Today: It's the fifth game of a six-game set (and the 23rd game of a 24-game season series) between the Lansing Lugnuts and the Great Lakes Loons. The Nuts have lost the first four games of the series, dropping their Dow Diamond record to 2-8 and their overall record vs. Great Lakes to 7-15.

Last Night: Loons 3, Lugnuts 2. The Luggies were officially eliminated from playoff contention despite limiting Great Lakes to only three hits: an **Emil Morales** two-run homer off of **Jose Dicochea** in the fourth, and a **Jaron Elkins** double and **Mairo Martinus** go-ahead RBI single off **Tzu-Chen Sha** in the seventh. Dicochea fired five innings of one-hit ball in a no-decision in his second consecutive start since joining the rotation.

On the Air: Jesse Goldberg-Strassler and the Voice of Central Michigan University, Adam Jaksa, deliver the call on milb.streamguys1.com/lansing, while John Vicari and Brad Tunney call the game on Bally Live and MiLB TV.

On Deck: The Nuts wrap up the 2026 road schedule tomorrow, returning home September 1-6 to welcome in Fort Wayne and conclude the season.

LUG-NOTES

History: The Nuts set a new franchise record with their 44th loss on the road last night, breaking the dubious mark of 42 losses set by the 1999 team (which starred **Corey Patterson** and **Carlos Zambrano**, lost only 25 games at home, finished 73-67, went to the postseason, swept Michigan in two games, and was eliminated in the divisional championship round by Wisconsin).

Home and Road: The Nuts have lost 12 of their last 14 road games while winning 13 of their last 15 home games.

- The Lugnuts have outscored the opposition by 49 runs at home, averaging a league-leading 6.12 runs per home game. Lansing is also the hardest team in the league to strike out at home, averaging only 7.8 K per game. On the road, the Nuts have been outscored by 117 runs and are averaging 4.16 runs per game while allowing 5.98 runs/game, and have struck out the 3rd most times, averaging 10.1 K per game.
- Triple slash splits, home - .256 / .372 / .393, .765 OPS, vs. road - .227 / .327 / .323, .650 OPS.
- Pitching-wise, the Lugnuts' staff has issued the fewest walks (226, 3.9 per game) at home, but that changes on the road (287, 4.6).

Two for the Price of One: The Lugnuts lead all of High-A in turning double plays, 118.

Who's Streaking:

- Jake Reinisch** went 1-for-2 with a single and two walks, extending his team-high on-base streak to 37 games. Reinisch is batting .295 with a .452 OBP and a .508 slugging pct. during the streak, with 36 base hits and 33 walks. It is the second longest active streak in the minors behind only Jose Cerice's 44-game streak for Quad Cities. The longest in MLB history was Ted Williams' 84 games (July 1-Sept. 27, 1949).
- Daniel Bucciero** went 0-for-5 to end his on-base streak at 23 games.

New Addition: Pitcher **Chen Zhong-Ao Zhuang** joins the Lugnuts this week on Minor League rehab assignment from Triple-A. He is scheduled to start on Sunday. The Taiwanese right-hander, affectionately nicknamed "Z Man," posted a 2.56 ERA in nine appearances spanning 31 2/3 innings with the Lugnuts in 2024, with a remarkable 3:29 BB:K ratio. He spent all of 2025 in Double-A Midland (6-11, 4.08 ERA, 145 K in 145 2/3 IP) and was added to the A's 40-man roster entering 2026. But Zhuang landed on the 7-day IL from May 4-30 and was designed for assignment on July 31, going back on the Injured List (right elbow) on August 6.

Organizational Showdown: The A's and Dodgers' MiLBers are meeting up in the California League (Stockton Ports vs. Ontario Tower Buzzers), the Midwest League (Lansing Lugnuts vs. Great Lakes Loons) and Texas League (Midland RockHounds vs. Tulsa Drillers). **Scoreboard check:** The Lugnuts and RockHounds lost yesterday, but the Ports won 6-0 behind 6 1/3 shutout innings from **Donny Troconis**, who struck out six; the Dodgers lead the A's for the week, 8-4, though that's only because of Great Lakes' 4-0 record. The other two series have been split in the first four games.

Major League Lugnuts: Ten former Nuts have made their MLB debuts this season: **Daniel Susac** for the Giants, **Junior Perez** for the White Sox, **Eduardo Rivera** for the Red Sox, **Jack Weisenburger** with the NY Mets, and **Henry Bolte**, **Gage Jump**, **Kade Morris**, **Joshua Kuroda-Grauer**, **Tommy White** and **Yunior Tur** for the Athletics. In all 48 Lugnuts have appeared in a Major League game this season.

Moving On Up: The Lugnuts have seen above-average roster movement, with 17 players moving to the upper levels of the minors...

- 2026 Nuts **Ryan Magdic**, **Jake Garland** and **Davis Diaz** have reached Triple-A Las Vegas.

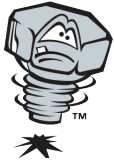

AUGUST 29 IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2018: The Lugnuts drew 4,182 on a Wednesday night to Cooley Law School Stadium, surpassing the 300,000 attendance mark for the 23rd consecutive season. Ryan Noda's first-inning RBI triple and fourth-inning home run gave the Nuts all that they would need in a 2-1 victory over the Great Lakes Loons. It was Noda's 19th home run of the year.

2019: It was beat-the-rain with the Lugnuts, in a two-hour, 24-minute 7-3 victory over West Michigan before a massive storm showed up at Cooley Law School Stadium. Fitz Stadler gave up one run in six innings and LJ Talley, Johnny Aiello, Rafael Lantigua and Griffin Conine all homered off Whitecaps starter Chance Kirby in the win.

2024: Lawrence Butler hits three home runs in a 10-9 A's loss at Cincinnati, becoming the second A's player ever and the third MLB player ever to have two 3-HR games in the same season.

Background: Ranked the Angels' No. 20 prospect in 2024 by MLB Pipeline, giving him 60-grade control... signed with LAA for \$35,000 and zoomed up through rookie ball despite a fastball that sits 87-89 mph, but hit a wall with High-A Tri-City... home city of Bayamo was founded in 1513 by Diego Velázquez de Cuéllar... "bayamo" is a violent high-speed wind... the national anthem of Cuba is "La Bayamesa" or "Himno de Bayamo," written during the Battle of Bayamo in 1868 after the native Cubans forced the surrender of Spain in Bayamo; it was adopted as the national anthem in 1902.

In a Nutshell: Drafted 45th in the Triple-A phase of the 2025 Rule 5 Draft from the Angels' organization... makes his third start of the season today (April 29, Game 2 vs. Dayton: 2 IP, 0 H, 0 R, 3 BB, 0 K | July 24 vs. Great Lakes: 4 IP, 2 H, 1 R, 1 HR, 2 BB, 2 K)... joined the rotation following the promotion of Ben Hansen and Zane Taylor to Double-A... in his finest professional start, Marcheco faced an ACLA's lineup on August 22, 2022, with rehabbers Lawrence Butler, Cody Thomas, and Austin Beck, plus Henry Bolte, and tossed 6 shutout IP with 12 K.

Last Game: August 22 vs. Peoria... Daniel Bucciero singled home Pedro Pineda in the first inning for a 1-0 lead, and then Jorge Marcheco pitched on the razor's edge with scoreless innings through the first five... he recorded a pair of outs in the sixth, but gave up a double to Ian Petruz, causing Lansing to go the bullpen... but a lightning strike heralded the arrival of a storm, bringing an early end to the game... Marcheco won, 1-0.
