HJERPE, LLOYD POWER CARDS TO 4-1 WIN OVER TRAVS: Cooper

Hierpe toosed 5.0 hitless innings for the 2nd straight start while tying a career high with 8 strikeouts and Matt Lloyd homered for the 4th straight game as the Cardinals defeated the Arkansas Travelers 4-1 on Wednesday night at Hammons Field. Lloyd, Jimmy Crooks and Jeremy Rivas each had two hits for the Cards, who also swiped a season-high 5 stolen bases. The Cardinals carried a no-hitter through 6 innings, but **Ben Williamson** broke up the bid with a leadoff single in the 7th for Arkansas.



OPPOSING STARTER: Lefty **Danny Wirchansky** gets the nod for the Travelers making his 11th start (13th appearance) of the season...Last pitched on Friday, June 21 at Dickey-Stephens Park against Wichita and fired 6.0 innings of 2-hit ball allowing just an unearned run with 5 K...Did not factor in the decision, a 3-2 Traveler loss...Has not allowed an earned run in 22.0 June innings, and has surrendered just 7 hits (.095 BAA)...In two starts against the Cardinals at the beginning of the month in North Little Rock allowed just 3 H over 10.0 scoreless innings...In 4 starts against the Cardinals is 0-1 with a 4.76 ERA...Making his debut in affiliated baseball this season...Signed with Seattle as a minor league free agent in February... CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD

The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to Southwest Missouri from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

For the second straight season all 138 Cardinals games can be found across the FM airwaves of Southwest Missouri all season long on Classic Rock 106.7, the radio home of the Springfield Cardinals!

FIRST HALF CHAMPS: For the first time since 2016, the Springfield Cardinals clinched a postseason berth with a first half title. The race came down to the wire, with the Cards needing a win on the last day of the first half to clinch. Springfield trailed the Arkansas Travelers by 2.5 games with 5 to play and by 1.5 games with 2 to play, but the Travs lost their final two games of the first half to the Wichita Wind Surge and the Cards defeated Corpus Christi on back-to-back nights to clinch the title. The Cardinals will be playing in the postseason in backto-back seasons for just the 2nd time in franchise history (2009, 2010).

HOME STRUGGLES: The Cardinals got back on track at Hammons Field on Thursday night with a 4-1 win over the Arkansas Travelers to snap their 2nd home skid of 8 games, tying a franchise record. After winning their first 8 games at home this season, the Cards have still dropped 19 of their last 25 games at Hammons Field. Thursday's win was the first time the Cardinals have allowed less than four runs at home since a 1-0 win over Tulsa on May 24, a stretch that covers 9 games. Overall the Cardinals are 14-19 at home with a team ERA of

Road games, however, have been a much different story. The Cardinals have the best road mark in the Texas League at 24-14, and sport a 3.62 ERA which is the 2nd best in the circuit behind Frisco and tops in the North Division.

GRINDIN': Simply put, the Cardinals don't strike out very much. The Cards have struck out the 2nd-fewest times in all of full-season Minor League Baseball with 503 whiffs in 71 games. The only team with fewer strikeouts than Springfield is the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers (480 K in 71 games). The Cards are averaging just 7.08 K's per game.

THE (EXTRA BASE) JUICE IS LOOSE: Lacking extra base pop in the month of June, the Cardinals have enjoyed a breakout over their last 4 games. With just 11 extra base hits over their previous 11, and 25 over the first 18 games of the month, the Cardinals have knocked 12 extra base hits (5 2B, 7 HR) over their last 4 games. The power surge has been a welcome sight, teh Cardinals hit just 3 HR during a 23 game stretch from May 26-June 21. Sunday represented the first time the Cardinals hit two homers in a game since May 21 when Matt Lloyd and Nathan Church both went deep against the Tulsa Drillers in a 7-6 win.

For the season Springfield has 143 extra base hits this season, still fewest in the Texas League. San Antonio has the 2nd-fewest with 149. Despite having the most hits and highest OBP (.351) in the league, the Cardinals are 7th in SLG at .362 and 5th in OPS (.713). The Cardinals are on pace to hit 78 HR, which would be the fewest in the Texas League since the Travelers hit 71 in 2016.

LLOYD ON A TEAR: Matt Lloyd has been a steady presence in the middle of the Cardinals all season long, but the Canadian product has exploded recently. Lloyd has homered in 4 straight games for the first time in his career and has tallied 8 RBIs during that time, and his batting .342 with 5 HR, 10 RBIs and a Texas League-high 1.221 OPS over his last 10 games since June 14. The former Indiana Hoosier hit a home run in 3 straight games in his first pro season from June 18-July 2, 2019. Thanks to his recent tear, Lloyd now leads active Texas Leaguers with 44 RBIs, 3 behind Colby Thomas (MID) who is now with Triple-A Las Vegas.

RUNNING WILD: After swiping a season-high 5 bags on Wednesday night, the Cardinals are now 20-for-23 in stolen base attempts over their last 8 games since their series opener in Corpus Christi last Tuesday. Jeremy Rivas leads the Cards with 4 SB during that time, while 4 other Birds have 3 bags each. The Cardinals are 3rd in the Texas League with 93 SB as a team, while Rivas and Brvan Torres are tied for the team lead with 19 SB.

REDMOND ON DOORSTEP OF SPRINGFIELD HISTORY: With his go-ahead two-run homer in the 8th inning on April 23 against Arkansas, Cardinals slugger Chandler Redmond tied the franchise record for most home runs. His 59 career home runs in a Springfield uniform bring him even with Xavier Scruggs (2010-13). Redmond already holds the Springfield record for career RBIs with 215

Since tying the record, however, Redmond has gone 37 straight games without a home run.


