TODAY'S GAME: The Curve open their first series of the season with the Richmond Flying Squirrels, the lone series in the first half of the season between the clubs.

LAST TIME OUT: The Curve dropped the series with Portland, falling 10-4 in the series finale. Joe Perez had 2 RBI in the defeat.

BULLPEN TROUBLES: Altoona's bullpen has blown 11 of 21 save chances this season, second-most by a Double-A club behind the Akron RubberDucks (12 blown saves). Altoona's 5.66 bullpen ERA is last among 30 Double-A clubs, 108th among 120 minor league teams

DEJA VU: In back-to-back games against Portland on May 31 and June 1, the Curve had their hearts ripped out by a game-tying homer from Portland's Kyle Teel.

A 'CRAFT FIT TO CARRY THE CURVE: Right-hander Braxton Ashcraft turned in one of the best calendar months in franchise history on the mound in May. He had the team's highest strikeout performance (10), recorded a 6.0-inning complete game and threw 14.2 consecutive scoreless innings across four outings (5/2 - 5/19). Entering the month of June, his 4.2% walk-rate was the 4th-lowest among Double-A pitchers that have thrown at least 40.0 IP, and also ranks 5th in Swinging Strike% (whiffs divided by total number of pitches) and 6th in K-BB%. In the month of May he ranked 5th in the Eastern League in ERA (1.95), T-1st in SO (39), T-1st in CG (1), 4th in IP (39.0) and 5th in WHIP (0.99).

GRAND PEREZ: Joe Perez hit this 49th Grand Slam in franchise history on Friday, May 31 against Portland. With the Curve trailing 3-1, Perez rocked the first pitch he saw from Robert Kwiatkowski into the left field bleachers to take a 4-3 lead and Carter Bins followed with a solo blast for the 53rd instance of back-to-back home runs. Altoona last had back-to-back home runs on April 11, 2023 when **Domingo Leyba** and **Matt Fraizer** went back-to-back at Erie. **Andres Alvarez** recorded the last Grand Slam on May 25, 2023.

SULLY DOMINATES: Righty Sean Sullivan has picked up right where he left off in 2023 in the Curve rotation. Sullivan tossed 18.0 consecutive scoreless innings (5/7 - 5/28), the longest streak by a Curve pitcher since Roansy Contreras began the 2021 season with 18.2 scoreless innings. In his time with Altoona he has allowed 2 runs or fewer in 20-of-31 starts and his 3.12 ERA ranks 10th in the Eastern League.

BEER'S ALL AROUND: Infielder Seth Beer has been one of the Curve's most consistent hitters this season. Beer's reached in 19-of-21 games since May 3, during which he's hitting .321/.402/.469 with 4 2B, 1 3B, 2 HR, 5 RBI. His .296 batting average this season ranks 7th in the Eastern League entering play on Tuesday, June 4.

NOWHERE TO GO BUT UP: Through April and May, Altoona had the 3rd-worst record among professional baseball teams with an 16-33 record. The Curve were the last team in the affiliated minors to win 10 games. The Chattanooga Lookouts (Reds, Southern League) hold the worst record in professional baseball at 14-35. Altoona's 16-33 start is the worst record for the club through 49 games in franchise history, matching the 2009 Curve who started the season 17-32. The 5 wins in the month of April were the fewest for the team in a calendar month in which they played at least 15 games.

THE SQUIRRELS IN FLIGHT: Dennis Pelfrey returns for his third season as Manager for Richmond. Pelfrey led Richmond to the post-season in 2023, their first appearance since 2014 and enters this season ranked second on the club's all-time Managerial wins list. Grant McCray has been one of their most consistent players this season, entering the series he leads the club in HR (6), RBI (23), runs (27) and stolen bases (6). Richmond is 12-6 since going 1-12 over a 13-game stretch from April 28-May 12. They won 5-of-6 in back-to-back series before splitting last week's series with Erie, 3-3. John Michael Bertrand and Grant McCray swept the Eastern League's weekly awards after their series in Bowie two weeks ago. Seven of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the roster, including Hayden Birdsong (No. 6), Grant McCray (No. 10), Vaun Brown (No. 11), Eric Silva (No. 22), Adrián Sugastey (No. 25), Ryan Murphy (No. 28) and José Cruz (No. 30)

THE FIRST IN FLIGHT: John Michael Bertrand takes the ball on Tuesday night. Bertrand has been on fire of late, tossing 13 consecutive hitless innings over his last two starts. Bertrand is the second Flying Squirrel in team history to earn two EL Pitcher of the Week awards in the same season, first since Eric Surkamp in 2011. Bertrand was San Francisco's 10th round pick in 2022 ut of Notre Dame and reached Richmond for 11 starts in 2023 where he recorded a 4.67 ERA. Bertrand tossed 5.0 scoreless innings against the Curve on August 4, 2023 allowing just 2 hits and 2 walks in his outing. Bertrand began his college career at Furman where he pitched for three seasons before finishing at Notre Dame, his father Jim rowed collegiately at the University of San Diego and his brother JD was a linebacker and team captain for Notre Dame's Football team.
