COLUMBUS, OHIO – The Omaha Storm Chasers shut out the Columbus Clippers to split this week's series Sunday afternoon, with a 2-0 win at Huntington Park.

- In the top of the 2nd inning, Omaha continued its strong offensive performance from the night before as **Tyler Gentry** led off the inning with a single up the middle ... the next at-bat, **CJ Alexander** knocked his first of two doubles on the day to right field to put two runners in scoring position.
- With one out and two runners on in the second inning, left fielder **Nate Eaton** hammered a double of his own to right field and brought Gentry and Alexander home to make the score 2-0 and give the Storm Chasers took the early lead, their lone runs of the day.
- The rest of the day offered little in offense, as the Storm Chasers were held to two hits over the final seven innings and Columbus could not find a way onto the scoreboard.
- Omaha starting pitcher **William Fleming** shined in his Triple-A debut with a 2024 Chasers individual-best six strikeouts over 4.2 scoreless innings ... reliever **Steven Cruz** replaced Fleming with two outs in the bottom of the 5th inning and pitched his way out of danger and stranded two inherited runners on base.
- That fifth inning was one of only a few times where Columbus threatened, as **Daniel Schneeman** led off the bottom of the 5th inning with a single and **Micah Pries** was hit by a pitch to bring Schneeman into scoring position but stellar Storm Chasers defense and a strikeout from Cruz prevented Columbus from crossing home plate.
- In the bottom of the 6th inning, Columbus pressured again with runners at the corners ... Cruz was relieved by **Walter Pennington** as he struck out followed what Cruz did the inning prior and stranded a pair on with a three-pitch strikeout to end the inning ... Pennington also offered a scoreless 7th to earn his first win of the year.
- Tyler Duffey** pitched a perfect 8th inning before giving way to **Dan Altavilla**, who worked around a pair of baserunners to earn his first save of the year in the ninth.
- Omaha's five pitchers combined to pitch its first shutout win of the year, after the offense was held scoreless three straight games to open the week.

NOTES AND NUGGETS

FAMILIAR FACES

A few familiar faces will take the field this week at Werner Park, both for Omaha and Gwinnett.

- Stripers catcher **Sebastian Rivero** played 45 games for Omaha between 2019 and 2021, including 42 games with a .260 average (39-for-150) and .699 OPS in 2021.
- Omaha outfielder **Drew Waters** played for Gwinnett from 2019 to 2022, appearing in 178 games for the Stripers before he was traded to Kansas City in July 2022.

DAZZLING DEFENSE

While still early in the season, the Omaha Storm Chasers have established themselves at one of the best defensive teams in Minor League Baseball, with just 1 error made in 315 total chances (.997 fielding percentage) across the first 9 games of the season.

- The Chasers haven't made a fielding or throwing error, just a caught stealing error (interference) by **Cam Devanney** on March 30 vs. Iowa.
- Omaha has not made an error in its last 7 games ... last year, the Chasers had just one stretch of more than 5 games without an error, a 10-game errorless streak between July 14 and 25 ... since 2011, the Storm Chasers have just 6 stretches of 7+ games without making an error and last year's 10-game streak is tied for the longest (with the 2018 Omaha Storm Chasers, July 22 to August 2).
- Devanney's 83.3mph average arm strength ranks as the best among International League shortstops with at least 15 total chances this season.

RELIABLE RELIEVERS

The Storm Chasers bullpen is still of the best in the International League as Omaha's relievers have combined for a 3.83 ERA through the team's first 9 games.

- A 3.83 ERA (18 ER in 42.1 IP) ranks 9th among the 30 Triple-A teams.
- The Storm Chasers bullpen has combined to hold opposing hitters to a .188 average (.28-for-149), which is the second-best mark among Triple-A teams, trailing only Nashville (.145 average).
- Three relievers have yet to allow a run this year: **Walter Pennington** (7.0 IP), **Sam Long** (4.2 IP) and **Will Klein** (4.0 IP) ... Pennington has the most scoreless innings of any International League reliever, the 4th-most scoreless innings pitched without allowing a run of any arm in the league.

DID YOU GET A WHIFF OF THAT?

Omaha's hitters have 106 strikeouts (31.7% strikeout rate), the most strikeouts of any Minor League team and the highest strikeout rate of any Triple-A team and the most average strikeouts per game (11.8 K/G)

- The next-closest team in strikeouts is the Toledo Mud Hens, with 103 strikeouts as a team (29.2% strikeout rate), also the closest Triple-A team in strikeout rate and strikeouts per game (11.4 strikeouts per game).
- Omaha has 10+ strikeouts at the plate in 6 of 9 games thus far, with three games of 15+ strikeouts ... last year, the team had 10 or more strikeouts in 59 games (40%), but 15+ strikeouts in just 5 games (4 times in August).

CAREER NOTES

- 2023**
- ✓ After opening the year at NW Arkansas (AA), Bowlan earned a promotion to Omaha on June 20 and made 14 appearances (12 starts) for the Storm Chasers, before earning his first big league call-up on September 19.
 - ✓ Having not pitched into the 6th inning in over two years, did so in five of his final seven outings with Omaha ... three of his last four starts with the Chasers were quality starts - 8/30 vs. LOU (6.0 IP, 1 ER), 9/5 @ IOW (6.0 IP, 2 ER) & 9/16 vs. IND (6.0 IP, 2 ER).
 - ✓ 669 days after being added to the 40-man roster (on 11/19/21), was called up by the Royals for the first time on September 19 and made his Major League debut 8 days later on September 27 at DET as KC's opener, his first of two MLB outings ... struck out **Parker Meadows** to begin the game and allowed a solo home run to **Miguel Cabrera** in the 2nd inning, Miggy's final MLB homer.

- ✓ After undergoing Tommy John Surgery in 2021, returned to the mound June 17 in the Arizona Complex League and made seven starts with the ACL Royals (R), one start with Quad Cities (A+) and finished the year with NW Arkansas (AA) for his final nine starts.
 - ✓ Was named Texas League Pitcher of the Week for the week of August 22 to 28, after throwing 5.0 scoreless innings on August 28 vs. Springfield (STL) and allowing just two hits with two strikeouts to earn his first win of 2022 with the Naturals.
 - ✓ After allowing two home runs in each of his first two starts, allowed three homers over his last seven starts ... 10 of 33 runs (30%) allowed with NWA came on home runs.
