CORPUS CHRISTI HOOKS (21-41) vs. SPRINGFIELD CARDINALS (38-25)

LHP BRODY RODNING (0-1, 10.03 ERA) vs. RHP LHP BRYCEN MAUTZ (1-0, 3.18 ERA)

SETTING THE SCENE: The Cardinals take on the Hooks (HOU) in the 1st game of a 6-game series and 7th of a 12-game homestand ... are 6-0 this homestand after sweeping TUL ... are on a season-best 7-game win streak and are 11-1 in last 12 games ... tonight is a Great Southern Bank \$2 Tuesday.

FIRST THINGS FIRST: Springfield enters the day in 1st place in the North Division, 4.0 games ahead of WCH ... magic number to win the 1st Half title is 3 with 6 games to play ... at 38-25, SGF is a season-high 13 games above .500 and holds the best record in the Texas League.

KING OF THE NORTH: Springfield is vying to win back-to-back 1st Half titles for the first time in franchise history ... 2024 team clinched on final day of half with a 37-32 record ... has won four 1st Halves all-time (2007, 2009, 2016, 2024).

MAUTZ ON MOUND: LHP Brycen Mautz makes his 11th start and 1st vs. CC this season ... picked up his 1st win and recorded his 1st quality start after 6.0-shutout IP on 6/11 vs. TUL ... allowed only 2 hits and struck out a season-high 9 ... has allowed 2-or-fewer runs in 6-straight starts.

SUNDAY FUN DAY: The Cardinals picked up 2 wins over TUL on Sunday ... won 6-4 in the completion of Saturday's SUSP game ... rallied for 3 runs in the 8th with a game-tying HR from IF Ramon Mendoza and go-ahead 2B from IF JJ Wetherholt ... C Carlos Linarez hit a grand slam as part of a 7-run 4th to help the club to a 7-1 win in Sunday's originally scheduled game.

WETHER HEATING UP: IF JJ Wetherholt ranks 1st in the TL with a .323 AVG and .444 OBP ... posted multi-hits in 8-of-last-10 games ... is batting .486 (18x37) in June with 12 walks and a .620 OBP.

FEEL THE BERN: C Leonardo Bernal is tied for 1st in TL with 11 HR and ranks 2nd with 40 RBI and a .930 OPS ... hitting .432 (19x44) in June with 5 HR, 15 RBI, and a 1.288 OPS.

X MAN: LHP Ixan Henderson lowered his league-leading ERA to 1.95 on Thursday after allowing 1 run over a season-high 6.2 IP ... struck out 5 and allowed only 2 hits ... also leads the TL with 70 strikeouts and a .204 OBA ... in last 3 starts, has allowed 1 ER over 19.0 IP (0.47 ERA).

AIN'T IT SWEEP: Springfield's sweep over TUL was its 1st series sweep at home April 9-14, 2024 vs. NWA and 1st sweep overall since July 1-3, 2024 at NWA.

LAST IN THE PAST: The Cardinals are 26-9 in 35 games since dropping to 5th place in the North Division at 12-16 on 5/7.

BAITING THE HOOKS: Tonight's game is the 1st of 12 in the season series with CC and 1st of 6 at Hammons Field ... club's will match up in Texas for a 6-game series, July 8-13.
