LAST TIME OUT...

WORCESTER, Mass. (August 18, 2021) – The Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders never trailed as they defeated the Worcester Red Sox 9-1 on Wednesday night at Polar Park.

In his Triple-A debut, Yankees No. 2 prospect Clarke Schmidt allowed one run on three hits in 3.1 innings. He walked one and struck out four while throwing 62 pitches in his first start off a rehab assignment for an injury suffered pre-season. Miguel Andujar went 0-for-2 with a walk while playing four innings in left field in the second game of his MLB rehab assignment.

The RailRiders took the lead four batters into the game when Chris Gittens launched a mammoth two-run home run to left off Kyle Hart (4-7). The round-tripper was his third in his last four games with SWB and his 10th of the season, tying him with Hoy Park for the team lead.

Worcester tallied a run against Schmidt in the bottom of the second on a solo home run from Josh Ockimey to cut the deficit to 2-1. However, the RailRiders added to the lead in the top of the fourth with an RBI single by Armando Alvarez. Rob Brantly cracked a two-run home run off MLB rehabber Ryan Brasier in the sixth to extend the lead to 5-1. The RailRiders added runs in the seventh and eighth off Jose Adames courtesy of an Estevan Florial double and a Max Burt single to swell their advantage to 7-1.

Brian Keller (1-1) was terrific in 3.2 innings of relief in back of Schmidt, allowing just one hit while striking out five. Brooks Kriske worked around a two-out double in the eighth to keep the WooSox off the board. In the top of the ninth SWB, Brantly brought in two more runs with a single to left to grow the lead to 9-1. Brantly finished the game 2-for-5 with a home run and four RBIs. Braden Bristo set the Red Sox down in the bottom of the ninth to close out the win.

NEWS & NOTES

DIFFERENTIAL EQUATION: The Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders pounded out 11 hits including seven extra-base hits on Wednesday night's 9-1 victory over the Worcester Red Sox. Astonishingly, that was the ninth win of the season for the RailRiders by a margin of eight-or-more runs. However, it was the team's first such win since an 8-0 win over Rochester on July 21, a game more noted for being a combined no-hitter. The RailRiders took home six victories by eight-or-more runs in their first 45 games of the season, but have only done so three times in their last 43. Scranton/Wilkes-Barre is +103 in run differential this year, third-best in Triple-A behind Durham (+175) and Buffalo (+112).

WE'RE GETTING THE BAND BACK TOGETHER: Since mid-July the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders roster has been radically changed owing to injuries, two COVID-19 outbreaks and the taxi squad, but the roster is beginning to resemble its old self. **Chris Gittens** has been activated off the injured list and optioned to the RailRiders, while **Trey Amburgey** continues to be with the RailRiders on an MLB rehab assignment. Catchers **Rob Brantly** and **Max McDowell** are back after stints as a COVID replacement player and on the taxi squad, respectively. Outfielder **Matt Pita** is back from a leg injury, and RHPs **Sal Romano** and **Nick Goody** have re-signed minor league contracts with the Yankees after leaving the organization in July. RHPs **Stephen Ridings** and **Nick Nelson** have also been returned by the Yankees, but are yet to report.

STARTING SLOW: The RailRiders sport a 3.96 ERA as a team through 88 games this season, but starting pitching has been a weak spot for the team. Starters have pitched to the tune of a 12-20 record and a 5.21 ERA, while the bullpen is 41-15 with a 3.02 ERA. SWB starters have lasted an average of just over 3.2 innings per start this season, and have sported a 5.54 RA/9 (both earned and unearned runs allowed per game on an ERA scale). Meanwhile the RailRiders have the second-best bullpen ERA among full-season minor league clubs, trailing Buffalo (2.92).

SUPER GREG: RailRiders OF **Greg Allen** has been on a tear in nine games since being returned to the team from the Yankees. The switch-hitter is batting .480 (12-for-25) with 5 R, 4 2B, HR, 3 RBI, 3 BB, 5 K, and 2 HBP. Overall, Allen is riding an 11-game on-base streak since July 15 which has raised his season batting line from .263/.402/.343 to .316/.438/.459, a 142-point jump in his OPS.

MIND THE CLOCK: Last week's series with Lehigh Valley has featured three pitch clock violations – one against RailRiders pitcher **Josh Maciejewski** for taking too long to deliver a pitch, one against Iron Pigs outfielder **Matt Vierling** for taking too long to step in the box on Wednesday, and a third against SWB pitcher **Kevin Gadea** for taking too long to come set with a runner on base on Saturday. In 88 games, the RailRiders have seen only 12 pitch clock violations against themselves or their opponents this year, after 31 were called in the 2019 season. These are the first pace of play violations called in a RailRiders game since June 22, when both **Luis Gil** and Lehigh Valley's **Mauricio Llovera** were cited for taking too long to come set with a runner on base.

BEEN A LONG TIME: With a loss to Lehigh Valley last Wednesday and Buffalo's 5-0 win over Rochester, the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders wake up Thursday morning in second place in Triple-A East Northeast for the first time since the beginning of play on May 7. That day, the RailRiders beat the Syracuse Mets 7-3 to move into a tie for first in Triple-A East Northeast, and would at least share the throne until the end of play on August 11. During SWB's 97-day reign atop the division, the average price of a gallon of gas jumped from \$2.89 to \$3.17, "Save Your Tears" by The Weeknd and Ariana Grande was de-throned as the No. 1 song, and **Hoy Park's** entire RailRiders career happened.

ROUGH PATCH: With Sunday's loss to Lehigh Valley, the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders completed their 12-game homestand with a 4-8 record. In their last 20 games, SWB is 7-13, by far the worst stretch of the season. There have been two three-game losing skids for SWB in this span, only the second and third times this year that the RailRiders have dropped three in a row, respectively. Through 88 completed games, the RailRiders have not dropped four straight games. In 2019, SWB had three four-game losing streaks and one six-game losing streak. There was also one stretch where the team lost 11-of-12 games played from 8/6-17.

144 in '22: The Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders announced their 2022 schedule this morning, featuring 144 games from April 5 through Sept. 21. This will be the first time since 2016 that Triple-A plays a 144-game schedule, as the number was gradually reduced from 144 to 140 following that season. Highlights of the season include SWB's first-ever matchups with St. Paul and Jacksonville, and the first series at Omaha since 1990.

LAST TIME OUT: Came out of the bullpen piggybacking on a **Braden Briso** open last Friday night at PNC Field and struggled with his command, walking a career-high seven batters in 5.0 innings of work. The seven free passes were the most by a SWB relief pitcher this season, and tied with starts by **Deivi García** and **Luis Gil** for most by a RailRiders pitcher in a single game in 2021. Krook limited Lehigh Valley to only three runs despite all the traffic on the bases because he allowed only two hits and struck out six.

2021 HIGHLIGHTS:

- Began the season with the Double-A Somerset Patriots break camp roster.
- Promoted to Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre on June 15, the first mid-season promotion of his career.
- Posted a 44:11 K:BB ratio, 0.89 WHIP in 29.1 innings with Somerset before the promotion, including 17 strikeouts in 10.0 innings in his last two starts.
- Had a streak of 18.2 IP without allowing an earned run from 5/18 - 6/12.

PERSONAL/CAREER:

- Selected by the Yankees in the first round of the Triple-A phase of the 2020 Rule 5 Draft.
- Full name is Matthew Edward Krook.
- Drafted in the 1st Round of the 2013 MLB Draft (35th overall) by the Miami Marlins, but did not sign (Competitive Balance Round A). Agreed to a contract with the Marlins, but failed his physical and Miami withdrew its offer.
- Underwent Tommy John surgery performed by Dr. James Andrews on April 22, 2014, during his freshman year of college. Did not pitch in 2015 collegiate season, but did return to pitch with the Wareham Gatemen of the Cape Cod League in the summer of '15.
- Drafted by the San Francisco Giants in the 4th round of the 2016 MLB Draft.
- Traded by the Giants to the Tampa Bay Rays on December 20, 2017 along with RHP Stetson Woods, INF Christian Arroyo and OF Denard Span in exchange for 3B Evan Longoria.
- During the COVID-19 pandemic, Krook traveled around the country as different locales began opening up to train with teammates and find open gyms. He mostly stayed in Washington, DC and Charlotte, NC in different AirBNBs. Krook trained and lived for a while with Durham Bulls pitcher Tyler Zombro, whom he describes as a close friend and pitching mentor.

LAST TIME OUT: Boyle threw a career-high 4.1 innings last Thursday night as a piggyback reliever to opener **Brian Keller** and picked up his first career Triple-A win in a 10-3 victory. He allowed one run and struck out three without walking a batter as he set a new career-high in innings pitched and pitches thrown (66) in a game.

SLIDING ALONG: Boyle's signature pitch is his slider, but he as worked with Yankees Director of Pitching **Sam Briend** to re-vamp his grip and alter the shape of the pitch. He previously threw more of a "gyro" slider with more downward break and less horizontal movement. The new slider has less vertical drop but more glove-side horizontal break.

2021 HIGHLIGHTS:

- Began the season with the Low-A Tampa Tarpons break camp roster.
- Promoted to High-A Hudson Valley Renegades on July 6.
- Started Hudson Valley's no-hitter on 7/10 (G1) vs Brooklyn: 4.0 IP, 0 H, 0 R, 3 BB, 3 K. The no-hitter was finished off by **Nick Ernst** and **Derek Craft**.
- Promoted to Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre on August 7.

PERSONAL/CAREER:

- Did not start playing baseball until his freshman year of high school. He was cut on the third day of tryouts before making the JV team as a sophomore and played varsity in his final two years of high school.
- His family was not a big sports family, but his dad taught him how to pitch through reading books and watching instructional videos on YouTube.
- Is also a self-taught guitar player, and enjoys playing classic hard rock like AC/DC and Led Zeppelin.
