Today is the finale of a six-game series and the 498th all-time meeting between the Lugnuts and Whitecaps, part of a 24-game season series between the two teams. Lansing is 233-263 all-time vs. the Whitecaps, losing the first five games of this series.

Yesterday: Whitecaps 9, Lugnuts 5. The Nuts overcame 1-0 and 3-1 deficits to take a 5-3 lead entering the sixth inning, only to see the Whitecaps score six unanswered runs to snag their sixth straight win. **Devin Taylor** and **Casey Yamauchi** homered in defeat, while **Andrew Sojka** and **Clayton Campbell** homered for West Michigan in the win.

LUG-NOTES

Transaction: The Lugnuts have added reliever **Jorge Marcheco** (No. 30) from Double-A Midland, bringing the roster to 30 active players. Marcheco, 23, was selected by the A's with the 45th pick of the 2025 Rule 5 Draft Triple-A Phase from the Los Angeles Angels' organization. He had spent the 2025 season with High-A Tri-City (77 IP, 4.44 ERA, 22 walks, 77 strikeouts) and Double-A Rocket City (two starts, 3.52 ERA, 7 2/3 IP). The native of Bayamo, Cuba, was originally signed by the Angels as an international free agent as a 19-year-old in 2021.

Sha vs. the Whitecaps: Lansing starter **Tzu-Chen Sha** made two starts against the Whitecaps last season, on July 20 and August 20. (What if today had been April 20...?) On July 20, he allowed five runs in three innings (two in the 2nd, three in the 3rd) in a 6-0 loss. On August 20, he pitched in piggyback relief, following **Kenya Huggins'** three scoreless innings, and was masterful, allowing only an **Archer Brookman** fifth-inning solo home run in his first five innings. The game went to the bottom of the ninth tied at 1-1; **Izaak Pacheco** led off with a single and advanced to second via a throwing error by Sha on a pickoff attempt. After a **Garrett Pennington** HBP, **Austin Murr** won the game with a sacrifice fly to center field.

Congratulations! The first Midwest League Player of the Week was 23-year-old Lansing C/3B **Davis Diaz**, who batted .611 (11-for-19) while reaching base 16 times and scoring nine runs in five games at Fort Wayne last week. Diaz added four doubles, four walks, one HBP, and two runners caught stealing. He is tied for 1st in the Midwest League in runs scored (11, with teammate **Bobby Boser**), tied for 1st in doubles (5), 2nd in batting average (.480), 2nd in OBP (.606), 3rd in OPS (1.286), and tied for 3rd in base hits (12).

Miller Time: The most dominant former Lugnut in the Majors is untouchable Padres closer / 2022 Lugnut **Mason Miller**. In ten appearances / 10 1/3 scoreless innings this season, batters are 2-for-33 with two singles, two walk and 25 strikeouts. Miller has tossed 32 2/3 consecutive scoreless innings, bringing him within two innings of matching San Diego's franchise record.

Prospecting: The Nuts' roster now has No. 8 (**Devin Taylor**), No. 15 (**Gavin Turley**) No. 16 (**Steven Echavarria**), No. 19 (**Zane Taylor**), No. 26 (**Nate Nankil**) and No. 30 (**Bobby Boser**) on MLB Pipeline's Top 30 rankings of Athletics prospects.

All Aboard: Shortstop **Bobby Boser** has reached base in 12 straight games.

Milestone Watch: Lansing is 12 wins away from the 2,000th win in Lugnuts history and 3 players away from 1,000 players all-time.

Cooperstown Bound: 18-year-old **Carlos Beltrán** was in the very first Lugnuts starting lineup on April 5, 1996. Over the course of his ensuing 20-year career, he was voted 1999 American League Rookie of the Year, was named a nine-time All-Star, won three Gold Gloves, two Silver Sluggers, the Roberto Clemente Humanitarian Award, and the 2017 World Series. This summer, on July 27, Beltrán will be inducted into the National Baseball Hall of Fame in Cooperstown, becoming the first Lugnut to be enshrined.

Major League Nut: The 201st Lugnut to reach the Major Leagues, 2023 Lugnuts catcher **Daniel Susac**, has opened his career batting .500 (11-for-22) with two doubles and a triple through 10 games with the Giants. Debuting on April 1, Susac hit safely in his first five at-bats, setting a new Giants modern-day franchise record and coming up one shy of the Major League modern-day franchise record set by Boston OF **Ted Cox** in 1977. Susac was taken in the Rule 5 Draft by Minnesota and traded to San Francisco.

APRIL 19TH IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2010: Catcher A.J. Jimenez went 4-for-5 with three doubles, two runs scored and two RBIs, and the Lugnuts battered Bowling Green with 18 hits in a 9-3 victory at Cooley Law School Stadium, finishing a three-game sweep. This was the Hot Rods' first ever visit to Lansing, in their first season in the Midwest League since moving up from the South Atlantic League with Lake County before the year.

2015: In an unusual shutout – and a brilliant relief appearance – Justin Shafer relieved Sean Reid-Foley (2 2/3 innings) and blanked the Dayton Dragons for the final 6 1/3 innings in a 4-0 win at Cooley Law School Stadium. Shafer struck out Gavin LaValley to escape a bases-loaded jam in the third inning and was never seriously threatened afterward, allowing four singles and whiffing five.

2019: For the first time since September 4, 2017, the Dayton Dragons won in Lansing, 9-4 – ending a 12-game losing streak in Lansing.
