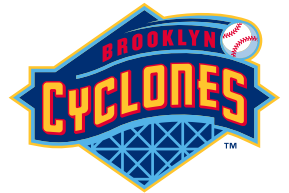

LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn dropped their 3rd-straight contest in a 4-3 loss vs. Wilmington on Tuesday night at Maimonides Park...Brooklyn took a 1-0 lead on a wild pitch and tied the game at 3 in the 4th on a 2-run single by SS **Kevin Kendall**...SS **Jordy Barley** reached base 4 times and stole 3 bases for Wilmington...The 23-year-old slapped an RBI single in the 4th and added a go-ahead solo home run to left in the 7th...RHP **Jeffrey Colón** struck out 5 for the 'Clones, while RHP **Rodney Theophile** whiffed 4 for the Blue Rocks, as both took no-decisions...RHP **Nick Pogue** went 3.0 frames for the win and RHP **Jack Sinclair** added 2.0 scoreless for the save...RHP **Manny Rodriguez** permitted just 1 hit, but suffered the loss...Wilmington relievers retired the last 13 Brooklyn hitters in order.

FULLY LOADED: Prior to Opening Day, *Baseball America* ranked the Brooklyn Cyclones as having the fourth most-talented roster in all of Minor League Baseball...The 'Clones are the highest rated non-Triple-A squad, falling just behind the Norfolk Tides (1), Durham Bulls (2), and Columbus Clippers (3)...Brooklyn is the lone South Atlantic League team and A-level club to be recognized within the Top 10.

KENDALL KEEPING ON: INF **Kevin Kendall** has reached base safely in 9-straight games to start his Brooklyn career...After being limited to just 3 games last year due to injury, the former UCLA Bruin is second in the South Atlantic League in triples (2)...Entering play on Wednesday, Kendall is tied for 2nd on the Cyclones in walks (8), and 4th in total bases (12) and on-base percentage (.356).

STAN THE MAN OF Stanley Consuegra was named South Atlantic League Player of the Week (April 10-16) on Monday...During last week's series in Winston-Salem, Consuegra was 9-for-24 (.375) with 2 doubles, 3 home runs, and 10 RBI...The 22-year-old tied a career-best with 4 hits and fell one RBI short of matching his career-best with 4 RBI last Thursday...The Dominican native's previous 4-hit night came with Brooklyn on July 13, 2022, vs. Greensboro...Coming into Wednesday, Consuegra is tied for the SAL lead in home runs (3)...He is tied for 2nd in extra-base hits (6) and total bases (23), tied for 3rd in RBI (10) and doubles (3), tied for 5th in hits (11).

PARADA POWER: C **Kevin Parada** is off to marvelous start in his first full professional season...The No. 11 pick in last year's MLB draft has reached base in all 9 games played in Brooklyn...Parada has coaxed more walks (10) than strikeouts (8) in 42 plate appearances...The Pasadena, Calif. native enters Wednesday's matchup tied for 2nd in the league lead in runs scored (9) and walks (10).

RED HOT RAMÍREZ: OF **Alex Ramírez** comes into rides a season-high 5-game hitting streak on Wednesday...The 20-year-old is 8-for-his-last-20 (.400) with 4 runs scored, 2 doubles, a home run, 5 RBI, and 3 walks...The outfielder is tied for 5th in the SAL in hits (11).

vs. WILMINGTON: Brooklyn returns home for a 6-game set against the Nationals' High-A affiliate. The Dash boast 5 of the Nats' top 30 prospects per *Baseball America*...OF **James Wood** (1), OF **Jeremy De La Rosa** (8), OF **T.J. White** (10), RHP **Andry Lara** (15), and INF **Trey Lipscomb** (24)...The Cyclones went 13-14 in 27 matchups against the Blue Rocks in 2022...Brooklyn and Wilmington split 10 games at Maimonides Park last season...The Cyclones are 14-8 all-time at home vs. Wilmington.

KING CÉSAR: INF **César Berbesi** has bounced back from an injury-plagued 2022 in style...The 23-year-old has reached base in each of his first 6 games in 2023...Berbesi is 8-for-21 (.381) at the plate with 7 runs scored, a triple, and 4 RBI...Berbesi enters Wednesday's game leading the SAL in on-base percentage (.567)...He is also 4th in batting average (.381), tied for 6th in walks (8), and 9th in OPS (1.043)...Berbesi has walked 74 times compared to only 83 strikeouts in 102 career games.

GRAB SOME PINE: Brooklyn pitching racked up strikeouts in bunches on Friday night...Cyclones pitchers combined to whiff a season-high 17 Winston-Salem hitters in an 8-3 victory...RHP **Raimon Gómez** punched out a career-high 7 over 3.0 frames to start...LHP **Daniel Juárez** (5), RHP **Manny Rodriguez** (3), and RHP **Jace Beck** (2) united to retire 10 in relief...The 17 K's are the most for Brooklyn pitching since they reached that number in an 18-1 win at Jersey Shore on August 28, 2022...The 17 strikeouts are tied for the most by a pitching staff in a South Atlantic League game this year...Aberdeen and Greenville also struck out 17 on April 8 and 15, respectively.

2022 IN REVIEW: The Cyclones finished the 2022 campaign with an overall mark of 70-62...Brooklyn snared the South Atlantic League North Division crown in the second half, finishing 2.0 games ahead of Hudson Valley with a mark of 40-26...The 'Clones earned an 8-1 win at home vs. Aberdeen in the opening game of the Division Championship before dropping the final two games of the series on the road.

'NEW' MAN IN CHARGE: Chris Newell takes over as the manager of the Brooklyn Cyclones in 2023 after serving as the team's bench coach in 2022...Newell served as skipper of the Birmingham-Bloomfield Beavers of the United Shore Professional Baseball League from 2016-19...The 49-year-old won consecutive championships (2017-18) and was named Manager of the Year three times (2016-18)...Including 2023, holds a career record of 108-97 (.527).

PROSPECTS: Brooklyn hosts three of the Mets Top 10 prospects, according to *MLB Pipeline* and *Baseball America*...They include C **Kevin Parada** (No. 3 *MLB Pipeline*/No. 4 *Baseball America*), OF **Alex Ramírez** (4/5), and RHP **Blade Tidwell** (7/9)...OF **Stanley Consuegra** ranks as the organization's No. 21 farmhand per *MLB Pipeline*.

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered the loss in his 2023 season debut at Winston-Salem...Entered in relief of RHP **Jeffrey Colón** in the bottom of the 5th and the Cyclones leading, 7-6...Yielded a career-high-tying 6 runs (5 earned) over 1.2 innings...Walked 2 and struck out 1...Hit a batter... Threw 38 pitches (21 strikes)...Relieved by RHP **Trey McLoughlin** with the bases empty and two out in the bottom of the 6th and Winston-Salem in front, 12-7...Dash went on to win by that final.

PROSPECT RADAR: While not currently ranked, Suárez was deemed the Mets' No. 30 prospect entering the 2022 season by *Baseball America*... Considered the No. 25 farmhand entering 2021.

2022: Placed on Single-A St. Lucie's 60-day injured list to start the season...Sent on a rehab assignment with the Florida Complex League Mets on August 12...Tallied a 1-1 record with a 3.97 ERA (5 ER in 11.1 IP) and 12 strikeouts in 6 games (3 starts)...Returned to St. Lucie on August 23...Registered an 0-2 mark with a 7.20 ERA (8 ER in 10.0 IP) and 13 K's in 4 appearances (2 starts).

COMEBACK TRAIL: Suárez is participating in his first full season since the 2019 campaign...The 23-year-old made 6 starts with Single-A St. Lucie in 2021 before undergoing Tommy John surgery in June...Made his return to play in game one of a doubleheader with the FCL Mets vs. the FCL Cardinals on July 14, 2022.
