Today: It's the first game of the final series in the Lugnuts' 27th Midwest League season, the start of a six-game series against the Lake County Captains – the 222nd all-time meeting between the Nuts and Caps. The Lugnuts are 8-10 vs. the Captains this season, losing four of five games in Eastlake in April before winning four of seven games in Lansing in May and splitting a six-game series in July. Lansing's 24 games scheduled against Lake County this year are the club's most vs. any Midwest League team in 2023.

Last Game, Sunday: Lugnuts 19, West Michigan 9. Euribiel Angeles went 5-for-6 and Colby Thomas capped a 10-run third inning with a three-run opposite-field home run, launching the Lugnuts to their biggest win of the year and clinching a six-game series split with the Whitecaps. The Nuts finished with 18 hits in the game, which took three hours and five minutes to play in front of a roaring crowd of 4,373.

Starting Matchup: 22-year-old right-hander Jose Dicochea gets the ball against Captains southpaw Ryan Webb tonight. On July 7, Dicochea limited the Captains to one hit in four innings in a Lake County 9-8 victory. Webb has faced Lansing twice, tossing 5 2/3 scoreless innings on April 23 and allowing two runs in five innings on May 21.

Lug•Notes

Among the League Leaders: The promoted Daniel Susac leads the Midwest League in qualified batting average with a .303 average. Danny Bautista, Jr. is 2nd in base hits (113). Junior Pérez is tied for 3rd in stolen bases (41), tied for 6th in doubles (26), 9th in total bases (167) and 10th in extra-base hits (40).

A Night to Remember: Saturday night's epic saw seven runs scored in the first eight innings and 14 runs scored in the final three. It lasted a season-long three hours, 54 minutes to complete, and saw 12 pitchers throw a combined 389 pitches. Junior Pérez tied a Lugnuts 2023 single game high with four runs scored, Jacob Wilson collected his first four-hit game as a pro and reached base five times (also tying a Lugnuts single game high for 2023) and Lansing collected six doubles (which, yes, also tied a 2023 single game high). West Michigan blew two separate saves in the game, giving the Whitecaps 22 blown saves for the year, while the Nuts improved to 7-2 in extra-inning games.

The Encore: The Lugnuts followed up on Sunday with their first 10-run inning since April 12, 2018, setting season highs in runs (19) and hits (18). West Michigan scored 10 runs and nine runs in back-to-back games, but lost both games, falling out of first place in the East Division entering the final week of 2023.

Summing it up: The Nuts are triple-slashing .358/.424/.517 through three games in September, with 33 runs on 43 hits (62 total bases) comprising 12 doubles, two triple and one home run, not to mention five HBPs. Lansing finishes the season with a .267/.337/.416 mark in home games, topping the circuit in home hits (574), home total bases (896) and home doubles (122).

Roll Call: The Lugnuts have used 25 position players this year and 26 pitchers (not including Danny Bautista, Jr., who tossed one inning as a position-player-pitching). 16 players have hit at least one home run, 16 players have stolen at least one base, 15 pitchers have made at least one start, 19 pitchers have won at least one game, and 13 pitchers have recorded at least one save.

Two for the Price of One: Lansing leads the league with 112 double plays turned, six more than second-place Peoria.

Crossing the 300,000-Fan Threshold: Including the season-opening Crosstown Showdown exhibition vs. Michigan State, the Lugnuts drew 303,659 fans this year to Jackson® Field™ this season. Overall, the Nuts' average attendance of 4,679/game ranks ninth among the 30 High-A teams with Lansing's July 4th attendance of 11,521 the largest single game crowd at the High-A level.

Jerome Holtzman, Represent: The Lugnuts have been playing closer and closer games as the season has gone on. By month: seven saves in 20 games in April (35%), nine in 27 games in May (33%), 15 in 24 in June (63%), 20 in 24 games in July (83%), 22 in 27 games played in August (81%), and one through three games in September.

First-Round Pedigrees: The Lugnuts' roster has two current first-rounders: shortstop Jacob Wilson, the sixth overall pick this year from Grand Canyon University, and the Blue Jays' 2021 first-round selection, 19th overall, Gunnar Hoglund, acquired via trade in March 2022 for Matt Chapman. The A's 2021 first-round selection, shortstop Max Muncy, and 2022 first-round selection, catcher Daniel Susac, are both currently excelling with the Double-A Midland RockHounds in the Texas League.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2010: In Game 1 of a doubleheader, Lake County SS Casey Frawley became the first player to homer off the Classic Park lighthouse in center field - the prize: \$1,000 split between Frawley and a random Captains fan - and the Caps beat the Lugnuts, 8-6. In Game 2, the Lugnuts' Daniel Webb came one out from throwing a seven-inning no-hitter before Chase Burnette broke it up with a single to center field. Casey Beck relieved Webb and finished off a 3-1 Lugnuts win.

2011: Billy Hamilton stole three bases, finishing the regular season with 103 steals, and Dayton edged the Lugnuts, 3-2, at Fifth Third Field. Jonathan Jones went 4-for-4 with a walk and three stolen bases in the loss. Jake Marisnick went 0-for-2 before exiting, ending his MWL-best 30-game road on-base streak. The Nuts closed the regular season with a 77-60 record, while the Dragons finished at 83-57. The teams coincidentally were scheduled to play each other at Fifth Third Field in the first round of the playoffs, so the Lugnuts stuck around Dayton until the postseason began.

Profile

Home Cooking: Also from Tucson: Alex Verdugo, four-time All-Star Ian Kinsler, two-time All-Star J.J. Hardy, Cardinals All-Star catcher Tom Pagnozzi and Ron Hassey... in all, Tucson ranks second behind Phoenix in producing Major Leaguers from the Grand Canyon State.

Glory Days: Boasting a 96 mph fastball, Dicochea was highly regarded coming out of Sahuarita High School, ranked the No. 1 prep prospect in Arizona by Baseball America entering the 2019 draft... twirled a no-hitter in the state semifinals... signed for \$400,000... signing scout: Scott Cousins... signed away from commitment to University of Arizona... senior year stats: 1.30 ERA, 54 IP, 24 H, 10 ER, 11 BB, 86 K... in addition to pitching, also starred at shortstop.

Minor League Path: Dicochea opened his professional career in the 2019 Arizona League after signing, but his 2021 campaign was halted in Single-A Stockton due to injury on June 6 after only six appearances, five starts... returned from Tommy John surgery on August 12, 2022, and made two appearances in the Arizona Complex League before returning to Stockton on August 26, 2022... finished the year with three appearances for the Ports.

Bagels in April: Opened 2023 as the Ports' No. 4 starter, firing four scoreless innings at Fresno on April 11... that was the start of three consecutive scoreless outings to begin the year, finishing April with 13 2/3 scoreless innings... didn't allow first run until May 3 vs. Fresno, entering in relief in the fifth inning and allowing two runs in the fifth and two more in the seventh in a 5-4 Ports win... in total with Stockton, posted a 2.42 ERA with a .132 average against in five road starts (22 1/3 IP) compared to 4.24 ERA, .200 avg. in four home appearances (17 IP)... lefties hit .111/.243/.175 compared to righties' .205/.279/.308... base stealers went 2-for-2.

Rave Reviews: Dicochea was promoted from Single-A Stockton to Lansing on June 13 to replace Jack Perkins, who was transferred up to Double-A Midland... coincidentally, an article about Dicochea had just been written by MLB.com A's beat writer Martin Gallegos a day earlier, quoting A's GM David Forst in including Dicochea's name among the top pitching prospects in the system (Royber Salinas, Gunnar Hoglund, J.T. Ginn and Joey Estes). Wrote Gallegos about Dicochea, "Dicochea, an eighth-round selection by the A's in the 2019 MLB Draft out of Sahuarita (Ariz.) High School, ranks just outside Oakland's Top 30 Prospects list. But his inclusion in that group from Forst speaks volumes about how highly he is viewed. In nine games (seven starts) for Single-A Stockton this season, Dicochea holds a 3.20 ERA with 47 strikeouts against 17 walks in 39 1/3 innings. He has held opposing batters to a .163 average, which ranks lowest among all California League pitchers with at least 30 innings pitched. Dicochea's development hit a snag early in his pro career after he underwent Tommy John surgery in 2021. Since his return from injury, the 22-year-old right-hander is taking a big step forward this season, showing off a fastball that consistently hits 95 mph along with a solid slider and a changeup he's recently added to his mix. A's assistant general manager and director of player personnel Billy Owens added, "He's off to a promising start. Averaging well over a strikeout per inning. Overall, his command has taken a step forward. He's definitely an interesting arm on the horizon."

Life in Lansing: This is Dicochea's fourth start on a Tuesday... in his prior three, has a 0.73 ERA, allowing four hits and one run in 12 1/3 innings; he has made one start on Wednesday, three starts on Thursday, three starts on Friday, one start on Saturday and one relief appearance on Sunday... 4.21 ERA in home games, 4.79 in road games... limiting right-handed hitters to .218 avg. and .667 OPS compared to .241 / .817 for left-handed hitters.
