### TONIGHT'S GAME

Round Rock and Las Vegas will face off in the series opener on Wednesday night. Aviators RHP Freddy Tarnok is slated to start against Express RHP Robert Dugger, with first pitch at Las Vegas Ballpark scheduled for 9:05 p.m. CT.

### WALK-OFF WIN SECURED

Round Rock won in walk-off fashion on Sunday night at Dell Diamond by a final score of 5-4 to secure a 4-1 series win over Sacramento. The River Cats took a 1-0 lead in the first frame after a double steal allowed C Joey Bart to knock in a run on a fielder's choice. In the home half, DH Blaine Crim hit into a double play with the bases loaded and tied the game 1-1. Sacramento saw three runs in the fifth inning after DH Jacob Nottingham walked then scored on a single from SS Will Wilson. Bart tapped a two-out RBI single and a bases-loaded walk to 3B Armando Alvarez extended the River Cats' lead to 4-1. In the bottom of the sixth, Express 3B Dio Arias tripled to plate LF Sandro Fabian. A throwing error on a steal allowed Arias to score from third base as Round Rock trailed 4-3. Fabian tied the game in the eighth inning with a solo home run to left field. SS Jonathan Ornelas walked it off in the bottom of the ninth inning with a two-out double that scored Hernandez from second base and secured the 5-4 win.

### DUGGER UP NEXT

Round Rock RHP Robert Dugger is set to start on Wednesday. Dugger holds the second-longest scoreless streak among the Express pitching staff, which spans 10.1 innings. The righty has the third lowest ERA of 4.43 (33 ER/67.0 IP) among qualified pitchers in the Pacific Coast League.

### PCL'S PITCHER OF THE WEEK

Express RHP Cole Winn was named Pacific Coast League Pitcher of the Week for June 19-15 after holding the Sacramento River Cats scoreless in two relief appearances spanning 6.0 innings. Out of the bullpen on Sunday night, the righty threw 3.0 innings to extend his scoreless streak to 6.2 innings, dating back to June 14. It is the third-longest scoreless streak among the Round Rock pitching staff behind RHP Fer Ozuna (11.2 innings) and RHP Robert Dugger (10.1 innings).

### THE STREAK SITS AT 26

On Sunday night, Express OF Elier Hernandez extended his hitting streak to 26 games with his 26th multi-hit game of the season after finishing 2-for-4 with a run scored and a walk. His franchise-record streak is the longest of the season in the Pacific Coast League and dates back to May 24. During the hitting streak, he is batting .422 (49-116) with 10 doubles, two triples, eight home runs, 31 runs scored, 38 RBI, 10 walks and 24 strikeouts. He owns the longest active hitting streak in all of professional baseball and is now tied for the league's overall hit lead with Las Vegas OF Cody Thomas at 87 hits apiece.

### E-TRAIN CONTINUE JUNE RULE

After a 5-4 win over Sacramento on Sunday, the Express have compiled a 16-5 record in June. This month, the team has recorded the second-most runs (169) and RBI (157) in the Pacific Coast League while also drawing the second-most walks (113). June's 175 strikeouts are the third fewest in the PCL. Round Rock's .419 OBP and .919 OPS are second only to the Reno Aces and the team leads the league in slugging percentage with a .524 mark.

### MAKIN' MOVES

Round Rock saw a flurry of roster moves on Wednesday as INF Justin Foscue was activated from the team's 7-Day Injured List and reliever RHP Alex Speas was promoted from Double-A Frisco. To make room on the active roster, INF Nick Tanielu was sent to Frisco and RHP Edwar Colina was added to the Development List. Texas INF Brad Miller joined the team on a rehab assignment.

EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS

The 2023 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's Pacific Coast League debut. Davis spent the previous two years as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 673-588 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the 2003 World Series.



In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach.

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.

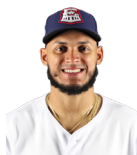
