SUNDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Baysox, 5-1, to leave town with a series split. The Baysox took a 1-0 lead in the fifth with a solo homer by Tavian Josenberger. In the top of the sixth, Sabin Ceballos tied the score with an RBI double. In the seventh, Dayson Croes hit a go-ahead single and Victor Bericoto belted a three-run homer to push the lead to 5-1. Jack Choate started and threw three scoreless innings. Shane Rademacher allowed one run, the Josenberger homer, over his three innings. Evan Gates and Will Bednar combined for three hitless innings to finish the game.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels play the opener of a six-game series against the Akron RubberDucks, Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians. Richmond is in fourth play in the Southwest Divisions second-half standings, 1.5 games behind Akron, 2.5 games behind Harrisburg and 3.5 games behind Altoona. The RubberDucks swept a three-game series at The Diamond to open the season in April. Richmond went 1-5 at Akron from April 22-27 and 5-1 at Canal Park from July 8-13.

PACKING THE HOUSE: This season the Flying Squirrels are averaging 6,585 fans per home game, which leads Double-A and ranks seventh among all 120 MiLB clubs. Their average of 7,290 in the season's first month was the highest April attendance in franchise history. Last year, the Flying Squirrels led all 30 Double-A teams in average (6,595) and total (435,295) attendance. Among the 120 MiLB teams, the Flying Squirrels were 10th in average attendance. It was the third straight year the Flying Squirrels led all 30 Double-A clubs in average and total attendance, which had not been done prior to 2022. Last year's total attendance was the highest since 2013 (434,769) and the fourth-highest average in team history.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** are in fourth place in the Southwest Division second-half standings, 3.5 games behind first-place Altoona. They split last week's series in Bowie against the Baysox. After going 10-2 from July 4-20, they dropped six-of-seven from July 22-30 before going 11-11 in their last 22 games dating back to August 1. Of Richmond's 71 losses this season, 40 of them have been by two runs or less (24 by one, 16 by two). Their 24 one-run losses are tied for the most in the EL, even with Reading.

**THE RUBBERDUCKS** are in third place in the Southwest Division second-half standings, two games behind first-place Altoona. The RubberDucks split last week's series against the Fisher Cats after winning five-of-six the previous week at Reading. Akron's roster features four players ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Guardians prospects, including SS Angel Genao (No. 2), RHP Khal Stephen (No. 6), C Jacob Cozart (No. 18) and LHP Josh Hartle (No. 27). MLB.com's top-30 Guardians prospects list features five Akron players, including Genao (No. 3), Stephen (No. 7), OF Alfonsin Rosario (No. 13), Cozart (No. 18) and Hartle (No. 25).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander John Michael Bertrand makes his 23rd start of the season and the 12th outing of his career against the RubberDucks. He last pitched on Wednesday against the Baysox on the road and allowed four runs over 4.2 innings. After going 0-4 with a 5.91 ERA (14 ER/21.1 IP) in five April starts, Bertrand has gone 5-5 with a 2.31 ERA (24 ER/93.1 IP) in his last 17 starts since May 4. Since July 4 in his last seven starts, Bertrand has gone 3-2 with a 1.47 ERA (6 ER/36.2 IP). In the Eastern League this season, Bertrand ranks third in ERA (2.98) and third in innings pitched (114.2). Since the start of the 2024 season, Bertrand leads all MiLB pitchers with 35 GDP and ranks third in innings pitched (270.2). Tonight's start is the 61st of his Richmond career, tying him with Justin Fitzgerald for the second-most in franchise history. Last year, he was named the Flying Squirrels' Pitcher of the Year after going 7-9 with a 4.32 ERA in 28 outings (27 starts). Bertrand also won the team's Community Service Award. He made two starts with Triple-A Sacramento to close the season. For the year, Bertrand led all Eastern League pitchers with 10 scoreless starts, all at least five innings. He also led all MiLB pitchers defensively in assists (31) and ranked second in total chances (38). He finished the season ranked first among all MiLB pitchers in double plays induced (23), five ahead of the next closest pitcher. Bertrand was named Eastern League Pitcher of the Week twice last year, first for throwing seven perfect innings against the Baysox on April 27 and then for working six hitless innings in Bowie on May 23. Entering 2025, he is rated by Baseball America as having the best control in the Giants system for the second straight year. Bertrand began his collegiate career at Furman University in South Carolina before playing his final two seasons at the University of Notre Dame. He was selected by the Giants in the 10th round of the 2022 MLB Draft. For more on Bertrand, see page two.

**FOR AKRON:** Right-hander Davis Sharpe makes his second start of the season and his 38th appearance of the year. He last pitched on Friday against the Fisher Cats and threw a scoreless inning. In five outings against Richmond this season, Sharpe is 0-1 with a 18.56 ERA (11 ER/ 5.1 IP). Sharpe is in his third season with Akron and has gone 14-11 with a 4.82 ERA in 116 outings. Tonight marks the second start of his professional career. Sharpe was selected by the Guardians in the 13th round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of Clemson University.

DON'T RUN ON RICHMOND: The Flying Squirrels' catching unit of Adrián Sugastey, Zach Morgan, Onil Perez and Drew Cavanaugh have combined to catch 65 stolen base attempts this season, which first among the 30 Double-A teams and leads the Eastern League. Sugastey leads all Double-A catchers with 45 runners caught stealing. Sugastey has set a franchise record for the most caught stealing in a season in Flying Squirrels history, passing Jackson Williams' mark of 35 set in 2015 with his 36th on July 26 against Portland. For his career with Richmond, Sugastey's 58 runners caught stealing for his career is second-most in franchise history. He is one behind the Flying Squirrels career record of 59, set by Williams (2010-11, 115).

**BERI BOMBS: Victor Bericoto** hit his 11th homer of the season last Friday night, which leads all Richmond players for the year. It was the 33rd homer of his Flying Squirrels career, which is tied for second-most in team history with **Jacob Heyward** (2019, '21-22) and four behind **Ricky Oropesa's** (2013-16) franchise record of 37. Bericoto now has 130 career RBIs with Richmond, trailing only Oropesa's record of 165. In 21 August games, Bericoto is batting .286 (20-for-70) with three homers, two doubles, 12 walks and 13 RBIs.

KING OF THE HILL: In his last 20 games since July 30, Turner Hill is batting .323 (21-for-65) with four doubles, eight walks, a homer, seven RBIs and 11 runs scored. On August 9 at Erie, he tied his Double-A career high with four hits and set a Double-A career high with three runs scored. He had three hits in the series opener at Chesapeake on Tuesday and drove in the go-ahead run in a 4-2 win on Saturday night with a sixth-inning single.

CROES CONTROL: Since joining the Flying Squirrels on August 5, Dayson Croes is batting .352 (19-for-54) with a homer, two doubles, a triple, nine RBIs and five walks in 15 games. He hit a two-run single in his Double-A debut on August 6 at Erie. On Thursday against the Curve, he picked up three hits, including his first Double-A homer. Croes is the first player in Flying Squirrels history born in Aruba. He played four seasons at NCAA DII Quincy before spending two seasons with the Winnipeg Goldeyes of the independent American Association, where he hit. 347 in 187 games. Croes signed with the Giants on April and played nine games in the Arizona Complex League before spending 47 games with High-A Eugene.

SECOND-HALF SABIN: In his last nine games since August 9, Sabin Ceballos is batting .400 (12-for-30) with two homers, four doubles and 10 RBIs. For the season, he is tied for the team lead with 39 RBIs. On August 13 against the Curve, Ceballos hit a two-run homer in the first inning and matched his season high with four RBIs. On Saturday night at Chesapeake, he had two hits, including a solo homer in the second inning. In his last 33 games since July 3, Ceballos is batting .291 (32-for-110) with four homers, eight doubles and 19 RBIs.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, **Diego Velasquez** is ranked tied for fourth in hits (105), fifth in walks (61) and eighth in OBP (.361). **Turner Hill** is tied for fifth in triples (5). **John Michael Bertrand** is third in innings pitched (114.2), third in ERA (2.98), sixth in BAA (.247) and seventh in WHIP (1.33). **Jack Choate** is fifth in strikeouts (114). **Joe Whitman** is sixth in strikeouts (109). **Tyler Myrick** is tied for first in saves (10).

**TOP SKIPPER:** Flying Squirrels manager **Dennis Pelfrey** has led the team to 247 wins in his career, which is a new franchise record all-time wins record for a manager. He passed the record with Richmond's 6-1 win at Binghamton on May 23. From 2011-2013, **Dave Machemer** won 216 games as Richmond's manager, leading the team to the Eastern League postseason for in 2011. Pelfrey, who has been with Richmond since the 2022 season, led the team to back-to-back postseason appearances for the first time in franchise history in 2022 and 2023. He also managed the 2021 Eugene Emeralds to the High-A West championship.

**PROSPECT WATCH:** Richmond's roster features four players are ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including **Bo Davidson** (No. 3), **Diego Velasquez** (No. 10), **Joe Whitman** (No. 11) and **Jack Choate** (No. 30). **John Michael Bertrand** is rated as having the best control in the Giants system. **Adrian Sugastey** is ranked as the top defensive catcher. **Aeverson Arteaga** is rated as the best defensive infielder and best infield arm. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list features three Richmond players, including Davidson (No. 5), Whitman (No. 14) and Velasquez (No. 21).

# THIS DATE IN RICHMOND

1966: The Richmond Braves beat the Columbus Jets, 6-4, at Parker Field. After an early Richmond lead, Jose Martinez hit a two-run homer in the top of the sixth to tie the score, 3-3. Dave Wissman hit an RBI single in the top of the eighth to give Columbus a 4-3 lead before Chris Cannizzaro tied the game with a single in the bottom of the inning. With two outs in the bottom of the 10th, Tomie Aaron hit a two-run walk-off homer to win the game Cannizzaro tied the game with a single in the bottom of the inning. 1979: The Richmond Braves beat the Tidewater Tides, 3-2, at Parker Field. Jim Arline hit an RBI single and Chico Ruiz brought in a run with a sacrifice fly for a 2-0 Richmond lead in the second inning. Bob Beall added a solo homer in the third. Tommy Boggs allowed two runs over 7 1/3 innings and became the first Richmond pitcher to reach 15 wins in the R-Braves era. The win clinched a spot for Richmond in the 1979 Governors Cup playoffs in an attempt to defend their 1978 title. 1984: The Richmond Braves beat the Columbus Clippers, 8-5, at Parker Field. Steve Shields, who had not thrown more than six innings in an outing that year, threw a complete game and allowed four earned runs. Paul Zuvella had a homer, two doubles and three RBIs. Terry Harper also drove in three runs. 1989: The Richmond Braves beat the Indianapolis Indians, 3-2, at Parker Field. Tommy Greene started and threw five scoreless innings. In the fourth, Ron Gant walked and came around to score on a double by David Justice for a 1-0 lead. Mark Lemke scored on a wild pitch in the sixth to open a 2-0 lead. Indianapolis rallied to tie the score in the ninth. In the bottom of the 10th, Kash Beachamp drove in Barry Jones with a bases-loaded single to the warning track to win the game.

2019: The Flying Squirrels beat the Erie SeaWolves, 7-6, at UPMC Park. Joey Bart picked up four hits, including a double, and drove in one run. Heliot Ramos had two homer.
