INDY BITS

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: A three-run rally in the ninth, sparked by a Dylan Shockley tiebreaking single and Jack Suwinski two-run home run, propelled the Indianapolis Indians past the St. Paul Saints at CHS Field on Friday night, 8-6. St. Paul jumped on the board in the third inning with two runs against Domingo Germán. Payton Eeles created havoc on the bases with a stolen base that forced an Endy Rodríguez throwing error, allowing Chris Williams to stride home for the Saints' first run. Austin Martin then singled and swiped second base ahead of a DaShawn Keirse Jr. RBI single to right field. With two on and two outs in the sixth inning, Joshua Palacios crushed a three-run blast to give Indy its first lead of the night. The Indians added another run in the seventh thanks to a run-scoring fielder's choice off the bat of Bae. Indy's 4-2 lead at the stretch evaporated as the Saints responded by scoring three runs. Rylan Bannon and Eeles then strung together consecutive doubles to give the home team a brief 5-4 advantage, but a two-out wild pitch with the bases loaded in Indy's half of the eighth again evened the score. With the game tied 5-5 in the ninth inning, Ji Hwan Bae got the ball rolling with a single to center field and took second on a fielding error before Shockley plated him in the following at-bat with an RBI single. In the next at-bat, Suwinski provided insurance with an opposite field home run to cap the scoring for Indy. The Saints crept within two runs in the bottom half on Williams' second home run of the contest, but Ryder Ryan nailed down the final two outs after the blast to earn the win.

POWERED BY PALACIOS: Joshua Palacios extended his on-base streak to 11 games last night after finishing a triple shy of the cycle. In total, he led the Indians while going 3-for-5 with a run, double, home run and three RBI, including a go-ahead three-run blast in the sixth inning of a back-and-forth contest. The performance extends a scorching month of September for the outfielder, and in 14 games he now boasts a .421 batting average (24-for-57) with 19 runs, 12 doubles, one triple, three home runs and 14 RBI. In that time, he also leads all International League hitters in doubles, extra-base hits (16), runs, slugging percentage (.825) and OPS (1.294) while also ranking among leaders in batting average (2nd), total bases (2nd, 47), hits (T-2nd) and on-base percentage (9th).

ANOTHER DOUBLE SHOT OF JACK: Jack Suwinski launched his second home run in his past three games at St. Paul last night, going 2-for-5 with a run and the two-run homer during a tiebreaking three-run ninth inning to give the Indians the win. It was his sixth multi-hit performance in 14 September games, during which he is hitting .345 (20-for-58) with 10 runs, six doubles, three home runs, 17 RBI, a .603 slugging percentage and .997 OPS. In that time, he also ranks tied for the fourth most doubles and RBI among International League leaders.

OFF THE BENCH: After entering as a defensive replacement at catcher for major league rehabber Endy Rodríguez in the bottom of the third inning, Dylan Shockley went 2-for-3 with two runs and the game-winning RBI in the top of the ninth inning. It was his second two-hit game during the month of September, following a two-hit performance on Sept. 1 in which he launched his second Triple-A home run. Shockley has recorded multiple hits in five of 10 games with at least one knock for Indianapolis this season.

HEY BAE: Ji Hwan Bae went 2-for-4 with a pair of runs, an RBI and walk last night to extend his hitting streak to eight games since Sept. 10. In that time, he is hitting .345 (10-for-29) with eight runs, three doubles, one triple, one home run, 10 RBI and nine walks to just three strikeouts. His performance continues to show why he has been one of Indy's most reliable hitters when facing right-handed pitching. This season against Triple-A right-handers, he has a .400 batting average (70-for-175) with 10 doubles, four triples, five home runs and 29 RBI in 58 games.

NEW KID ON THE BLOCK: Tsung-Che Cheng extended his hitting streak to three games with Indianapolis following a double last night, his first extra-base hit in Triple-A. He has recorded one hit in each of his games played with an official plate appearance. Cheng, rated as Pittsburgh's No. 18 prospect by MLB Pipeline, spent the majority of the season with Double-A Altoona and hit .218 (92-for-422) with 64 runs, 19 doubles, 11 home runs and 54 RBI in 126 games. Across levels, Cheng ranks among Pirates organization leaders in walks (2nd, 64), runs (4th, 67) doubles (7th, 20) and RBI (9th, 55).

HITTING STRIDES VS. THE SAINTS: The Indians have now recorded double-digit hits in each of their first four games of the series this week in St. Paul. In 16 games against the Saints this season, they are hitting .296 (160-for-541) with 86 runs, 34 doubles, four triples, 13 home runs and 82 RBI. On the other side, the Saints are only hitting .225 (117-for-521) with 66 runs, 29 doubles, three triples, 13 home runs and 60 RBI in games against the Indians.

TONIGHT: The Indianapolis Indians will look to take an advantage in the six-game series tonight at CHS Field, home of the Minnesota Twins Triple-A affiliate St. Paul Saints. The Indians dominated the Saints at Victory Field this season, going 11-1 with a six-game sweep from Aug. 13-18. Continuing the series for the Indians tonight is LHP Michael Plassmeyer (5-10, 7.47), who is 1-1 with one earned run allowed in 7.1 innings and 10 strikeouts in two outings (one start) against St. Paul this season. Countering for the Saints is RHP Randy Dobnak (12-7, 3.90), who is 0-3 with a 5.84 ERA (8er/12.1ip) and 13 strikeouts in three starts against Indianapolis this season.

THIS DATE IN 2000: Just three years into joining the International League, the Indians fought their way to the top of Triple-A baseball with a 9-2 rout in Game 4 against Memphis. Horacio Estrada — the IL leader with 14 wins that season — tossed 8.0 two-run innings to clinch the Triple-A World Series, 3 games to 1. Indy's single-season record holder with 35 saves, Bob Scanlan, closed out the title game with two strikeouts in a 1-2-3 ninth inning.

2024 Highlights

- » Was named Indianapolis' May Player of the Month after hitting nine home runs in 23 games, good for a .720 slugging percentage and 1.050 OPS; his nine home runs in the month were the third-most by an Indians batter in a single month since 2005 and the most since Michael Ryan launched 10 in July 2007.
- » Launched 10 home runs in an 18-game stretch from 5/16-6/2 with a .328 batting average (21-for-64), three doubles, two triples, 27 RBI, .906 slugging percentage and 1.276 OPS; in that time, he led all International League batters in home runs, RBI, slugging percentage, OPS, extra-base hits (15), total bases (58) and triples (T-1st, 2).
