SUNDAY... Bowling Green capped off their trip to Rome with a 5-3 win on Sunday. Hill Alexander led the offense with two RBIs, finishing 2-3 on the day. Curtis Mead and Evan Edwards contributed as well, both knocking in a run. Jacob Lopez started the game, tossing 5.0 innings and holding the Braves to one run on three hits while striking out five. Miller Hogan earned his second win of the season after blowing a save, pitching the final 2.0 innings in the Hot Rods 39th win of the season.

THE CENTURY MARK... Jacson McGowan's clout to dead center in Saturday's first game of the doubleheader was the 100th homer of the 2021 season for BG. Through 60 games, it's already the third most homers hit in a single season for the Hot Rods behind 2011's club record 106 blasts and 2012's 105. Both of those seasons also happened to be the only time Bowling Green played the full 140-game schedule. This season is shortened to 120 games.

ALL-TIME WINNER... After earning a win against the Rome Braves on July 7th, Alan Strong became the Hot Rods all-time wins leader. Strong is 5-0 this season, raising his win total for Bowling Green to 15 between 2019 and 2021. He surpassed Chris Pike who played with the Hot Rods for parts of the 2015 and 2017 season where he accumulated 14 wins.

PLAYER MOVEMENT... OF Niko Hulsizer has been promoted to AA Montgomery after his stellar month of June. He brought home the High-A East Player of the Month award after batting .325 and leading the league in homers (10), RBI (30), and OPS (1.220). OF Michael Gigliotti was activated from the IL and will join Bowling Green this homestand. He ended the 2019 season at the A Advanced level before being traded to the Rays in 2020. INF Osmy Gregorio was released, bringing the Hot Rods to 29 players on their current roster.





FORMER HOT RODS IN THE OLYMPICS... Joe Ryan and Shane Baz have been named to the U.S Olympic Team for the 2020 Tokyo Olympics. Ryan, pitched in six games with Bowling Green in 2019, posting a 2-2 record with a 2.93 ERA. Baz played the entirety of his 2019 season with the Hot Rods, finishing with a 3-2 record with a 2.99 ERA over 81.1 innings pitched. Both pitchers are currently playing at the AAA level with the Durham Bulls and open the Olympic Games on Friday, July 30, against Israel.

SUNDAY'S NOTES... Alexander had his fifth multi-RBI game of the season with Bowling Green... He's also got a five-game hit streak... Alexander has six multi-hit games with BG this season... McGowan has reached safely in eight consecutive games... Mead recorded his first multi-hit game as a Hot Rod... BG is 3-0 in games following a doubleheader... The team won their eight-game series against the Braves 5-3... Jesse Franklin V has hit seven homers against BG this season, which is half of his season total...

NOW PITCHING: JAYDEN MURRAY... After winning High-A East Pitcher of the Month, Murray has continued his dominance to start July. He has made two starts this month, working through a combined 10.0 innings, giving up just nine hits and one earned run during that span while striking out 12. His last start at Bowling Green Ballpark on July 1st was arguably his best, working through 5.0 innings, allowing five hits, no runs, and struck out a season-high eight batters.

July 13, 2012

On this day in Hot Rods history, Bowling Green beat the Burlington Bees 8-2. The Hot Rods plated four runs in the second frame, capped off with a three-run homer by future big leaguer Taylor Motter. Motter drove in another run in the fourth to expand their lead to 5-1. He continued his big day with a two-run double in the eighth and Juniel Querecuto and Drew Vettleson drove in the final two runs, bringing the score to a final 8-2. Future big leaguer Ryan Carpenter picked up a win after tossing 6.0 innings and giving up two runs in the Hot Rods 51st win of the season.

PLAYER SPECS

2019: Over his first season in the minor leagues, Murray primarily played for the Princeton Rays... While with Princeton, he posted a 2.88 ERA over 34.1 innings pitched... Although his record was 0-2, he showed stellar control with 37 strikeouts to just eight walks... He appeared in 11 games with eight of them being starts... Overall, he surrendered 30 hits and 11 earned runs while with Princeton... After his stop in Rookie Advanced ball, he moved up to Class A short season with the Hudson Valley Renegades for his final two games of the 2019 season... He started both games with the Renegades, one in the regular season and one in the postseason... His regular season start was a six inning, shutout performance in which he struck out 10, walked none and gave up one hit on 77 pitches... Murray's next outing came in the New York Penn League playoffs against Brooklyn Cyclones... Murray lasted seven innings, giving up eight hits while allowing four runs, with only one earned run. **2019 (NCAA DII):** In 2019 Murray posted a 3.78 ERA at Dixie State... He showed improvement from the previous season with a 10-3 record and struckout 92 batters... He made 14 appearances, all starts... Hurled two complete games over the course of his senior season. **2018 (NCAA DII):** As a junior in his first season at Dixie State, Murray started 12 games and recorded a 5.15 ERA with a 3-5 record... Tallied 46 strikeouts over his 64.2 innings... Had eight K's, allowed two hits and a run during his Dixie State debut against Cal State San Bernardino on February 9th. **2017 (JUCO):** Murray spent his sophomore season at Arizona Western Junior College... He posted an 11-3 record, which had him tied for 1st in wins in the Arizona Community College Athletic Conference... His 108 strikeouts had him ranked 4th in the ACCAC... He made 20 appearances with 14 stars... He logged two saves in his relief outings... Murray tossed three complete games, all within conference play. **2016:** As a freshman Murray tossed just 35 innings... Over that span, he posted a 6.94 ERA in 12 appearances, making just one start... Murray finished with 25 strikeouts and a record of 3-1... Was part of a team that finished 43 and 22, the 2nd best record for Arizona Western in the past four years. **Personal:** Parents are Ryan and Darchel... Played at Utah High School... Only one recorded MLB player from Utah High School, AJ Murray, who spent parts of 2007 and 2008 with the Rangers.... Was also recruited by BYU, Utah and Utah Valley before choosing to go to Arizona Wester JC and Dixie State... Dixie State is set to join the WAC and NCAA Division I in 2020-21... Favorite pitcher in college was Clayton Kershaw.
