Today's Game: The Sounds start their third road series of the season versus Louisville tonight at Louisville Slugger Park. Right-hander Carlos Rodríguez gets the ball for the Sounds and will go up against right-hander Christian Roa.

Carlos Rodríguez: The 22-year-old righty gets his fourth start (fifth appearance) for the Sounds this season. He is coming off his best start of the season against Omaha on April 17 where he went 6.1 innings, six hits, three earned runs, one walk and four strikeouts. It was his first quality start at the Triple-A level and the deepest he has pitched in a game since September 13, 2023 versus Montgomery (6.1 IP). His only career start that was longer came on May 27, 2023 against Montgomery (7.0 IP).

Christian Roa: The 25-year-old righty is making his first start of the season after coming off the injured list. He had 28 appearances (25 starts) for Double-A Chattanooga and Triple-A Louisville in 2023. He posted a 5.16 ERA (120.1 IP/69 ER) with 91 walks and 170 strikeouts. Roa struck out 83 batters in 61.1 innings in Louisville. The deepest that Roa has pitched in a game at the Triple-A level is 5.2 innings which came in his last start on September 21, 2023 against Iowa. Roa has never faced Nashville but is 2-0 with a 1.50 ERA (12.0 IP/2 ER) with 13 strikeouts in two starts against Biloxi. Tyler Black doubled off of him in the game on June 23, 2023. He was drafted in the second round by the Reds in 2020. Roa was ranked as the #15 ranked prospect in the Reds organization according to MLB.com back in 2022.

Injury Report: On Sunday, outfielder Chris Roller was added to the 7-day injured list, retroactive April 20. He becomes the sixth Sounds player to join the injured list, a day after left-handed reliever Darrell Thompson was added. The Sounds have lost several key players to injury this season, including losing prospect Jeferson Quero in the first game of the season. However, left-hander and 2023 International League Pitcher of the Year Robert Gasser is expected to return and make his first start of 2024 with Nashville at Louisville on Wednesday morning.

Speedy Brews: Brewer Hicklen stole his 11th base of the season on Sunday against Omaha. He is tied for fourth in Triple-A in stolen bases. The next closest player on the Sounds is Chavez Young at four. In his career at Triple-A, he has a stolen base percentage of 90.5% (67-for-74). Hicklen leads the team in total bases (40) and is tied for the team-lead in walks (14) and plate appearances (88).

Kevin and Big Z: Kevin Herget picked up his second win of the season with a scoreless 1.1 innings of work on Sunday. Rob Zastryzny also added a scoreless 1.0 innings with two strikeouts. The two relievers have a combined 5-0 record with a 0.00 ERA in 15.2 innings and only one walk while striking out 18. The duo has accounted for nearly half of the Sounds wins and Zastryzny has held batters to a minuscule .040 batting average.

Bahamian Rhapsody: Chavez Young hit his first home run of the season on Sunday. His last home run was on August 20, 2023 at Bowie. Young had a productive series against Omaha reaching base in five of the six games (5-for-18) with three walks, three RBI, three runs and three outfield assists. He has accounted for three of the four outfield assists with the other also happening in the Omaha series (Issac Collins). The team lead in that category last season was Monte Harrison with six.

The Black Album: Tyler Black mashed a solo home run and had four RBI in Sunday's contest. In the series he was 7-for-23 with five runs scored, two triples, two home runs and eight RBI. His eight RBI was the most he has had in a series since September 5-10, 2023 against Memphis where he had 10. Black leads the team in triples (3) and hits (23). He is also second on the team in RBI (13) and total bases (36).

Bullpen Beat: The Sounds bullpen rebounded with an excellent performance on Sunday. Reliever Nick Bennett got the start and five different Sounds pitchers combined to allow seven hits, three earned runs and struck out seven. Nashville's bullpen has a 1.81 ERA which is the best in Triple-A with the next closest at 3.40 (Sacramento). They also lead Triple-A pens in WHIP (0.95) and batting average against (.156).

Tobias Time: Pitcher Tobias Myers was recalled by Milwaukee yesterday and will make his Major League debut this evening at Pittsburgh. Myers would be the first Sound to make his Major League debut this season with Milwaukee and the 16th to go from Nashville to Milwaukee for their MLB debut since 2021.

The Sweet Life: Manager Rick Sweet returns for his fourth consecutive season as the Sounds manager (5th overall) and his 34th season as a manager in MiLB. Sweet is the winningest manager in Nashville Sounds history, earning his 321st victory in the 2023 season finale vs. Jacksonville. This is his 11th season as manager of the Brewers' Triple-A affiliate and boasts a 694-593 record (Nashville in 2014, Colorado Springs from 2015-18, San Antonio in 2019 and Nashville 2021-). Overall, Sweet has a career managerial record of 2,286-2,113 - that's the fifth most wins in MiLB history and second among active managers (only Buddy Bailey with Single-A Myrtle Beach has more wins).

Sounds Manager Rick Sweet ranks fifth among Minor League managers in wins. He has the second-most among active managers, trailing Single-A Myrtle Beach manager Buddy Bailey.
