Today's Game

The Fightin Phils are back on the road for the final series of the 2024 season at the Harrisburg Senators, Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals. Reading holds the edge in the season-series 6-4, after winning the series between the teams at FirstEnergy Stadium from June 4-9. Despite Harrisburg being the closest team to Reading (63 miles) the teams only face off twice during the season.

Game 135 Recap

The Fightin Phils snapped a two-game winning streak with a 5-2 loss to Harrisburg on Friday night. Christian McGowan took the loss, but allowed just one earned run. A costly error from Zach Arnold in the second allowed two runs to score. Justin Crawford hit a two-run single in the seventh to make it 3-2 at the time, but Harrisburg tacked on two more insurance runs. Crawford had two hits and two RBI on the night. Reading is now one win away from matching 2023's win total of 59 and two shy from surpassing it. The R-Phils also need to win one more game against Harrisburg to clinch the season-series over the Senators.

Crawford Is Cruising

Phillies No. 3 Prospect Justin Crawford turned in another strong game on Friday, registering two hits and two RBI. Since Sept. 3, Crawford is slashing .444/.487/.583 (1.070 OPS). He's added seven runs, two doubles, one home run, six RBI and three stolen bases over that stretch. Over 39 games so far with Reading, Crawford has 18 multi-hit games (46%), which includes six three-hit games. Since his Double-A debut on July 19, Crawford holds the following Eastern League ranks: 1st AVG (.340), T-7th RBI (26), 6th OBP (.383), 6th SLG (.463), 5th OPS (.846), 2nd Hits (55), T-3rd Doubles (11), 6th TB (75), 10th Runs (25) and T-1st SB (15). He has a hit in 16 of his last 17 games and is riding a 10-game hitting streak.

It's Miller Time

The Philadelphia Phillies announced last Tuesday that top prospect Aidan Millern was called up to Reading from High-A Jersey Shore. Miller was coming off an August that saw him hit .299 and win South Atlantic League Player of the Month. He finished his time with Jersey Shore with a five-hit performance against Hudson Valley on Sept. 1. Miller had hits in each of his first-four games with the Fightin Phils last week, before going hitless on Sunday. Miller joins Crawford as the last two first round picks of the Phillies prior to this year in Reading. The first time that has happened since Mick Abel (2020) and Andrew Painter (2021) during the 2022 season.

Home Cooking

Despite losing their last four home games of the season, the Fightin Phils closed off 2024 with a winning record at FirstEnergy Stadium, going 35-34. This comes on the heels of going just 23-44 last season at home. The last time Reading posted a winning record at home was in 2022, when the R-Phils went 36-33.

Pitchers Giving Length

After getting six-strong innings from Mitch Neunborn on Wednesday night, Fightin Phils pitchers have tossed six-or-more innings on 33 instances this season. In those games, Reading has posted a 23-10 record. When pitchers have gone seven innings, the Fightin Phils are 6-0 this year; and they have posted a 17-10 record in 27 games where pitchers have thrown 6-plus frames. Reading pitchers went six-or-more innings 33 times in 2023, and seven-plus three times. The starters success has led to strong relief pitching this week, as R-Phils relievers have a 1.76 ERA (3 ER, 15.1 IP) over four games so far this week in Harrisburg.

Milestone Watch

With three games to go in the season, the Fightin Phils have a few milestones to look out for. With Carson Taylor holding 74 RBI, this will mark the third-straight year that Reading's RBI leader has 70-plus RBI, after not doing so from 2017-21. This year will mark the first time since 2015 (Roman Quinn) that a R-Phil had been caught stealing over 10 times, as Robert Moore has been caught 11 times.

This Day in Baseballtown History

September 14, 2023: At Binghamton, Matt Osterberg twirls a gem in his final start of the season. The lefty goes seven innings and allows just two hits. The R-Phils would lose 2-1 on a walk off from Rowdey Jordan in the ninth.

Heading to Harrisburg

Harrisburg enters tonight with a 29-38 record in the second half. The Senators went 38-31 in the first half and narrowly missed out on a playoff spot, falling one game behind Erie. Harrisburg's roster has six players ranked amongst the Washington Nationals' Top-30 prospects: Yohandy Morales (9), Cayden Wallace (11), Daylen Lile (12), Andry Lara (17), Kevin Made (25) and Marquis Grissom (26).

Throwing for the Senators

Righty Chase Solesky makes the start today for Harrisburg. This is his 17th appearance and 14th start this season and he is 2-4, with a 3.10 ERA (78.1 IP, 67 H, 19 BB, 46 SO). Solesky last pitched Sept. 8 at Bowie, allowing two runs on two hits over six innings, in a no-decision, while striking out seven. Solesky spent 2023 in the White Sox system, pitching between Birmingham (AA) and Charlotte (AAA), going 5-11, with a 5.31 ERA over 26 games. He was released by Chicago in March and signed with Washington in June. The 26-year old was drafted by Chicago in the 21st round in 2019 out of Tulane.

In first start off Development List, gave best outing of season. Went five innings against Hartford, yielding just one-earned run in first win of season. Best start of season May 15 at RIC. Allowed one-earned run over season-high six innings. Made first relief appearance of season May 22 vs BNG and earned second win of season and matched season-high with four strikeouts. Quality start June 4 against Harrisburg, allowing three runs over six innings, in no-decision vs Senators. Earned win over five-shutout innings vs HBG on June 9.
