FRISCO DROPS OPENER AGAINST MISSIONS:

The Frisco RoughRiders lost their series opener 12-6 to the San Antonio Missions, early Tuesday afternoon at Riders Field. San Antonio (15-25) scored three times in the first inning against **Josh Trentadue** (1-2) on a three-run home run by Braedon Karpathios. In the bottom of the first, Frisco (20-19) tallied three runs of its own to tie the game, boosted by a **Keyber Rodriguez** two-run single and an RBI base hit from Marcus Lee Sang off of Omar Cruz (2-1). The Missions managed two more home runs off of Trentadue, though, to lead off the second inning. After back-to-back blasts from Albert Fabian and Francisco Acuna, San Antonio plated a third run for a 6-3 lead with a sacrifice fly from Ethan Salas. After the Missions took a 7-3 lead in the third, Frisco got back on the board with a sacrifice fly from **Keith Jones II**, which made it 7-4. San Antonio scored once in the sixth on a home run by Kai Roberts, who also plated a run with a double in the eighth at the start of a three-run inning that pushed the Missions' lead to 11-4. The RoughRiders bit back with two solo home runs in the bottom of the eighth, as **Arturo Disla** and Rodriguez left the yard, cutting the deficit to 12-6, which would hold through the final out.

THE BUFFALO HAS ARRIVED:

Arturo Disla, nicknamed "The Buffalo", has been amazing since joining the RoughRiders this week. In 6 games, he is hitting .458 (11-for-24)/.552/.875/1.427 with 1 double, 1 triple, 2 home runs and 10 RBIs. His 2-run, go-ahead triple in the 9th on Saturday was the first triple of his career. In his first 30 games of the season with High-A Hub City, Disla hit .314/.434/.559/.993 with 6 homers and 21 RBIs.

BIG SERIES WIN IN MIDLAND:

The Riders took 4 of 6 games against the RockHounds, tying the season series at 6-6. In the six games, the Riders averaged 7.2 runs per game while slashing .282/.396/.474/.870 with a league-best 18 doubles and 6 homers. Frisco's starting pitchers coming into the series owned a 6.75 ERA and averaged just 4.0 IP/GS. In the series, they carried a 4.82 ERA while averaging 4.2 IP/GS. **Blake Townsend** owned the best start in the series, going 7.1 innings on Wednesday, becoming just the second RoughRider starting pitcher to record an out in the eighth inning since 2018, joining **Nick Krauth** who did so in 2023. It was the longest start of any Double-A pitcher this year and tied for the 4th-longest start in Minor League Baseball.

COREY'S IN THE HOUSE:

Riders infielder **Corey Joyce** continues to impress on the offensive side this year for the Riders. After being signed as a MiLB free agent on April 8th, he joined the Riders on April 14th. In 24 total games, he is hitting .310 (27-for-87)/.384/.609/.993 with 5 doubles, 7 home runs and 22 RBIs. With Double-A Knoxville in the Cubs organization last year, he hit just 2 home runs in 92 games with a .272/.393/.347/.740 slashline.

KEYBRRRRR, IT'S COLD IN HERE:

Frisco infielder **Keyber Rodriguez** has been one of the best hitters in the Texas League this season. He is now hitting .320/.349/.523/.872 this year and is batting .351 (26-for-74)/.390/.568/.958 in his last 17 games. His 7 3-hit games this year lead Double-A. He is 3rd in the league in batting average (.320), 1st in hits (49), T-1st in doubles (12), T-4th in extra-base hits (19) and T-2nd in total bases (80). While he is slugging .523 this year, his previous state-side career high was .385 in 2021 with Low-A Down East.

GET RICH OR DIE DREILING:

RoughRiders outfielder **Dylan Dreiling** has been hitting well recently. The No. 10 prospect won Texas League Player of the Week two weeks ago, hitting .368 (7-for-19)/.520/1.000/1.520 with 4 home runs, 8 RBIs, 6 walks and 7 runs scored. Over his last 11 games, he is hitting .350 (14-for-40)/.519/.675/1.194 with 1 double, 4 home runs, 9 RBIs, 14 walks and 6 strikeouts.

GIMME THAT OFFENSE EARLY AND OFTEN:

The RoughRiders have been swinging the bat well in their last 21 games, going 12-9. During the stretch, they have scored 150 runs to lead the league (7.1 R/G), slashing .270/.379/.457/.836 with 30 home runs. Frisco's 41 runs in the first inning this year are tied for 3rd in the minors, hitting .316 (50-for-158) in the first with 8 home runs. They have scored in the first inning in 17 games and have scored multiple runs in the first inning in 12 games this season. When scoring 7 or fewer runs, the Riders are 7-18 (including a combined 2-8 record when scoring 6 or 7 runs) and 13-1 when scoring 8 and more. Frisco is 8-12 in 1 or 2-run games.

LEE SANG IT AND BANG IT:

Marcus Lee Sang has helped to carry the Frisco offense in the last three weeks. In his last 26 games, he has slashed .320 (31-for-97)/.400/.567/.967 with 6 doubles, 6 home runs and 23 RBIs.

YOU WANT THE HITS, WE GOT UM:

Through 39 games the RoughRiders are 1st in the Texas League with 365 hits. They are first in the league in batting average (.273) and 1st in runs (258, 6.6 runs per game). The RoughRiders have not led the Texas League in batting average since 2014. Frisco has scored 8 or more runs in 37 percent of their games (14-of-38). The Riders are T-2nd in the Texas League in homers (55) while they are 1st in SLG (.456) and 1st in OPS (.825). For perspective, the Wind Surge led the league last year with a .780 team OPS.

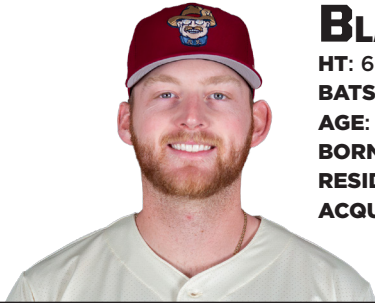

ABOUT BLAKE

-Australian native pitched for Team Australia in both the 2023 and 2026 World Baseball Classics. In 2023, he threw 1.0 scoreless inning before tossing two scoreless outings (2.1 innings) in 2026, including inducing a lineup to right field from Shohei Ohtani.

-Before the WBC, he was a member of the Australian National Team at the U-15 baseball World Cup in Iwaki, Japan in 2016.

-Pitched for the U-18 Australian Team against extended Spring Training Major League teams in 2018, leading to his signing by the Mariners on June 19th, 2018.

-After seven years with the Mariners, he was released in August of 2024 and signed by the Pirates, where he pitched for 2025 as well after resigning in the offseason.

-He elected free agency following 2025 and signed with the Rangers on January 23rd, 2026.

2026 SEASON

-Enters the season in the RoughRiders starting rotation.

-On May 13th at Midland, threw 7.1 shutout innings, his longest outing of his career. He became the second RoughRiders starter has recorded an out in the 8th since 2018 (Nick Krauth on 9/10/23: 7.1 IP).

2025 SEASON

-Among MiLB pitchers who threw at least 90.0 innings, he was 4th in the minors with a 1.76 ERA.

-Had just a 0.97 ERA through his first 25 games (six starts), allowing earned runs in just six of those outings.

-In his last 9G/6GS, went 1-2 with a 3.62 ERA.

2024 SEASON

-Pitched between Seattle and Pittsburgh organizations.

-2.35 ERA on the season over 38.1 IP was 84th in all of MiLB among relievers (0 starts) with at least 30.0 IP.

2023 SEASON

-All 35 games were in relief in 2023 for Low-A Modesto, finishing fifth on the team in appearances.

-Held opponents to a .221/.324/.293/.617 slashline

2022 SEASON

-Split time between four levels, including two games in Triple-A Tacoma, striking out 37 batters in 29.1 innings.

-Starting the season in Tacoma, he retired former MLB players Nate Mondou and Luis Barrera in his second appearance.

2019 SEASON

-Missed a majority of the season, undergoing "Tommy John" surgery, performed in August.

CHAD COMER

Years with Rangers: 10

Years with RoughRiders: 2 (1st as manager)

Comer returns to Double-A Frisco in 2026 after managing at the High-A level over the last three seasons. The native of Mansfield, Texas will enter his 10th season with the Rangers and his second in Frisco.

In 2022, Comer helped pilot the Riders to their second Texas League Championship in franchise history, serving as a development coach. Over the last three seasons, Comer managed High-A Hickory (2023-2024) and High-A Hub City (2025), going 197-191 (.508).

Prior to Frisco, Comer was the hitting coach for the High-A Hickory Crawdads in 2021, after serving as a coach at various levels of the Rangers system from 2016-2019.

The former University of Texas at Arlington catcher played two seasons in the Atlanta Braves organization, reaching High-A Lynchburg in 2012. He was drafted by Atlanta in the 29th round of the 2011 draft after four seasons at UTA.

THOMAS ST. CLAIR

Years with Rangers: 5

Years with RoughRiders: 1

St. Clair joins the Riders as the pitching coach after leading a Hub City staff that finished third in the SAL with a 3.50 ERA in 2025. St. Clair also will serve as the assistant pitching coordinator in the Rangers farm system in 2026.

Initially, St. Clair came to the Rangers as a coach in the Dominican Summer League in 2022 before serving as a pitching coach for the ACL Rangers from 2022-23. Before professional baseball, he spent two and a half years as pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at North Carolina Wesleyan College.

The right-hander pitched three professional seasons in the St. Louis Cardinals system from 2017-19 after he was picked in the 24th round of the 2017 June draft, making 88 outings for the organization's Rookie and Single-A affiliates.

The Winston-Salem, North Carolina native played four years (2014-17) at Division II Lenior-Rhyne University in Hickory, N.C.

HITTING COACH

JASON HART

Years with Rangers: 13

Years with RoughRiders: 9

Hart returns as the hitting coach in Frisco for the first time since he served as the RoughRiders hitting coach from 2012-2019. Before that, most recently, he was the Major League hitting assistant for the Miami Marlins under current Rangers manager Skip Schumaker.

In 2015, Hart was named the Mike Coolbaugh Texas League Coach of the Year for his work with the Riders hitters. Prior to joining Frisco, Hart spent two seasons as the hitting coach with Low-A Hickory. His tenure with the Rangers began after he assisted the Single-A Clinton staff with coaching responsibilities for a portion of the 2008 season and continued when he accepted the role of hitting coach for the Arizona Rangers before the 2009 campaign.

Hart played professionally for parts of eight seasons from 1998-2006, with stints in the Oakland, Texas and Minnesota organizations. He made his Major League debut with the Rangers in 2002, when he batted .267 (4-for-15) with three doubles over a span of 10 games. He missed the 2004 campaign following the removal of a benign brain tumor, but returned to the field in 2005 and hit 21 home runs in 128 games with Frisco.

Originally drafted by Oakland in the fifth round of the 1998 draft, Hart was acquired by Texas in a January 2002 trade with the Athletics. He attended Southwest Missouri State University, where he paced the conference in homers in 1997 and was named a Missouri Valley Conference All-Star in 1998.

Hernandez joins the RoughRiders for his first season with the Rangers organization.

During 2020, Hernandez managed the Texas Collegiate League Frisco RoughRiders after the MiLB season had been canceled. In 2025, he served as a bench coach for Triple-A Jacksonville and spent 19 seasons with the Marlins as a coach and coordinator. As part of that stint, he served eight seasons as a manager, most recently in 2022 with High-A Beloit.

Hernandez started his coaching career at the University of Mobile in 1993 as a hitting coach and stayed there through 2001. From 2005-2006, Hernandez served as the hitting coach for the Independent Pensacola Pelicans.

Before joining the professional ranks, Sullenger led the baseball program as head coach at Biola University in La Mirada, California, from 2013-2018.

Additionally, he worked one season in stadium operations for the Tampa Bay Rays. Sullenger attended Spotswood (Va.) High School and went on to play baseball at Florida Southern College (one season) and Liberty University (three seasons).

He holds a bachelor's degree from Liberty and earned a master's degree in Kinesiology with a focus in Athletic Administration/Coaching from James Madison in 2003.

Brown makes his Double-A debut in 2026. Before being the athletic trainer for High-A Hub City in 2025, Brown was the ACL Rangers athletic trainer in 2024.

Brown was also a student athletic trainer at Slinger (Wisc.) High School (2022) and Carroll University in Waukesha, Wisc. (2021).

The Louisville, Ky. native holds an associate's degree in Biology (McHenry County College), a Bachelor's degree in Exercise Science (Upper Iowa University), and a Master's in Athletic Training (Carroll University).

Platts is back with the RoughRiders for his third season and his fourth in the Rangers organization in 2026.
