Today: The Lansing Lugnuts, the High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, play the finale in a six-game series at the Lake County Captains, High-A affiliate of the

Cleveland Guardians, the sixth of 18 meetings between the two clubs this year. A victory would give the Nuts their first series win of the year; they enter today having won three of the first five games in the series.

On the Air: Logan Potosky and Tyler Danburg deliver the call via Bally Live and MiLB TV, while Jesse Goldberg-Strassler and Adam Jaksa are on StreamGuys.

Yesterday: Captains 12, Lugnuts 4. The Lugnuts knocked out Lake County starter Carter Spivey with a four-run 1st inning, capped by an Euribiel Ángeles three-run double, but Lake County answered with 12 straight runs between the second and the fourth innings to take the victory.

On Deck: After an off day tomorrow, the Lugnuts return to Lansing for a 12-game, 13-day homestand against the Dayton Dragons and South Bend Cubs, followed by a six-game series at the Great Lakes Loons and then a six-game homestand against these same Lake County Captains.

### Lug•Notes

EMU to The Show: The Lugnuts' first debuting Major Leaguer this year is 2021 super utilityman Max Schuemann, who made his Major League debut on April 12 as a pinch-runner for the Oakland Athletics, scoring the game-winning run in the bottom of the 10th, and followed up yesterday with a solo home run for his first MLB hit (in a 6-3 A's loss at Cleveland).

Sizzling: Euribiel Ángeles went 1-for-4 with a three-run double last night and is now 10-for-20 in this series, with three doubles, one triple, one home run, three stolen bases and seven RBIs in five games.

Streaking: Will Simpson went 1-for-3 with an RBI single and a walk last night, extending his on-base streak to 13 consecutive games to open the season.

Ladies and Gentlemen: The weeknd has proved troublesome for the Lugnuts this year, posting a 6-2 record from Tuesday through Friday (and allowing an average of 3.7 runs/game) while going 0-6 on Saturday and Sunday (allowing an average of 9.8 runs/game).

Powering On: The Lugs had hit only two home runs in their first nine games before knocking seven homers in the first four games of this series – including a home run by Brayan Buelvas in each of the three games and a pair of home runs from Henry Bolte.

League Leaderboard: The Nuts are tied for 2nd in the league in walks (68) and triples (4) as a team. Brayan Buelvas and Henry Bolte are tied for 2nd in the Midwest League in home runs (3); Buelvas is 3rd in runs scored (12) and tied for 5th in walks (11); Will Simpson is 1st in walks (15), 3rd in on-base percentage (.491) and tied for 5th in RBIs (10); James González is 2nd in ERA (0.79), 3rd in WHIP (0.71) and 7th in opponent batting average (.175); Garrett Irvin is tied for 1st in appearances (5), albeit it's a 23-way tie.

A Grand Start: On April 3, first baseman Will Simpson crushed a grand slam (as well as a solo shot) in an 18-0 victory over Michigan State in the Crosstown Showdown. Ten days later, Simpson launched a grand slam off the Great Lakes Loons in an 8-5 loss.

Prospecting: The Nuts' Opening Day roster includes two MLB Pipeline Top 30 A's prospects in outfielder Henry Bolte (No. 12) and first baseman Will Simpson (No. 30). Bolte, the A's No. 2 outfield prospect, was selected 56th overall in 2022 from Palo Alto High School, where he led all California high schoolers with 13 home runs. He spent the 2023 season with Single-A Stockton, where he slashed .257/.356/.421 in 112 games, collecting 17 doubles, five triples, 14 home runs and 32 stolen bases. Simpson, the A's No. 2 first base prospect, impressed with a .319/ .367/.543 line in his professional debut after he was drafted in the 15th round from Washington last year.

### **Today in Lugnuts History**

**2022:** Austin Beck homered and delivered an RBI single and Grant Holman whiffed seven TinCaps in six innings to help the Lugnuts beat Fort Wayne, 2-0, in one hour and 59 minutes at Jackson Field. The TinCaps had scored 19 runs in the first two games of the series.

**Happy Birthday!** Jordan Romano (1993), drafted in the 10th round in 2014 from Oral Roberts University, a Canadian catcher converted to pitcher, who missed all of 2015 due to injury, and then made his Midwest League debut in Game 1 of a doubleheader vs. Great Lakes on June 13, 2016, by throwing a seven-inning complete game (two hits, one run, zero walks, seven strikeouts) in a 4-1 win. Romano followed up with five hitless innings in Game 2 of a doubleheader on July 14 at Peoria – a combined six-inning no hitter with Josh DeGraaf that the Lugnuts lost, 1-0. His best performance came August 24 at Dayton: six shutout two-hit innings, striking out 10 Dragons. He made his MLB debut for the Blue Jays on June 12, 2019, and has been named an American League All-Star each of the last two seasons, saving 36 games each campaign.

In a Nutshell: One of five undrafted free agents on the Lugnuts, joining fellow pitchers Dylan Hall, Garrett Irvin and Jack Owen, and outfielder Cameron Masterman... last lowa player to suit up for Lansing: former Major League lefty Matt Dermody... started the Crosstown Showdown against Michigan State and tossed four scoreless two-hit innings in 18-0 Lugnuts win, April 3... 75-pitch limit / 5-inning limit today.

**Family of Athletes:** Father, Rob, played college baseball at Central College of Iowa, located in his hometown of Pella, as did both of his brothers, Jordan and Blake; his mother, Shannon, played golf in college.

At Pella High School: 2016 lowa Gatorade Player of the Year as a senior... Des Moines Register's All-lowa Baseball Player of the Year as both a junior and a senior, 2015 and 2016... 2015 Perfect Game Underclass High Honorable Mention... as a senior: 10-1, 0.64 ERA, 123 K, batting .421 with six homers and 12 steals... as a junior: 11-1, 0.56 ERA, 74 IP, 112 K, 10 BB, batting .520 with 14 doubles, nine triples, 13 homers, 57 RBIs, 51 runs, 15 steals... in his high school career, won 28 career games and totaled 337 career strikeouts.

Onward to Des Moines: Entered the Big Ten ranked by Baseball America as the No. 8 freshman... two-way player in 2017, hitting .270 in 31 starts as a DH (and three starts as a pitcher hitting for himself)... 2018 Academic All-Big Ten... No. 3 starter in 2019; 2019 Collegiate Baseball Player National Pitcher of the Week (Feb. 18), tossing six no-hit innings with 11 strikeouts; ranked 7th in the Big Ten in ERA (2.72)... No. 2 starter in 2020 before season was halted early due to the pandemic: 2-0, 3.00, 4 GS, 21 IP, 24 K, 5 BB... signed with the Athletics following the shortened five-round draft.

**International Stage:** With lowa, took part in the 2017 World University Games in Taipei City, winning a silver medal (fell to Japan in the gold medal contest)... part of the first American team to ever advance to the gold medal game as well as the first American team to ever medal, period... team finished 5-2, losing only to Japan... started five games, four at first base, one at pitcher.

**In a Nutshell:** Opens second Midwest League season in a pitching piggyback tandem with Grant Judkins... 45-pitch limit tonight... @JakeGarland25.

Hometown Hero: Started four years for Jupiter High School varsity baseball ("Warriors," wearing green and gold)... totaled 229 strikeouts, 1.49 ERA and 1.13 WHIP... named two-time FHSAA All-State... honored twice as the 9A Player of the Year... also from Jupiter H.S.: Miles Mikolas and Dante Bichette (but not son Bo, who attended Lakewood High School in St. Petersburg)... family originally from New England before moving to Florida shortly before he was born; the Garlands all root for Boston-area teams.


**Jupiter?** How did Jake's hometown receive its name? The Hobe tribe lived in the area, a Spanish mapmaker miswrote their name as Jobe, which was then miswritten again as Jove, which was then mistranslated to Jupiter. Misunderstandings the whole way down to the city's incorporation in 1925. Jupiter is located on the eastern coast of Florida in Palm Beach County on the Atlantic Ocean.

The Bandit Connection: Burt Reynolds was born in Lansing in 1936, and died in Jupiter in 2018.

**The U:** Attended the University of Miami (Coral Gables), a baseball program founded in 1940 with four NCAA championships and 25 CWS appearances... played for head coach Gino DiMare... true freshman year was the pandemic-shortened 2020 season, making six relief appearances before the year was shut down... returned in 2021 as a member of the rotation: 16 games, 13 starts, totaling a team-high 68 innings (5.69 ERA, 38 K, 14 BB, .286 avg.)... improved in 2022 to a 3.99 ERA in 65 1/3 innings (54 K, 11 BB, lowering home runs from 10 to four)... fifth of six Hurricanes drafted in 2022, going 514th overall in the 17th round to Oakland... the last Miami product drafted by the A's: Jemile Weeks (1st round, 12th overall, 2008)... two other Hurricanes have played for the Lugnuts: 3B Mark Sobolewski and OF Adam Finnieston.

**Professional Debut:** After signing for \$100,000, made three appearances, one start, for the Arizona Complex League A's, tossing three total innings.

2023 Season: Opened the campaign pitching in relief in Stockton's second game of the year, started by rehabbing American League All-Star Paul Blackburn... earned the honor of California League Pitcher of the Week with his very next outing, firing five perfect innings on April 13 at Fresno with seven strikeouts (69 pitches, 47 strikes)... finished his time in Stockton with back to back six-inning outings against Fresno and Rancho Cucamonga before getting called up to the Lugnuts to replace Jorge Juan on May 15... dominated in Lugnuts debut May 18 vs. Lake County: 95 pitches, 59 strikes, 7 innings, 2 hits, 1 run, 2 walks, 10 strikeouts, in 5-2 win.
