LHP Matt Wilkinson's 116 strikeouts are the most in the Cleveland organization through 84 team games since 2005. 5-year MLB veteran **Triston McKenzie** struck out 115 with then High-A Lynchburg in 2017.

Lake County leads the MWL and ranks 3rd in High-A with 446 runs (5.3 per game), its most runs through 84 games since the 2007 Captains scored 481 in this span.

CAPTAINS LOG

LAST TIME OUT: After Lake County entered the top of the 9th inning with a 4-3 lead, a 2-run double by Lansing CF Braylan Buelvas gave the Lugnuts a 6-5 win on Friday at Classic Auto Group Park.

RHP Magnus Ellerts (3-3) got the loss, allowing 2 runs on 2 hits in 2 innings. RHP Trenton Denholm (ND) went 5.2 innings in the start, allowing 4 runs on 4 hits while striking out 4.

FOX ON THE RUN: DH Jake Fox, MLB Pipeline's No. 18 Cleveland prospect, hit a 2-run home run in the bottom of the 5th, his 2nd homer against Lansing in the last 3 games. **Fox is batting .348 (8-for-23) over his last 6 games. 13 of his 35 RBI and 4 of his 5 home runs this season have come against Lansing.**

MOON LANDING: 3B Alex Mooney, MLB Pipeline's No. 20 Cleveland prospect, went 1-for-5 with a Little League home run on Thursday, hitting an RBI triple and scoring on a throwing error by Lansing SS Euribiel Angeles. **Mooney is 1 extra-base hit shy of becoming the 4th Captain in franchise history (2003-present) to record 30 XBH and 30 stolen bases in a season.**

THAT'S OUR GUY: RF Guy Lipscomb went 2-for-4 with 1 RBI and 1 run scored, recording his 1st multi-hit game since June 16 versus Fort Wayne. **In his last 8 games versus Lansing, Lipscomb is batting .467 (18-for-35) with 2 HR, 6 RBI, and 9 runs scored.**

GENAO AND LATER: SS Angel Genao, MLB Pipeline's No. 11 Cleveland prospect, has hit safely in 22 of his first 28 High-A games, and his 98 hits across Lake County and Single-A Lynchburg are tied for 10th in MiLB.

HOME SWEET HOME: The Captains are 29-16 (.644) at Classic Auto Group Park, the 3rd-best home record in the MWL and 9th-best in full-season MiLB. **LC has won its last 6 home series, with their last loss coming to Lansing on April 16-21.**

ONE OF THESE NIGHTS: Lake County's 20 runs on July 5 versus Dayton were tied for the most in High-A this season, matched by Eugene's 20 at Tri-City on June 4. **The Captains tallied 4 franchise records and tied a franchise best with 12 runs in the bottom of the 7th.**

COOPER (NEVER) TIRES: C Cooper Ingle, MLB Pipeline's No. 30 Cleveland prospect, leads the Midwest League with a .337 AVG, and ranks 2nd with a .427 OBP.

THE BATTLE OF TRENTON: RHP Trenton Denholm (8-2) leads the Midwest League in wins (8) and ranks 3rd in the Midwest League in quality starts (7), 3rd in WHIP (1.05), 6th in ERA (3.45) and is 1 of 2 Midwest Leaguers to pitch a 7-inning complete game shutout (Game 1, 5/10 vs. Dayton). **Denholm is the fastest Captains pitcher to win 8 games since at least 2005.**

TRIPLE ENTENTE: INF Alex Mooney, OF Jonah Advincula and OF Guy Lipscomb are the 1st Captains trio to steal 20+ bases in Lake County's first 74 team games of a season since 2012. 4 Captains that stole 20+ bags in 74 team games, 1 of them being current New York Mets SS and 4-time MLB All-Star Francisco Lindor.

REAL STEAL: The Captains have stolen 149 bases through their first 834 games, their most through the first 84 games since at least 2005. **Lake County is tied for 1st in MiLB with an 88.2% stolen base percentage.**

NAVAL POWER: LHP Matt Wilkinson eclipsed 100 strikeouts on June 25 versus Great Lakes, and now ranks 3rd in MiLB with 116 strikeouts this season. **Among Minor League pitchers with 70+ IP, Wilkinson's 14.57 K/9 are the highest through a team's first 80 games since current San Francisco LHP Kyle Harrison posted 15.01 K/9 with Double-A Richmond in 2022.**

THE ATLANTIC CAMPAIGN: Since 2021, 11 of Cleveland's draft picks have come from the Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC), including 6 in the 2023 MLB Draft. Of those 11 ACC draftees, 5 have played for the Captains this year (LHP Parker Messick, OF Angel Zarate, 1B/LF C.J. Kayfus, C Cooper Ingle, and INF Alex Mooney), with 5 total '23 draftees being Top 30 Cleveland prospects by MLB Pipeline.

PROSPECTING: Cleveland has experienced a gold rush of prospects, with 5 current Lake County Captains and 6 2023 draftees listed among Cleveland's Top 30 prospects by MLB Pipeline. The latest is C Cooper Ingle, who is MLB Pipeline's No. 30 Cleveland prospect, replacing 2021 Captain and current Triple-A Columbus Clippers SS José Tena, who graduated from prospect status on June 30.

LANSING CONNECTIONS: Lansing Hitting Coach Kevin Kouzmanoff played for Lake County in 2004, and holds the Captains' single-season franchise records for batting average (.330), hits (156), OPS (.920), and doubles (35, since tied). Lugnuts Pitching Coach Don Schultze pitched parts of 3 seasons for Cleveland from 1984-86. He was traded to Cleveland along with Joe Carter and Mel Hall for Rick Sutcliffe. And Lansing RHP Jacob Watters is cousins with Jason Michaels, who played parts of 3 seasons with Cleveland from 2006-08.

LAST TIME OUT: On July 6 versus Dayton, Matt Wilkinson (2-1) earned his 1st High-A home win at Classic Auto Group Park. In arguably his best start as a Captain, Wilkinson pitched 5 shutout innings, allowing 1 hit and 2 walks while striking out 8 in the 3-0 victory.

MINOR LEAGUE RANKS: Wilkinson leads qualified Minor League pitchers with 14.57 strikeouts per nine innings and is second with a 41.7% strikeout rate. He and then-Double-A Akron and current Guardians LHP Logan Allen are the only Cleveland Minor Leaguers since at least 2005 to reach 100+ strikeouts through a team's first 70 games.

ALL ABOARD THE "TUGBOAT": Wilkinson has held the nickname "Tugboat" from a young age. His father's best friend growing up, Phil McNeil, gave Matt the nickname, "after seeing Wilkinson run around the bases at a pace he thought was similar to that of the boat designed to tow larger vessels," MLB.com's Rob Terranova wrote.

TOP 30 PROSPECT: Wilkinson is Cleveland's No. 30 prospect according to Baseball America. Per Baseball America, "Wilkinson gets bushels of whiffs thanks to a flat-plane fastball that has solid life, even if it sits 89-90 mph regularly, making it well below average in velocity. He also spots a fringe-average high-70s slider and mid-70s changeup.

A START FOR THE AGES: On April 25, Wilkinson made Minor League Baseball history in his start against the Myrtle Beach Pelicans (Single-A, CHC). The left-hander pitched 6 scoreless, hitless innings, allowing just 1 walk and throwing 15 strikeouts in 82 pitches (56 strikes).

PITCHER OF THE MONTH: Wilkinson was named the Carolina League Pitcher of the Month for the month of April as a member of the Single-A Lynchburg Hillcats. In 4 starts, he went 2-0 with a 0.44 ERA, a Minor League-best 41 strikeouts, and a Minor League-best .091 opposing AVG.

VALIANT VAQUERO: After initially committing to the University of Washington, Wilkinson pitched collegiately at Central Arizona College (JUCO), where he was 2023 NJCAA Division I Pitcher of the Year, a 2023 NJCAA 1st Team All-American, the 2023 ABCA/Rawlings Pitcher of the Year, and the Arizona Community College Athletic Association Pitcher of the Year.

LITTLE LEAGUE LEGEND: When he was 12 years old, Wilkinson had a remarkable performance at the 2015 Little League World Series as a member of Team Canada. In his only start, he pitched 5 scoreless innings against Team Mexico, allowing just 2 hits and throwing 16 strikeouts in a 1-0 defeat.

MORE ON WILKINSON: Grew up in Ladner, British Columbia, the same hometown as current Los Angeles Dodgers LHP James Paxton. Has 2 Australian Kelpie dogs, Reggie and Mookie, named after Baseball Hall of Famer Reggie Jackson and 8-time MLB All-Star Mookie Betts.

INF/OF Jhonkensy Noel: On Wednesday, June 26, **INF/OF Jhonkensy Noel** made his MLB debut for the Cleveland Guardians on the road against the Baltimore Orioles. He started at first base and batted 9th in the Guardians' order, finishing 1-for-4 with 2 strikeouts. ***In his 1st MLB at-bat, Noel hit a 413-foot solo home run to center field, becoming the 4th player in Cleveland franchise history to homer in his 1st career MLB at-bat.
