Today: The Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, play the sixth game in a 12-game, 14-day road trip, wrapping up a six-game season series at the legendary Wisconsin Udder Tuggers, High-A affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers. The Lugnuts, who won four of six games in Appleton last season, dropped the series opener (pitting today's starters, Joelvis Del Rosario and Jacob Misiorowski), won three straight, and then lost last night.

Last Night: Tuggers 8, Lugnuts 5. Lansing left fielder Jonny Butler went 3-for-4 with a double, two homers, a steal, an outfield assist and three RBIs, but Wisconsin right fielder Joe Gray, Jr. swatted two three-run homers, the second to break a seventh-inning tie, to lift the Wisconsin Udder Tuggers to victory. The game was played in two hours and five minutes in front of a crowd of 3,660.

On the Air: Today's game is available on Bally Live and MiLB TV with Chris Mehring, and an audio-only broadcast via StreamGuys with Jesse Goldberg-Strassler and Adam Jakska.

On Deck: The Lugnuts enjoy a couple of days off, and then continue the two-week road trip with a six-game series at the Great Lakes Loons, whom they swept to open the season. The next Lugnuts home game will be on the 4th of July against the Lake County Captains.

Streaks Snapped: Jack Winkler was hit by a pitch in the ninth inning last night to extend his on-base streak to 11 games, but went 0-for-3 to end his eight-game hitting streak. Junior Pérez went 0-for-4, ending his own on-base streak at 11 games.

Powering On: Yesterday Jonny Butler became the third Lugnuts player to hit two home runs in a game this season, joining Lazaro Armenteros at Lake County on April 19 and Junior Pérez at West Michigan on May 12.

Back to Back: Yesterday also marched the third time this year that Lansing has allowed consecutive home runs to the opposition, with Joe Gray, Jr. and Darrien Miller going yard in the first inning. The first two times, it came against today's starting pitcher, with Joelvis Del Rosario victimized by West Michigan on April 13 and by Cedar Rapids on May 31.

Two for the Price of One: The Lugnuts did not turn a double play yesterday, though they did hit into one in the ninth inning. Still, Lansing has 21 double plays turned in their last 13 games and has turned a league-leading 65 double plays this year. The Double-A Midland RockHounds, a level above the Lugnuts on the Oakland organizational ladder, have 63 double plays in 67 games to tie for the Texas League lead.

More Burglary: The Nuts swiped two bases yesterday, giving them 11 stolen bases this series and 99 steals for the year, second most in the league. Lansing leads the MWL with 40 steals this month.

The Cycle: Jack Winkler's cycle on Wednesday afternoon was the first for Lansing since Ryan Gold achieved the feat vs. Dayton on April 18, 2019. The other cycles in team history: Corey Patterson (7/5/99 at South Bend); Donnie Hood (4/21/03 vs. Dayton); Chip Cannon (6/2/05 vs. Clinton); Travis Snider (7/7/07 at Fort Wayne); Brad Glenn (7/26/10 vs. Clinton); Edward Olivares (4/24/17 vs. South Bend).

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2010: Trailing 4-2 to the Dayton Dragons entering the ninth inning, the Lugnuts used RBI singles from Kenny Wilson and Ryan Goins to tie the score. Dayton recaptured the lead at 6-4 in the 11th inning, but this time it was little-used catcher Karim Turkamani who played the hero, dumping a broken-bat game-winning single into left field to cap a three-run rally and set off a jubilant celebration in front of a crowd of 7,916 on the first day of the second half.

2015: Lugnuts All-Star Rowdy Tellez is promoted to A-Adv. Dunedin, leading the league with 49 RBIs and tied for second with 80 hits in 68 games.

2016: Tayler Saucedo had allowed 14 hits and eight runs in five innings in his previous start against West Michigan. He was much better here, needing 109 pitches for a nine-hit, two-walk, complete-game shutout, 6-0, over the Whitecaps at Cooley Law School Stadium.

The King: First name is pronounced “yo-el-vis,” with the emphasis on the middle syllable... nicknamed Elvis... one other Joelvis played professional baseball, Joelvis Gonzalez, a Twins prospect from Venezuela in 2006-07 who hit .270 in 79 games but never made it higher than rookie ball... has been clocked as hot as 98 mph this year; says that he has hit 100 mph once in his life, the first time his mother came in from the DR to watch him pitch in a professional game, in 2022 in the Florida State League... currently rated the No. 29 prospect in the Athletics’ organization by MLB Pipeline; Fastball 55, Slider 50, Changeup 50, Control 50, Overall 40.

Path Through the Pros: After signing at age 16 for \$33,000, Del Rosario debuted as a reliever in 2018 in the Dominican Summer League before converting to a starter in the DSL in 2019, tossing 5 2/3 innings at most... made United States debut in 2021 in Florida Complex League; twirled five hitless innings in second start, July 5, striking out seven Orioles and walking one... made full-season debut with Bradenton in 2022, posting three six-inning starts in a four-start span in June; allowed .248 avg. to right-handers compared to .299 to lefties; runners stole six bases in 10 attempts; outstanding in the first inning, limiting opposition to .191/.295/.353 splits; far better on the road (2.95 ERA in 55 IP) than at home (4.74 in 38 IP).

Joining the Athletics: Del Rosario was the first overall selection of the 2022 MiLB portion of the Rule 5 Draft... in the Major League portion, the A’s had selected 2018 Lugnut Ryan Noda from the Dodgers with the second overall pick; Noda debuted in the Majors on his birthday on March 30th and has already launched his first MLB home run... Del Rosario was one of a staggering 11 Pittsburgh Pirates prospects to be selected in the Rule 5 MiLB portion after two Pirates prospects, Jose Hernandez and Blake Sabol, were taken consecutively (3rd and 4th) in the MLB portion.

A Taste of the Cactus League: Del Rosario appeared in one Spring Training game for the A’s, pitching well initially before bowing out having allowed four runs on four hits and three walks in 2 2/3 innings, striking out four, hitting one and tossing a wild pitch.
