Leading Off

Reading continues a six-game series and 12-game homestand tonight against New Hampshire. The Fisher Cats lead the season-series 14-7.

Reading fell behind 3-0 early, but Zach Haake settled in to pitch five-solid innings. Ethan Wilson lifted a two-run homer in the fourth and Baron Radcliff hit a solo home run to tie the game at three in the sixth. Reading then took the lead in the seventh on an RBI single from Jhailyn Ortiz. The bullpen combined for four-shutout innings and Orion Kerkering earned his fourth save as the R-Phils won 4-3.

Reading finsihed the month with a 12-12 record, marking its first winning month of the season. Reading finished the month hitting 40 home runs, which lead the Eastern League for the month. Reading's pitching staff is third in the league in strikeouts this month with 274. Oliver Dunn finished the month hitting .299, with ten homers and 29 RBI in August. Dunn's ten home runs and 29 RBI are tied with Somerset's Ben Rice for the Eastern League lead. David Parkinson's 1.26 ERA this month leads the league and Mick Abel's .188 average against ranks second this month.

Abel Stavs Hot

Phillies No. 2 Prospect Mick Abel turned in another strong start Wednesday night. Over his last two starts, Abel has 12 innings, four hits allowed, just two earned runs (1.50 ERA) and eight strikeouts, with opponents hitting .108 against him and a 0.83 WHIP. Abel now ranks ninth in the Eastern League in strikeouts (111), fifth in WHIP (1.29) and leads in batting average against (.197).

Baron's Got the Power

Baron Radcliff has homered in two-straight games on moonshot hits. Wednesday night he hit a ball that traveled an estimated 409 feet in right and last night he hit on 427 feet and it cleared the pool deck in right field.

Jhailyn Stays Hot

Jhailyn Ortiz had another hit last night to extend his season-best hitting streak to six games. He's also reached in a season-high seven-straight games. Over his last five games, Ortiz is hitting .353 and is .318 (7-22) against New Hampshire this season.

Around the Organization

The Phillies were off last night and begin a series in Milwaukee tonight. Lehigh Valley walked off Syracuse in ten innings 9-8 as Tyler Phillipes twirrled a quality start. Jersey Shore beat Aberdeen 5-0 as Mitch Neuborn threw five-shutout innings. Clearwater fell to Fort Myers 7-4 as Emaarion Boyd stole two more bases to get him to 53 on the season.

Welcoming the Cats

New Hampshire enters tonight with a 21-30 record in the second half, which is last in the Eastern League, and 56-63 overall record. Last week, New Hampshire won just one-of-five games with Binghamton and Sunday was cancelled. Next week, the Fisher Cats remain on the road at Bowie before finishing the season at home against Somerset. Five of the Blue Jays top-30 prospects are on New Hampshire: Ricky Tiedemann (1), Alan Roden (7), Chad Dallas (14), Damiano Palmegiani (19) and Mason Fluharty (28). Tiedemann ranks No. 33 on MLB Pipeline's Top 100.

Chad Dallas makes his third start against Reading this season. In his prior two starts, he's combined to throw 9.1 innings, allowed six hits, six runs and struck out 12, including ten on Aug. 9 in Manchester. Overall in 2023, Dallas is 6-2 with a 4.54 ERA (79.1 IP, 68 H, 31 BB, 85 SO). Dallas last started Aug. 26 vs Binghamton and suffered the loss as he allowed six-earned runs and 12 hits over 4.2 innings. Dallas began the season with High-A Vancouver and went 2-0 with a 2.03 ERA over five starts. He also spent all of 2022 with Vancouver, going 1-7, with a 4.60 ERA. The Blue Jays selected Dallas in the fourth round of the 2021 draft out of Tennessee.
