TUESDAY'S RECAP: The New Hampshire Fisher Cats lost to the Portland Sea Dogs 6-4 in walk-off fashion on Tuesday night from Hadlock Field in the series opener. The Fisher Cats held a 4-1 lead heading into the bottom of the ninth but a five-run inning for the Sea Dogs gave them a come from behind victory in the end. Down to his final strike, Stephen Scott drove in the winning runs with a three-run walk-off home run off Troy Watson, his second home run of the game. Damiano Palmegiani recorded a game-high two RBIs for New Hampshire, tying the game in the sixth with a sac fly and extending the lead 3-1 in the eighth with a fielder's choice grounder to third. Orelvis Martinez drove in his 30th RBI of the season with a single in the eighth, bringing home Palmegiani. New Hampshire collected only two hits in the entire game but drew nine walks against Portland pitching. Starting pitcher Adam Kloffenstein threw six strong innings, allowing only one run on six hits and two walks while striking out five. The 22-year old right hander lowered his ERA to 2.20, which is fifth best in the Eastern League. He is also second in the Eastern League in strikeouts with 51.

CHUCKY CHEESE DALLAS: Chad Dallas was named Eastern League Pitcher of the Week after a dominant seven shutout inning, nine strikeout performance on Friday against Binghamton. It's the first time a Fisher Cat pitcher has been named with the weekly award since Max Castillo the week of April 8-17, 2022. Dallas's seven-inning start in his Fisher Cats debut was the longest start of his career.

30 FOR NUMBER 2: Orelvis Martinez drove in his 30th RBI of the season last night against Portland with an RBI single in the eighth. He is the third Eastern League hitter this season to drive in 30 or more RBIs behind Hartford's Hunter Goodman (43) and Erie's Colt Keith (33). 12 of Martinez's 19 hits this season have gone over the wall for home runs. His nine home runs this month ties a Fisher Cats record. Last season, Martinez had 23 RBIs in the month of May. This year, he has already 20 RBIs in May with seven games to go this month.

'OBP' - ON BASE PALMEGIANI: Damiano Palmegiani is in the top-10 of the Eastern League leaderboard in on-base percentage. The corner infielder is getting on-base at a .404 clip, eighth-best in the league. On Tuesday, he collected his 18th and 19th RBIs of the season, placing him second on the team behind Orelvis Martinez. Palmegiani has reached base in an impressive 30 of 35 games played this season.

GET SCHWECKED: Trevor Schwecke drove in a career-high five RBIs in the second game of the Sunday doubleheader, including a grand slam in the fourth to tie up the score 4-4 in the fourth. It was Schwecke's second career grand slam and the first grand slam hit by the Fisher Cats this season. The utilityman has played every position on defense except for catcher, center field and pitcher.

PARTY LIKE A ROCK-STAR: Dylan Rock has a knack for knowing when to hit the ball out of the park for the Fisher Cats so far this year. Three of his four home runs this season have been game winning hits, including his most recent homer in the second game of the doubleheader on Sunday, a two-run shot to break the 4-4 tie in the fifth. His very first Double-A homer broke a 5-5 tie in the eighth on April 25 vs Hartford in the continuation of a suspended game.

THIS DAY IN FISHER CATS HISTORY (May 25, 2018)- Bo Bichette and Vladimir Guerrero Jr. each homered in New Hampshire's 10-3 win over Hartford to get a five-game series going in Manchester. Bichette knocked in a run with a double in the sixth, and hit a three-run homer in the seventh as the Fisher Cats turned a 2-0 lead into a 10-0 lead after seven. Jon Harris was the winning pitcher, allowing two unearned runs in his 7.1 innings pitched.

MANCHESTER-BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: Toronto (26-24) have dropped two of three at Tampa Bay, falling 7-3 last night. Toronto was down 3-0 in the fourth when Vladimir Guerrero Jr. singled home Bo Bichette. Cavan Biggio hit a pinch-hit homer in the eighth to make it 5-2, and Nathan Lukes followed with a triple, scoring on a George Springer groundout. But the Jays could not get closer. The series wraps at 1:10 p.m. today...Triple-A Buffalo (22-25) lost 11-9 at Lehigh Valley. Jake Cave hit a walk-off two-run homer in the bottom of the ninth. Davis Schneider hit his ninth homer, a two-run shot in the top of the first to give the Bisons an early 2-0 lead....High-A Vancouver (21-18) lost 11-6 at Spokane...Class A Dunedin (21-19) was rained out at home with Fort Myers.

COMING UP: New Hampshire continues its six-game road trip at Portland this week, their first of two visits to the Sea Dogs this season. The next home game will be Tuesday, May 30 when the Fisher Cats host Reading.
