Rochester Red Wings RHP Spenser Watkins (2-2, 4.83) vs. Worcester Red Sox RHP Richard Fitts (4-1, 3.72)

Chance for a Series Win in Game 6 – The Worcester Red Sox – who have won 3 straight to take a 3 games to 2 lead in this series – attempt to win the series outright today when they play the finale of their 6-game set against the Rochester Red Wings (AAA-Washington) at 1:05 pm at Polar Park. Worcester is 4-5-1 in their first 10 series of 2024 (4 wins, 5 losses, and 1 split) with a chance for a series victory today. This afternoon's game can be seen live on NESN+ and can be heard on NASH 98.9 FM and the rest of the WooSox Radio Network.

This Series – Worcester has received explosive offense and solid pitching to win three in a row over the Red Wings the past three days by scores of 13-4, 7-4, and 8-2. The three victories have come after Rochester won the first two games of the series, 11-4 and 9-6. The WooSox have out-scored the Red Wings, 38-30 in the five games combined and have hit at a .305 clip during this series (53-for-174) with 10 2B, 1 3B, and 9 HR. Sox batters have a .422 OBP and a .529 SLG pct. during this series. WooSox pitchers are 3-2 with a 4.40 ERA (22 ER in 45 IP) while allowing 7 HR.

Go Fourth – A victory today would extend the WooSox winning streak to four straight which would match their longest of the season. The Sox won 4 in a row from April 14 (G2 of a doubleheader) – April 19.

We are the Worcester Ruby Legs - The WooSox will be playing as the Worcester Ruby Legs this afternoon for the second time in their history. Last year on June 11 the WooSox (er Worcester Ruby Legs) defeated Rochester, 5-2 here at Polar Park. To give a brief history of how this has come to fruition...during the 2019 baseball offseason, a year following the announcement of the impending move from Pawtucket to Worcester, WooSox President Dr. Charles Steinberg led a series of "Fan Plan" sessions throughout the area to gather thoughts and ideas for what fans wanted from their new team. As part of that, fans were asked to help decide a new team name and more than 200 fans submitted entries. Besides clear cut winner "WooSox", "Worcester Ruby Legs" was one of the most popular suggestions. The name pays homage to the Worcester Worcesters and the Boston Braves of the late 1800s. It's unclear which team wore red high socks, but once the Braves disbanded, the Red Sox began wearing red high socks (hence the team name). Legend has it, the Worcesters were also referred to as "the ruby-legged opposition". So today, the entire WooSox team will be wearing jerseys and hats that were typical of the Worcester Ruby Legs nearly 150 years ago.

Masataka Back in Action - Boston Red Sox OF Masataka Yoshida will play his second game with Worcester on an injury rehab assignment today (again as the DH). He went 1-for-4 with a run scored as the DH yesterday in his WooSox debut. "Mah-sah-TAH-kah yo-SHEE-dah" has been on Boston's injured list since April 29 with a left thumb strain. He was batting .275 in 24 games this season with 2 HR & 11 RBI. Yoshida had an excellent season in his first year with the Red Sox in 2023 after signing as a free agent in December of 2022, hitting .289 in 140 games with 33 2B, 3 3B, 15 HR & 72 RBI. He finished 6th in the 2023 American League Rookie of the Year voting after leading AL rookies in hits (155), doubles (33), and average (.289). The 30-year-old from Fukui, Japan played for the Orix Buffaloes of Japan's Nippon Professional Baseball from 2016-2022 and in 762 games he hit .327 with 153 HR & 467 RBI and was a four-time NPB All-Star.

The Road Ahead – The WooSox will head to Buffalo tomorrow afternoon in advance of opening a 6-game series against the Bisons on Tuesday night at 6:35 pm. Worcester is 3-9 vs. the Bisons this season (their worst record against any International League opponent) including a 2-5 mark in Buffalo during a 7-game series from May 7-12. The WooSox went 1-4 vs. the Bisons during Worcester's first homestand of the season from April 2-7.

Climbing Back — The WooSox have won 3 in a row following their 4-game losing skid and are now 29-33 on the season. Before this winning streak they had dipped to a season and franchise-low 7-games under .500 on June 5. Worcester's low point last year was 6-games under .500 when they were 8-14 on April 26, 2023. Their low in 2022 was also 6-games below on May 15, 2022 at 15-21. And their low point in 2021 during their inaugural campaign was just 3-games under when they started 0-3.

Even Not Too Long Ago - Just 2½ weeks ago, on May 21 after a 20-4 rout of Norfolk, the WooSox pulled even at 23-23 on the season. The Sox have been over .500 just once this season when they were 2-1 on March 31.

Turn for Home – Worcester is back over .500 at Polar Park with their 18-16 record here in Worcester (compared to 11-17 away from home). The Sox have been up and down at Polar Park throughout this season. They started 1-4 at home from April 2-7, then went 14-5 at Polar Park from April 16 – May 21, and recently were 0-7 from May 22 – June 5 before going 3-0 in their last three here at home.

Wingstop – This series this week/weekend is one of two that Rochester will play here at Polar Park in just over one month's time as the Red Wings will be back in Worcester for another 6-game series next month from July 9-14 leading into the All-Star break. The WooSox finally make their only trip to Rochester all season from September 2-8 for a 6-game set vs. the Wings.

Red Sox vs. Red Wings – By virtue of their wins the past three games, Worcester has overtaken Rochester to grab a 37-35 win advantage in the all-time series between the clubs (since 2021). The Red Wings are 23-17 all-time at Polar Park while the WooSox are 20-12 in Rochester winning 19 of their last 26 games at the Rock. Furthermore, Worcester is now three games up on Rochester with 361 wins to 358 in the remarkably close last 44+ years of facing each other since the 1979 season. These two clubs went 12-12 during their season-series against each other last year as the teams finished 6-6 here at Polar Park and 6-6 in Rochester as well.

Hit Me With Your Best Shot – WooSox batters are 1st in the 20-team International League by being hit by pitch 54 times this season including 10 hit batsman in the first five games of this series. Next on the list for HBP on the season is Norfolk with 42. The Red Sox Triple-A record for Most Hit by Pitch (by batters) in a season is 79 set by the Pawtucket Red Sox in 2000 & tied by the Worcester Red Sox in 2022.

Rankings – Worcester is 13^{th} in the IL in team batting with a .251 average while Rochester is 5^{th} at .261. On the pitching side, the Sox are 10^{th} in team ERA (4.97) while the Red Wings are 19^{th} with a 5.70 ERA.

Streaks – The WooSox suffered a season-high 6-game losing streak from May 22-28 which was Worcester's longest in over a year since a 6-game losing streak from April 9-14 of last season. Worcester's longest winning streak of this season was 4 in a row from April 14 (G2 of a doubleheader) – April 19. They can match that with a victory today.

Series Math – Worcester is 4-5-1 in their first 10 series of 2024 (4 wins, 5 losses, and 1 split). They finished 13-8-5 in their 26 series last season...13 winners, 8 losers, and 5 splits. The Sox went 8-3-2 in 13 series at Polar Park and 5-5-3 in 13 sets on the road.

Two for Ones — Worcester was the only team without a 1-run victory this season — until May 16 (and then May 17 as well). The WooSox were 0-7 in 1-run games this year until their dramatic, 13-12 win on May 16 followed by May 17th's 9-8 triumph. They are now 2-9 in 1-run affairs. Last year the WooSox went 21-24 in 1-run games. The Sox are 4-7 in 2-run games this season. Last year they were 13-10 in that category.

Daydream Believers – Worcester has had more success this season in day games (16-16) than at night (13-17).

Comeback Kids – Worcester has 14 come-from-behind victories this season including 4 wins in their last at-bat of the game and one walk-off. They have suffered 8 losses during the opponent's final at-bat.

May Be or Might Be - The WooSox rallied to win their final three games in May and finish the month even with a 14-14 record. The WooSox finished 10-14 in April after going 2-1 in March. Sox pitchers had a 4.88 ERA (129 ER in 238 IP) with 27 HRA in May while Sox batters hit .256 during the month (232-for-908) with 42 HR.

April Recap - The WooSox finished 10-14 in April (after going 2-1 in March) while batting .244 with 22 HR. Sox pitchers were 10-14 with a 5.55 ERA with 25 HRA. Worcester out-scored their opponents, 129-123 in April. The month also featured five postponements, four doubleheaders, 29 player transactions, 10 players promoted to Boston (not including any rehabbers), and a total of 41 players used (19 position players & 22 pitchers).

A Winning Tradition – The 2023 Worcester Red Sox went 79-68 to post a winning season for the third time in as many years of existence. Worcester finished with a 43-33 home record compared to 36-35 on the road last year. The 2021 WooSox went 74-54 during their abbreviated inaugural season while the 2022 WooSox finished 75-73.

Finish Line – In the overall International League Standings for the 2023 season, out of 20 IL teams, Worcester finished in 7th-place with a 79-68 overall record. In the 1st half standings last year, the WooSox went 39-36 while they improved to 40-32 in the 2nd half. This season, for the second time ever, the IL will again invoke a split season with the first half sending on June 23 while the second half will run from June 25 – September 22.

You Need a Scorecard – The 2023 WooSox built on a pair of all-time Red Sox Triple-A records as they made **271 player transactions** during the 2023 campaign and set a new all-time Red Sox Triple-A record for players appearing in a single season. The WooSox used **79 different players** in 2023 (33 position players and 46 pitchers) to better the mark of 75 different players in 2022 (31 position players and 44 pitchers). Ironically, the 2021 WooSox set the previous mark of 72 different players (31 position players and 41 pitchers).

Two Dozen to Go - 24 different WooSox players were promoted to Boston during the 2023 season (not counting Red Sox rehabbing players) including Jarren Duran, Chris Murphy, Brandon Walter, David Hamilton, Wilyer Abreu, Ceddanne Rafaela, and many others.

PORTLAND SEA DOGS UPDATE – The Portland Sea Dogs (30-26) fell to Akron, 7-5 last night as the 2nd-place Sea Dogs remained a ½-game behind Hartford in the Eastern League Northeast Division. Roman Anthony ripped a pair of doubles and had 1 RBI while Phillip Sikes stroked 3 hits good for 2 RBI. Jonathan Brand (1-2) gave up 1 run over 2 innings of relief to be saddled with the loss.

WOOSOX PLAYER MOVES – None today.

Worcester has already used 55 players this season (26 position players and 29 pitchers). The list does not include LHP Joely Rodriguez who joined the WooSox on May 3 but did not pitch and was placed on the injured list on May 12 with right hip inflammation.

The WooSox have sent 12 players to Boston in the 10+ weeks since the season started...INF David Hamilton, INF Romy Gonzalez, LHP Brennan Bernardino, INF/OF Bobby Dalbec, RHP Cooper Criswell, LHP Joe Jacques, LHP Cam Booser, C Tyler Heineman, RHP Zack Kelly, RHP Naoyuki Uwasawa, INF Enmanuel Valdez, and INF/OF Jamie Westbrook. Those 12 do not include OF Rob Refsnyder, INF Vaughn Grissom, RHP Nick Pivetta, and OF Tyler O'Neill who were all injury rehab recalls from Worcester to Boston. Uwasawa and Heineman are back with the WooSox, while Jacques was claimed off waivers by Arizona. The rest of those players are still with the Red Sox.
