WEDNESDAY'S RECAP

The Baysox came from behind to beat the Senators, 6-4, in 11 innings on Wednesday afternoon. After falling behind 4-0 early, **Hudson Haskin** tied the game on a grand slam in the sixth. That score held into the 11th inning, where Chesapeake took the lead on an RBI single from Jeremiah Jackson and later added a sacrifice fly from Silas Ardoin. The Baysox bullpen contributed seven shutout innings in the victory, including two scoreless frames from Houston Roth, who picked up the win on Wednesday. It was Chesapeake's third-consecutive victory.

CREED CRUSHES

C Creed Willems is tied for sixth in the Eastern League in doubles (10) and extra base hits (17). The Orioles No. 12 prospect homered in consecutive games for the Baysox (5/17, 5/18 vs AKR) for the third time in his career this past weekend. Willems' four homers in the month of May are tied for second-most in the league, while his .956 OPS this month leads the team. The 21-year-old is the youngest position player on the Baysox.

WALK THIS WAY

C Silas Ardoin leads the Eastern League in walks (31). Ardoin drew the most walks in the league in the month of April with 18. No player has drawn more walks in the circuit since April 23 than Ardoin. Last season, he drew 47 walks in 104 games.

ACTION JACKSON

Over his last nine games, IF Jeremiah Jackson is batting .351 with two home runs, five doubles, and a 1.024 OPS. The first year Baysox shortstop is tied for second in the league in doubles (13). The next home run for Jackson will be the 100th of his pro career. A former Mets farmhand who played 158 games with the Binghamton Rumble Ponies, Jackson has homered in every Eastern League ballpark aside from FNB Field in Harrisburg.

BULLPEN BEASTS

Chesapeake's bullpen holds a 2.93 ERA, which is third-best in Double-A and fifthbest in MiLB. Baysox relievers have tossed 13.1 scoreless innings to open this week in Harrisburg - the most of any Minor League team. The Baysox opened the season with 15-consecutive scoreless innings from the bullpen. Chesapeake relievers lead the Eastern League and are second in Double-A in strikeouts (231).

ONE RUN WONDERS

Despite having scored the third-fewest runs in all of Double-A (138), Chesapeake is currently tied for the most one-run victories in MiLB this season with 12 (Triple-A Oklahoma City). Chesapeake has played more one-run games (20) than any team in the minors so far this season.

SCOUTING THE SENATORS

The Harrisburg Senators enter the week with a record of 19-20 on the season, currently fourth-place in the Southwest division. The Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals, Harrisburg's 88 runs in the month of May are 19 more than any other Eastern League team. They also lead the league in team batting average (.272) and extra-base hits (49) this month. The Senators roster features three active members of the Nationals Top 30 prospect list (per MLB.com) - IF Cayden Wallace (No. 10), IF Yohandy Morales (No. 12), and IF Kevin Made (No. 26). Harrisburg is managed by returning skipper Delino DeShields, who appeared in four games for the Baysox in 1999 during his playing career.

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Riley Cornelio is expected to start for the Senators tonight. This will be his second Double-A start after making his Double-A debut on May 13 against Richmond. The 24-year-old threw six shutout innings and allowed just two hits and two walks with five strikeouts in a no decision. Cornelio began the season in High-A Wilmington where he recorded a 3.03 ERA in seven starts spanning 32.2 innings.

ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

Roberto Mercado returns for his second season as Baysox Manager in 2025 after completing his first year at the Double-A level last season. The 17th manager in franchise history, he led the Baysox to a 62-75 overall record, oversaw 18 player promotions to Triple-A and coached two former Baysox who would go on to make their Major League debuts in the same season. The New Britain, CT native also managed the Surprise Saguaros of the Arizona Fall League this past offseason, where he led them to a league-best 18-10 record and a Fall League Championship Game appearance.

Before the Baysox, Mercado spent two seasons as manager of the Aberdeen IronBirds - the Orioles' High-A affiliate. Mercado received the Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award in 2022 by the Orioles.

Prior to joining the O's, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut and served as Dean of Students for over 18 years.

JORDIE HENRY

Pitching Coach

Jordie Henry enters his first season as Baysox Pitching Coach in 2025 and his third season as a member of the Orioles' system. Previously, Henry served as the pitching coach at High-A Aberdeen where his staff recorded 1,357 strikeouts last season – 2nd-most in the South Atlantic League and 2nd-most in IronBirds franchise history. Before joining the Orioles, Henry was the Director of Pitching at Prime Sports Performance in Baltimore – a private athletic development training facility. He also worked as a pitching coach and instructor at the high school and summer collegiate levels. Henry pitched collegiately for four seasons at Wayland Baptist University.

JOSH BUNSELMEYER

Hitting Coach

Josh Bunselmeyer returns for his second season as Baysox Hitting Coach in 2025 and his sixth as a member of the Orioles' system. He joined the Baysox as hitting coach in 2024, after filling the same role for the Orioles' Single-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, in 2023. He spent the previous three campaigns as a hitting coach in both the Florida Complex League and Dominican Summer League. Bunselmeyer played three seasons in the Independent Frontier League following a collegiate playing career at St. Louis University.

CHESAPEAKE OYSTER CATCHERS



For select home games, the Chesapeake Baysox will take the field as the Chesapeake Oyster Catchers as a tribute to the Chesapeake Bay's rich heritage and thriving ecosystem.

Inspired by the American oystercatcher, the prominent patterned shorebird can be found along the Chesapeake Bay year-round. With its bold black-and-white plumage, orange beak, and knack for hunting shellfish, the oystercatcher is a symbol of strength and ingenuity—qualities that define both the Chesapeake region and its passionate baseball fans.

The Oyster Catchers name also pays homage to the Chesapeake Bay's rich maritime traditions and oyster restoration efforts, celebrating the region's deep connection to its waters.

CANGREJOS FANTASMAS DE CHESAPEAKE



The Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake (Chesapeake Ghost Crabs) are a part of MiLB's "Copa de la Diversión™" or "Fun Cup™"- a season-long event series specifically designed to embrace the culture and values that resonate most with Minor League Baseball™ teams' local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identiy came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.

BOWIE PIT BEEF



The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Chesapeake Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland.



Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.
