-3 in last week's series at Altoona. The Erie offense is ranked fourth in the league with a .252 batting average and third with 148 homers. The Erie pitching staff is ranked seventh in the league with a 4.35 ERA. Erie's roster includes six of MLB.com's top-30 prospects, including C Dillon Dingler (No. 4), RHP Reese Olson (No. 11), LHP Joey Wentz (No. 13), OF Daniel Cabrera (No. 16), INF Andre Lipcius (No. 22) and RHP Beau Brieske (No. 27).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Right-hander **Aaron Blair** makes his ninth start for the Flying Squirrels and his third against the SeaWolves. He last pitched last Friday at The Diamond against Akron and allowed four runs over 4.1 innings in a no-decision, the highest run total surrendered by Blair since August 11. He made two starts against the SeaWolves at The Diamond during the previous series between the two teams. On August 17, he worked 5.0 innings and allowed one run in the series opener. In the series finale on August 22, he pitched five innings and allowed two runs with seven strikeouts. In his two starts against the SeaWolves this season, Blair is 0-0 with a 2.70 ERA (3 ER/10.0 IP) and 12 strikeouts. Blair began the season with the independent West Virginia Power and had his contract selected by the San Francisco Giants on July 23. He made his first start of the year on May 29 against Southern Maryland, picking up a win after allowing one run over 5.0 innings with six strikeouts. He began a start on June 3 against Long Island but left in the first inning with an injury before the game was suspended for rain. Blair was the 36th-overall pick in the 2013 MLB Draft by the Arizona Diamondbacks out of Marshall University, the highest draft pick in the school's history. He was traded to the Atlanta Braves in December 2015 along with Dansby Swanson and Ender Inciarte for pitchers Shelby Miller and Gabe Speier. Blair reached the majors for the first time in 2016 with the Braves. He missed most of the 2018 season and all of 2019 after undergoing shoulder surgery. He signed with the Arizona Diamondbacks in 2020 but was released in May after the MiLB season was canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic. **For more on Blair, see page two.**

**FOR ERIE:** Right-hander Beau Brieske makes his eighth Double-A start and his second against the Flying Squirrels. He pitched last Friday at Altoona and allowed two runs on eight hits in 5.1 innings in a no-decision. Brieske pitched at The Diamond against the Flying Squirrels on August 19 and was charged with a loss after allowing two runs in 5.0 innings with eight strikeouts, but Akeel Morris and the Richmond bullpen held the SeaWolves to one run. Brieske was drafted by the Tigers in the 27th round in 2019 out of Colorado State Pueblo. He began this season with High-A West Michigan and went 6-3 with a 3.45 ERA in 13 starts, earning High-A Central Pitcher of the Week honors twice. He was promoted to Double-A Erie on July 27.

**WINNING WAYS:** The Flying Squirrels need to pick up one more win to clinch their first winning season since 2015. That year, **Jose Alguacil** led Richmond to a 72-68 record. The Flying Squirrels have posted a winning record three times, including 2011 (76-66), 2014 (79-63) and 2015.

**BIG FLIES IN BUNCHES:** The Flying Squirrels have hit 40 homers in the last 24 games since August 10. In that stretch, **David Villar** has nine homers, **Diego Rincones** has six home runs, **Sandro Fabian** has five, **Frankie Tostado**, **Brandon Martorano** and **Jacob Heyward** have three, **Andres Angulo**, **Will Wilson** and **Heath Quinn** have two and **Vince Fernandez**, **Shane Matheny**, **Mitchell Tolman**, **Luis Basabe** and **Simon Whiteman** each have one. All but one active Richmond position player have homered in that span.

**POWER SURGE:** This season, the Flying Squirrels rank fifth in the Double-A Northeast with 123 home runs. On August 24, **Andres Angulo** hit the team's 110th home run of the season, breaking the previous franchise record of 109 from 2013. This year, the team has combined for a .403 slugging percentage, which is sixth in the league but would be the highest in the franchise's history (Ahead of a .382 mark from 2013). The Flying Squirrels hit 61 homers in home games at The Diamond this year, the most in franchise history.

**LEAVING THE YARD:** The 2021 Flying Squirrels have seven players who have reached double-digits in home runs this season, including **David Villar** (20), **Vince Fernandez** (14), **Sandro Fabian** (14), **Frankie Tostado** (13), **Jacob Heyward** (11), **Heliot Ramos** (10) and **Diego Rincones** (10). Seven players with 10 or more homers is a new franchise record, surpassing the 2013 season, which included **Jarret Parker** (18), **Adam DuVall** (17), **Javier Herrera** (16), **Andrew Susac** (12) and **Mark Miniccozzi** (10).

**BACK IN THE SWING OF THINGS:** On August 12 at Bowie, Villar snapped a season-high stretch of 25 games without a homer. In his last 22 games since August 12, **David Villar** is batting .388 (31-for-80) with nine homers, 10 doubles and 25 RBIs. Last Wednesday, he hit his 19th home run on the season, surpassing **Jarrett Parker** (2013) and **Mario Lisson** (2014) for the most home runs in a season in franchise history. He added his 20th on Tuesday at Erie. He is the first Giants' Double-A player to hit 20 home runs in a season since Adam Witter in 2008 with the Connecticut Defenders. Villar's nine-game hit streak was snapped on Wednesday. During the streak, he hit .389 (14-for-36) with four homers, four doubles and 16 RBIs.

**FABULOUS FABIAN:** Over the last 23 games since August 10, **Sandro Fabian** is hitting .315 (29-for-92) with five homers and 23 RBIs. He has 14 home runs this year, which is a new career high. Fabian has picked up 20 RBIs over the last 20 games since August 14, with multiple RBIs in six of those contests. He hit his 14th home run of the year on Tuesday, moving him into a tie with **Vince Fernandez** for second on the team this year.

**GO, DIEGO, GO!** Over his last 41 games since July 17, **Diego Rincones** is batting .325 (49-for-151) with 10 homers, eight doubles, one triple and 31 RBIs. Over his last 30 games since August 3, Rincones is batting .345 (40-for-116) with six homers, seven doubles and 20 RBIs. He has 13 multi-hit performances in his last 30 games played. He added a walk-off single on August 20 to cap a three-run bottom of the ninth for the Flying Squirrels in a 7-6 win over the SeaWolves. On Tuesday, he hit his 15th overall homer of the season (10 with Richmond).

**TAKE A WALK:** In 2019, **Jacob Heyward** set the single-season franchise record with 80 walks, surpassing the previous mark held by **Mark Miniccozzi**, who walked 62 times in 2013. Heyward has walked 33 times this season. For his career with the Flying Squirrels, Heyward has worked 113 walks, which sits him in tied for first in the team's history in career walks with **Ricky Orpessa**, who walked 113 times in his four seasons with Richmond from 2013-2016.

**IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS:** **David Villar** is ranked 12th with a .279 batting average, tied for seventh with 20 home runs, sixth with a .380 OBP, fifth with a .512 SLG, fifth with an .892 OPS, tied for fourth with 104 hits, sixth with 27 doubles, tied for eighth with 46 walks, fifth with 47 extra-base hits, third with 191 total bases and fourth with 68 runs scored. **Frankie Tostado** is eighth with 61 RBIs. **Vince Fernandez** is tied for seventh with four triples. **Simon Whiteman** is tied for 10th with 17 stolen bases. **Trenton Toplikar** is eighth with a 5.08 ERA. Toplikar and **Michael Plassmeyer** are tied for ninth with 84 strikeouts. **Patrick Ruotolo** (38/3rd), **Joey Marciano** (37/T-4th), and **Frank Rubio** (36/T-7th) are in the top-10 in the league in games pitched. **Patrick Ruotolo** is tied for third with 10 saves.

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Flying Squirrels have three players included in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects: **Will Wilson** (10), **Diego Rincones** (23) and **R.J. Dabovich** (30). **Simon Whiteman** is rated by *Baseball America* as being the "Fastest Baserunner" in the Giants system and Rincones is rated as having the "Best Outfield Arm." Wilson (15) is also ranked in MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospects.
