**CAPRA SLAM POWERS FISHER CATS:** Vinny Capra hit a grand slam in the bottom of the third inning to power the Fisher Cats to a 5-1 victory over Binghamton last night. In the third, Chris Bec reached on an error before Reggie Pruitt and Tanner Kirwer singled. With one out and the bases loaded, Capra hit the second pitch of his at bat into the Samuel Adams Brewhouse, recording his tenth home run of the season and first grand slam while making the score 4-0. Johnny Barbato got the start for New Hampshire, and only allowed one hit through three innings. Brandon Eisert (W, 1-0) entered in the beginning of the fourth and struck out four batters while also allowing only hit in two innings of relief. Connor Law allowed an unearned run in the sixth and Marcus Reyes and Graham Spraker finished up. Nick Podkul ripped an RBI single in the eighth to make it 5-1.

**2022 SCHEDULE RELEASE:** The Fisher Cats released their 2022 schedule, featuring home matchups on Father's Day, Fourth of July, and Labor Day Weekend. New Hampshire opens up the year on the road at Portland before their home opener on April 12<sup>th</sup> against Hartford. New Hampshire will also host Richmond, Erie, and Altoona for inter-divisional play.

**SEVEN AND COUNTING:** Capra's slam was a franchise-record seventh of the season. The previous mark was five in 2011. Seven different players have hit the grand slams. The Fisher Cats have made the most of bases-loaded situations. They are 38-107 (.355) with six doubles, two triples, and 123 RBI. They have drawn 12 walks and hit 13 sacrifice flies.

**BOB LIPMAN'S THIS DATE IN FISHER CATS HISTORY:** August 29, 2019—In the final home game of the 2019 season, the Fisher Cats beat Trenton 8-2. Thomas Hatch allowed two runs on three hits over seven innings to earn the win. He struck out 11. Josh Palacios and Riley Adams went back-to-back in a five-run fourth to propel New Hampshire to the win.

**MANCHESTER BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS:** The Blue Jays won 3-2 over the Tigers in 10. Vladimir Guerrero Jr. was the extra runner in the tenth, and scored on a single by Corey Dickerson. Jordan Romano finished up for his sixth win. Earlier, Bo Bichette had singled in a run to put the Jays up 2-0, but the Tigers rallied against Alek Manoah in the bottom of the seventh to tie... Worcester edged Buffalo 7-6. Danny Jansen hit a three-run in the fifth... Hillsboro beat Vancouver 9-6... Dunedin won 3-1 at Lakeland... the FCL Jays won 9-3 over the Tigers West. Brock Lundquist had another hit.

## STARTERS:

Luis Quiñones puts a 15-inning scoreless streak over his last three starts on the line this afternoon against the Rumble Ponies. Quiñones worked a career-best six innings in Tuesday's 2-1 win. The 24-year old allowed six runs to Reading in his first New Hampshire start, but has only allowed two earned runs over his last five starts since. With 103 strikeouts in his 67 innings combined Vancouver/New Hampshire, Quiñones ranks second in the organization to Zach Logue (107 K).

Oscar De La Cruz is scheduled for the Rumble Ponies. 26-year old Dominican makes his 11<sup>th</sup> start, and 14<sup>th</sup> appearance for Binghamton. He also worked four games at Triple-A to open the season. De La Cruz has not pitched in two weeks, last working August 15 against Hartford, allowing one run in 5.2 IP. Against New Hampshire this season, De La Cruz has worked twice, including a win in his start on July 10 (5.0 IP-3 ER) ... has allowed eight runs on 10 hits over 7.2 IP.


