> ROSTER MOVES: Prior to Friday's game, the Pittsburgh Pirates assigned 2024 15th round pick INF Ethan Lege to the Marauders roster. The former Ole Miss Rebel is scheduled to bat second and play third base. He becomes the sixth player from this year's draft class to play

> **HOME DROUGHT:** The Marauders dropped their third-straight contest at home on Thursday night to Dunedin, tying a season-long losing skid at home. After owning a 22-14 record at home in the first, Bradenton is just 8-13 in the second half at LECOM Park.

TONIGHT'S STARTER: RHP Carlos Jimenez has been on a groove since just before the All-Star break. Over his last six appearances, Jimenez is 2-0 with a 1.21 ERA. He's struck out 24 in 22.1 innings with opponents hitting just .179 against. The 1.21 ERA is the second-best among qualified pithcers in the Florida State League during this span.

ON A ROLL: Since coming off the injured list on August 2, LHP Michael Kennedy has been superb in his three starts. The southpaw sports a 1.38 ERA after only allowing two earned runs on five hits while striking out 14 and only walking two in 13.0 innings. Opponents are hitting just .116 off him in August.

 $\textbf{THOU SHALL NOT PASS: RHP Danny Carrion} \ to ssed two more scoreless innings on Wednesday night to run his scoreless innings streak up to nine innings. Over his last five plus outings, Carrion has allowed just two hits while striking out eight. The 2023 9th round pick has lowered to the contract of the contract o$ his season ERA from 5.40 to 3.26.

FLASH: Justin Miknis is riding a season-long 12-game on-base streak after recording two hits on Tuesday night against Dunedin. During this streak, Miknis is hitting .206/.400/.324 with a double, HR, 11 walks, and five runs scored. It's the third-longest active streak in the Florida State League right now.

GRAND SALAMI: C Derek Berg's first professional home run came on an inside-the-park grand slam last Thursday night in Port St. Lucie. For the Marauders, it's their second inside-the-park grand slam this year, with the other coming from Esmerlyn Valdez against the Mets at LECOM Park on May 10. A week later, Will Taylor's first professional hit was a grand slam against Dunedin at LECOM Park. Bradenton has six grand slams this year, which is the second-most in Single-A and tied for the eighth-most in all of Minor League Baseball. Last year, Bradenton hit four with Deivis Nadal hitting one on same day last year (Aug. 15) as Taylor's.

AMONG LEAGUE LEADERS: The Marauders hold four of the top nine home run leaders in the Florida State League, with **Esmerlyn Valdez** leading the way in second with 17 longballs. **Axiel Plaz** is currently in third with 15, **Javier Rivas** is in eighth with 11 and **Shalin Polanco** is tied for ninth with 10. Valdez is one just HR shy of tying league leader in Ariel Almonte (Daytona). The 17 HR hit by a Valdez are the second-most by a Marauder since the Florida State League was moved from High-A to Low-A. Rodolfo Nolasco hit 20 bombs last year for Bradenton to lead the way.

CLOSE QUARTERS: Thursday night's loss to the Blue Jays marked the Marauders' 38th one-run contest of the season. The Marauders own an 18-20 record in those games. Bradenton has lost their last five one-run games.
