### FRES-NOTES

**2-0 IN 2024:** The Fresno Grizzlies (2-0) growled past the San Jose Giants (0-2) 13-6 Saturday evening from Excite Ballpark. Fresno's 13 runs were the most scored against San Jose since 2022. The Grizzlies provided 12 runs on July 5, 2023 at Chukchansi Park. Fresno also earned a series win and look for their first sweep of San Jose since the California League Playoffs in 2022. The Grizzlies have never swept a series at Excite Ballpark since joining the league in 2021. Fresno's lineup tallied 13 runs on 13 hits, seven walks and two hit-by-pitches. Every Grizzlies batter recorded a hit and six different players mustered at least one run. Fresno batted around in the fifth, plating five runs. They yielded three runs in both the third and eighth frames. Luis Mendez highlighted the offense with a career-high five RBI thanks to a two-run triple in the third and two-RBI single in the fifth. Mendez walked twice and waltzed home three times.

**GIANT AMOUNT OF MATCHUPS:** The Fresno Grizzlies and San Jose Giants (San Francisco Giants Single-A affiliate) conclude their three-game series today at Excite Ballpark. This is the first of six series between the clubs in 2024 and the first of three sets in San Jose. Last season, the Grizzlies won 14 of the 27 meetings between the clubs and are now 49-40 overall in the regular season (2-3 in playoffs) against the Giants since joining the California League.

**FROM FRIEND TO FOE:** The San Jose Giants have a few names on their coaching staff that the Central Valley may recognize. Giants pitching coach Dan Runzler was selected by the San Francisco Giants in the 9th round of the 2007 MLB Draft. He played for the Grizzlies from 2009-14, appearing in 144 games. Runzler pitched in the majors for parts of five seasons (Giants 2009-12, Pirates 2017) before playing overseas and independent ball. Over 97 big league games, he logged a 4-2 record with a 3.89 ERA over 76.1 innings. Another staff member fans may remember is Giants hitting coach Travis Ishikawa. The Giants selected Ishikawa in the 21st round of the 2002 MLB Draft out of Federal Way HS in Washington. Ishikawa played eight MLB seasons starting in 2006 and ending in 2015 with time spent in San Francisco (2006, 2008-10, 2014-15), Milwaukee (2012), Baltimore (2013), New York AL (2013) and Pittsburgh (2014-15). Ishikawa wore a Grizzlies uniform in 2008, 2011 and 2014, playing in 175 games. The final coach fans may remember is Giants Manager Ydwin Villegas. The always smiling infielder played for the Grizzlies from 2011-14, appearing in 95 games. Villegas batted .208 and had a .962 fielding percentage.

**FARM GROWN:** Today, the Grizzlies hand the ball to RHP Jace Kaminska. Kaminska was selected by the Rockies in the 10th round (Pick 292) of the 2023 MLB Draft out of Nebraska. Kaminska made 14 starts for the Cornhuskers in 2023, going 7-3 with a 4.13 ERA and 1.14 WHIP. Prior to Nebraska, Kaminska pitched for Wichita State and Caney Valley High School in Caney, Kansas.

**FAMILIARITY FOR THE WIMMERS:** Braylen Wimmer has launched both of the Grizzlies homers to start the year. Wimmer's first series with Fresno is similar to that of his dad, Chris. The elder Wimmer made his professional debut for the San Jose Giants (1993), who of course, is the Grizzlies opponent to open the 2024 season.

**MULTIPLE OPENING DAY STARTS:** OF EJ Andrews Jr., INF Luis Mendez and INF Andy Perez became the 53rd, 54th and 55th players in Grizzlies history to make multiple Opening Day starting lineups. The most recent player prior to the trio above to join this list was OF Yanquiel Fernandez (2022-23). INF Todd Linden currently sits atop the list with five Opening Day starts.
