### LAST GAME'S RECAP

The Baysox roared to a dominant 19-4 win over the Curve on Wednesday afternoon. After an 84-minute rain delay pushed back the start, Chesapeake erupted with five homers on the day. **Anderson De Los Santos** (2H, 5 RBI), **Carter Young** (2H, 2 RBI), **Frederick Bencosme** (2 RBI), **Ethan Anderson** (3 H, 3 RBI), and **Tavian Josenberger** (3 H, 4 RBI) all went deep. Left-handed starter **Sebastian Gongora** matched a career-high with six innings pitched and seven strikeouts en route to picking up his first win at the Double-A level. The five homers hit by the Baysox on Wednesday were the most in a game since July 31, 2022. Wednesday was the first time the Baysox scored 19 runs in a game since April 6, 2024.

### JACKSON BACK IN ACTION

Orioles INF Jackson Holliday begins an MLB rehab assignment with the Baysox tonight. Holliday had successful surgery to remove a fractured right hamate bone in February. Since then, he has played 12 games with Triple-A Norfolk (7/43 AB, 2 2B, 3 RBI) and two games with High-A Frederick (2/8 AB, 2B, RBI) on rehab. Holliday last played with Norfolk on April 21. This is Holliday's first time playing with the Baysox since 2023, when he was the first 19-year-old to play for the Baysox since Manny Machado in 2012. Holliday hit .338 in 36 games with the Baysox in '23, posting nine doubles, three triples, three homers and a .928 OPS. He became the 218th Baysox alum to make his major league debut on April 10, 2024.

### DE LOS SANTOS DELIVERS

IF **Anderson De Los Santos** has adjusted to the Double-A level in his debut campaign with the Baysox. A complimentary mix of power and patience, De Los Santos' .439 on-base percentage is ninth-best among Eastern League hitters this season, while his 1.023 OPS is eleventh (min. 90 PA). De Los Santos matched a career-high on Wednesday with 5 RBI - his first five RBI game at Double-A. De Los Santos hit .230 with a .721 OPS in 103 games with High-A Aberdeen last season. Entering 2026, De Los Santos was a career .229 hitter in his professional career.

### STRIKEOUT STUFF

The Baysox staff has piled up the strikeouts to begin 2026. Chesapeake's 305 staff strikeouts lead the league, while their 11.39 K/9 is best among all Double-A clubs.

### ESTRADA IS ELECTRIC

IF **Aron Estrada** has registered a hit in six-consecutive starts and is batting .360 (9-for-25) during that stretch with a .986 OPS. Estrada registered his first three-hit game of the season and second of his Double-A career on Tue, 4/28 against Erie.

### IT'S IN THE GAME

C/1B **Ethan Anderson** has been on a tear at home to start the season. Anderson is hitting .500 (22-for-44) with a 1.335 OPS at Prince George's Stadium in 12 contests this season. Anderson has notched six three-hit games already this season. All of them have come at home, including two three-hit contests to open the series against Altoona. Anderson has also homered in each of the first two games this series. It's the first time in Anderson's pro career that he's homered in consecutive games.

### PREVIEWING THE CURVE

Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates, the Curve enter this week with a record of 8-18. After suffering a franchise-worst 0-12 start, Altoona has bounced back nicely, coming off a series split against Richmond. The Curve roster includes five of the Top 30 Pirates prospects, via MLB Pipeline - C Omar Alfonzo (No. 15), RHP Kristian Curtis (No. 22), INF Jack Brannigan (No. 23), INF Duce Gourson (No. 27), and INF Callan Moss (No. 29).

### TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Left-hander Nick Dombkowski takes the ball for Altoona on Thursday. Dombkowski has spent the entirety of his season with Triple-A Indianapolis to this point, but did spend time in Altoona each of the previous four seasons. In his career against the Baysox, Dombkowski has gone 0-1 with a 2.11 ERA in 11 appearances (two starts). Dombkowski was signed to a minor league deal by the Pirates in July of 2021.

**2026: 5/1 @ ERI:** Allowed five runs in the first inning before allowing just one run with five strikeouts in his final three frames. Activated by CHE on 5/1....Began the season on the Baysox injured list... Made three rehab starts with High-A Frederick, going 1-0 with a 0.66 ERA (1 ER in 13.2 IP) and 19 strikeouts with just three hits allowed...**4/24 vs WIL:** Threw five hitless, shutout innings with just one walk and eight strikeouts. **Named to the MiLB Prospect Team of the Week for the week of 4/20-26.**

**2025:** Went 1-3 with a 3.82 ERA in seven starts with the Baysox... Allowed 10 HR in 35.1 IP with CHE after surrendering just 4 in 52.1 IP with NH... Struck out roughly 11 K/9 with CHE versus 9.2 K/9 with NH. Struck out at least 7 in four of seven Baysox starts... **9/6 vs HBG:** Matched a Double-A career-high with 8 strikeouts in 6.2 scoreless IP with just one hit and two walks allowed (**longest scoreless start of his career**)... **Traded to the Orioles organization from the Blue Jays on 7/29 in exchange for big-league reliever Seranthony Dominguez and cash. The trade occurred while Watts-Brown was on the Fisher Cats and New Hampshire was visiting Prince George's Stadium. At the same time, the Blue Jays and Orioles were playing a doubleheader at Camden Yards, prompting both players to walk the complex and switch clubhouses. Watts-Brown then made his Baysox debut five days later against the Fisher Cats at Prince George's Stadium...**Posted a 2-2 record and a 3.48 ERA in 11 starts with Double-A New Hampshire... Promoted to Double-A on 5/20 after beginning the season with High-A Vancouver... Went 0-3 with a 3.62 ERA in eight starts with Vancouver.

**2024:** Split first full season in minors between Single-A Dunedin and High-A Vancouver...**Led Blue Jays system in K (131), BB (60) and 6th in IP (103.0).** Went 3-5 in 12 starts for Dunedin with a 3.43 ERA, allowed 22 ER in 57.2 IP with 74 K to 29 BB and a 11.5 K/9 ratio... Boasted a 2.91 ERA in June with 7 ER and 23 K across 21.2 IP, including 9 K in 6 IP vs Single-A Daytona on 6/19... Assigned to Vancouver on 6/30 and made his first start on 7/4 @ High-A Everett... Went 1-6 for the C's with a 6.35 ERA in 9 starts...Struck out 5+ batters in each of his 9 starts for High-A Vancouver...

**Career Notes:** Did not pitch in '23 upon being drafted.

**College:** Spent two seasons at Long Beach St. before transferring to Oklahoma State in 2023. Suffered a shoulder injury during senior year of HS and redshirted freshman year at Long Beach St. Threw the first complete game no-hitter in LBSU program history on 5/8/22 vs UC Riverside with 16 Ks, one K shy of the single-game program record. Named a Freshman All-American and Honorable Mention All-Big West Conference in 2022. At Oklahoma State in '23, his 124 total strikeouts were the most in the Big 12 and were the 10th most by a Cowboys pitcher in a single season. His 13.55 K/9IP ranked 6th in the NCAA. **Oklahoma St. head coach is Josh Holliday, uncle of former Baysox and now current Orioles INF Jackson Holliday.**

**Personal:** Drafted by the Blue Jays in the 3rd round of the 2023 Draft out of Oklahoma State. Native of Visalia, Calif. A three-sport athlete in high school, playing quarterback in football, basketball and baseball all four years at Hanford High School (Calif.)...

**2026: 4/23 vs AKR:** Nabbed first Double-A win... Promoted to CHE on 4/17... Began season with High-A Frederick, tossing two and one-third scoreless innings with six strikeouts in two appearances... **2025: Made a pair of outings in his lone stint with the Baysox (5/3-13).** 5/11 @ POR: Tossed four shutout innings out of the bullpen with just one hit allowed... 5/3 @ HFD: Made his first professional start in his Double-A debut, allowing just one run in four and one-third innings with three hits allowed and four strikeouts... Spent the majority of his season with High-A Aberdeen. Went 5-8 with a 3.70 ERA in 58.1 innings as both a starter and reliever... Also appeared three times for Single-A Delmarva, going 2-0 with a 3.21 ERA in 14 innings... **2024:** Drafted by the Orioles in the 14th round of the 2024 Draft out of Lindsey Wilson College. Signed for \$25,000. Did not pitch upon being drafted... **College:** Pitched four seasons primarily as a starter at Lindsey Wilson College, an NAIA school located in Columbia, KY (about 2 hours north of Nashville). Became school's all-time leader in strikeouts (341) after punching out 101 batters in just 64.1 IP in 2024. Became first player in program history to record over 100 strikeouts in multiple seasons. Holds third most wins (23) in program history. Named Mid-South Conference Freshman of the Year. Began college career at Big Bend College (JUCO in Moses Lake, WA) and pitched there for half a season before COVID shut it down. While at Big Bend College, took a comebacker off the right side of the head in March 2020 that resulted in a fractured skull, slight brain bleed, a concussion, and three months of vertigo. Recovered from the injury after his season was shut down due to the COVID-19 pandemic... Pitched for Lakeshore Chinooks in the Northwoods League in summer of '24 and was named an NWL Postseason All-Star... **Personal:** Native of Calgary, Alberta.
