Lovich and Poteet Jack Homers, Pelicans Drop To Warbirds 4-3

MYRTLE BEACH, S.C. (May 28, 2026). – The Myrtle Beach Pelicans (19-27) dropped game three of six to the Wilson Warbirds (25-23) 4-3 at Pelicans Ballpark on Thursday evening.

Trailing the Warbirds 4-2 entering the top of the ninth, the Pelicans scratched a run across courtesy of a solo home run from Logan Poteet (7) to cut the deficit to 4-3, however that was all the Pelicans could muster.

Pelicans RHP Kaleb Wing was stoic in his first start at home, tallying four strikeouts over three scoreless innings while surrendering three hits and two walks. Myrtle Beach took a 1-0 in the bottom of the second with a solo home run from Eli Lovich (6).

The Pelicans tacked on another run in the bottom of the fifth. Derniche Valdez singled and then moved to second when Yahil Melendez was plunked. A batter later, Valdez scored when Darlyn De Leon reached on a fielder's choice coupled with an error to make the game 2-0.

Wilson tied the game in the top of the seventh. Filippo Di Turi and Luis Lameda hit consecutive singles to leadoff the inning. Two batters later, Handelfry Encarnacion roped a two-run double to tie the game at 2-2.

The Warbirds took the lead in the top of the eighth. José Anderson doubled and then scored on an RBI double hit by Frederi Montero to give the Warbirds a 3-2 lead.

Wilson put up one more insurance run in the top of the ninth. Encarnacion singled and then moved to second when Brady Ebel drew a walk. The next batter, Juan Ortuño grounded into a forceout coupled with a fielding error to bring home Encarnacion and increase the lead to 4-2.

LHP Andrew Healy (2-0, 6.35 ERA) received the win for the Warbirds. RHP Jordan Henriquez (2-2, 5.09) was tagged with the loss for the Pelicans.

SHIPPING UP TO SOUTH BEND

Pelicans RHP Mason McGwire and OF Josiah Hartshorn were promoted to High-A South Bend on 5/26. Hartshorn was the anchor in the Pelicans lineup. The Cubs 8th overall prospect had started his first pro season on a reaching base at least once in his first 21 games. Hartshorn was tied with C Logan Poteet for the team-high in HR's on the active roster. RHP Mason McGwire was electric of the Birds this season. The righty took home MiLB Pitcher of the Week Honors (4/14-4/19). On the season, Mc-

Gwire made 10 appearances, 5 starts, racking up 45 strikeouts over 30 innings of work while sporting an ERA of 2.40.

BYE BYE "EL PRIME"

INF/OF Jose Escobar was promoted to High-A South Bend on 5/27 after being on a scorching hot tear as of late. Escobar was the offensive straw that stirred the drink for the Pelicans leading the team in batting average (.299), hits (44), RBI (23), doubles (8). Escobar had also played in the most amount of games for the Pelicans this season (40).

NEW BIRD

RHP Henry Cone was transferred from the Complex League to Single-A Myrtle Beach on 5/26. Cone was acquired by the Cubs via free agency last season and made his pro debut on 5/20 vs A-DBA (1.0 IP, 0 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 1 BB, 3 K). Cone had gone undrafted out of Abilene Christian.

LOVICH LEGACY GAME

Pelicans OF Eli Lovich turned in a career high four hit night on 5/26 vs WIL, going 4-for-4 finishing a triple shy of the cycle. Lovich also added a double to his line. It was his first four hit game in his pro career. After struggling with chasing pitches and timing early in the season, he has quickly found his swing and has looked dangerous as of late. Lovich is currently tied Logan Poteet for the team-high in homers (5) and holds the third-high-est batting average for the Birds hitting .225.

FRIDAY NIGHT THEIVERY

Back on 4/10 in Columbia, the Pelicans stole a season-high nine bags, four of them coming from INF Ty Southisene (tied his career high in SB). OF Alexey Lumpuy stole three bases, OF Cole Mathis and INF Jose Escobar swiped one a piece. Myrtle Beach currently ranks tied for third in stolen bases across Single-A with 20 on the year. Both Southisene and Lumpuy also led the stolen base charge last season as they finished No.1 and No.2 in team high steals. Southisene (41), Lumpuy (30).

COPPOLA WON'T BACK DOWN

Pelicans LHP Pierce Coppola racked up a career-high nine strikeouts over 5.1 innings of three-run ball on 5/19 at KAN. Over his first four starts with the Pelicans this season, Coppola has tallied 28 strikeouts over 17 innings while surrendering 10 hits. The former Florida Gator had a cup of coffee with the birds last year appearing in three games. Now after surpassing his total number of appearances from last season already in 2026, the tall southpaw has been using Tom Petty's "Won't back down" as his walkup song on the mound, a song that the Florida Gators have recently adopted and turned into a tradition at Gators football games.
