TONIGHT'S GAME

The Round Rock Express and El Paso Chihuahuas will play game five of the six-game series tonight in El Paso. Round Rock RHP Jack Leiter takes the mound against El Paso LHP Jackson Wolf. First pitch at Southwest University Park is scheduled for 7:35 p.m. CT.

LATE INNING LOSS

The Express lost in walk-off fashion to the Chihuahuas on Friday night by a final score of 5-4. The six-game series in El Paso is now even at two games apiece. For the second time in as many nights, the Express got on the board in the top of the first inning via the long ball. SS Davis Wendzel hit a two-run homer to provide the early 2-0 lead. DH Andrew Knapp opened the second inning with a solo shot and increased the Round Rock advantage to 3-0. The E-Train would add their third big fly of the night in the fourth. 1B Blaine Crim went yard for the second time in his last two games to make it 4-0. El Paso DH Brett Sullivan hit a bases loaded triple in the bottom of the fifth to cut the Round Rock lead to 4-3. The Chihuahuas would tie it at four on a sacrifice fly by RF Bryce Johnson. Fast forward to the bottom of the ninth, Sullivan came up big again for El Paso. His walk off RBI double scored 3B Matthew Batten from first base to give the Chihuahuas a 5-4 win. Chihuahuas DH Brett Sullivan went 5-for-5 with a double, triple, four RBI and one run scored. It's the first time an opposing player has collected five hits against the Express since OF Jake Hager did it on July 7, 2018 with the Colorado Springs Sky Sox.

LEIT IT UP

Express RHP Jack Leiter goes to the mound for his first start of the year on Saturday. His first outing of the season was in relief on March 30 against Sugar Land. He went 5.0 innings allowing two runs on two hits with nine strikeouts. The 2021 second overall pick struck out six consecutive Sugar Land hitters and he tossed 4.1 innings before allowing a hit in his Dell Diamond debut.

DEJA VU

Round Rock SS Davis Wendzel and 1B Blaine Crim are enjoying their stay in El Paso this week. The pair of sluggers have homered in each of the past two games and are a combined 7-for-16 with four home runs and six RBI in those contests. Wendzel has nine career home runs against El Paso in 42 games.

OVERPOWERING OFFENSE

The Round Rock lineup leads the Pacific Coast League with 12 home runs to start the season. In addition to the long ball, Round Rock has produced 76 hits, which is tied with Reno for the PCL lead. The team also ranks first in both slugging percentage (.556) and OPS (.933). Last night was just the second game they have scored less than eight runs this year.

MR. FABIAN IS FEELING IT

OF Sandro Fabian finished yesterday 2-for-4 with a double. He is slashing .450/.476/.800 in his first five games. The 26-year old has hit safely in all five of the games he has played this season. Among PCL hitters, Fabian ranks top 10 in batting average (T-2nd), on-base percentage (T-9th), slugging percentage (4th), OPS (4th), hits (T-6th), doubles (T-1st) and XBH (T-3rd).

TIME FOR A KNAPP

Express C Andrew Knapp is slashing .368/.381/.789 with two doubles, two home runs, four RBI and four runs scored in his first five games of the season. Knapp is 27 games away from 900 in his pro career.

ALCS EXPRESS REUNION

The 2023 ALCS between Houston and Texas featured 22 players that appeared in a game for the Express. The Express reunited as the Rangers Triple-A affiliate in 2021 after spending eight seasons as the club's top affiliate from 2011-2018. Round Rock was previously a member of the Houston Astros organization from 2019-2020. From the Rangers, LHP Cody Bradford (2023), OF Evan Carter (2023), C Mitch Garver (2022, 2023), OF Travis Jankowski (2023), INF Josh Jung (2021, 2022), RHP Jose Leclerc (2016, 2018, 2022), LHP Martin Perez (2011, 2012, 2013, 2015, 2018), RHP Josh Sborz (2022, 2023), INF Josh Smith (2022), OF Leody Taveras (2021, 2022, 2023) appeared in the ALCS. For the Astros, RHP Bryan Abreu (2019), INF Jose Altuve (2019), INF Yordan Alvarez (2019), RHP Ronel Blanco (2019), RHP Cristian Javier (2019), OF Chas McCormick (2019), OF Kyle Tucker (2019), RHP Jose Urquidy (2019), LHP Framber Valdez (2019) appeared in the series and also played for the E-Train.

EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS

The 2024 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's second season with the E-Train. In his first season with the Express in 2023, he guided Round Rock to a PCL Second Half title and the club's first playoff appearance since 2019. The team's 89 total wins were the most regular-season wins in franchise history and just the seventh 80-win campaign in club history. Davis oversaw the longest winning streak in franchise history when the Express won 14 consecutive games last year from August 8-23.



Prior to Round Rock, Davis spent two seasons as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 673-588 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the 2003 World Series.

In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach.

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.
