LAST TIME OUT

The Baysox overcame three rain delays on Saturday and Sunday to sweep a Sunday doubleheader by final scores of 2-1 in 10 innings and 6-3 to win their first series of the second half. **Jud Fabian** grounded the go-ahead RBI single in the 10th in the first game and **Lincoln Henzman** threw three scoreless innings of relief to earn the win. In the second game, Bowie never trailed and **Samuel Basallo** returned to the lineup and doubled in a run in a three-run seventh.

BASALLO BITS

C/1B **Samuel Basallo** has reached base safely in 29 of his last 31 games dating back to May 21, including in his last nine strai. After suffering a lower body contusion on Thursday, Basallo returned to the lineup on Sunday and doubled in a run in the seventh. His 19-game on-base streak from May 21 to June 12 is the longest Baysox on-base streak this season and is tied for the sixth-longest in the Eastern League. Over his last 31 games, the 19-year-old is slashing .313/.392/.940 with six homers and

BENCOSME BARRELS

After a double on Saturday, IF **Frederick Bencosme** continues to own the longest active hit streak in the league at 14 consecutive games, which is also the longest hit streak by a Baysox player this season. The Orioles No. 27 prospect is slashing .286/.390/.737 over this span.

WELCOME MR. ETZEL

OF/1B **Matthew Etzel** was the first Orioles '23 draft pick to be promoted to Double-A after being selected in the 10th round out of So. Miss. The 22-year-old hit his first two Double-A homers at Reading this past week. His 37 steals on the season between High-A Aberdeen and Double-A Bowie is seventh-most in all of MiLB.

BOWENS BATS 'EM IN

1B **TT Bowens** is the first Baysox player to reach 40 RBI on the season after his tie-breaking solo homer on Saturday. He has the eighth-most RBI in the league and has the third-most doubles (17) in the circuit. After playing only 47 games last year due to injuries, Bowens has stayed healthy this year with already 60 games played.

THE FANTASTIC FABIAN

OF **Jud Fabian** is tied for the league lead among active Eastern League players with 13 home runs on the season. Fabian hit a league-high six homers in the month of May and hit five in June.

ON-BASE BEAVERS

OF/1B **Dylan Beavers** has reached base in 53 of 64 games started in his second season with the Baysox. The Orioles No. 7 prospect leads the team in OBP (.342) and leads the team in walks (38), tied for the third-most in the Eastern League.

SHOVING THE SHOVE

After recording a 4.28 ERA in the month of May, Bowie's pitching staff recorded the seventh-lowest ERA in all of Double-A in the month of June (3.51). The Baysox have struck out the most batters in all of Double-A (762).

SIZING UP THE SQUIRRELS

The Richmond Flying Squirrels finished the first half in fourth in the Southwest Division with a record of 34-35. The Double-A affiliate of the San Francisco Giants lost five of six to open the second half against Somerset but have won nine of 12 against Bowie in the season series. Richmond's active roster includes only three of the Giants' top 30 prospects (per MLB Pipeline) - RHP Trevor McDonald (No. 12), OF/1B Victor Bericoto (No. 19) and OF Jairo Pomares (No. 26).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

LHP John Michael Bertrand makes his 15th start of the season for the Flying Squirrels. Bertrand has thrown the seventh most innings in the league (76.2) but posted a 5.96 ERA in the month of June in five starts. Against Bowie this year, Bertrand has not allowed a hit nor a run in 13 innings thrown over two starts. The 26-year-old southpaw threw seven perfect innings in his first start against Bowie before throwing six no-hit innings almost a month later.

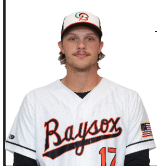

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the "Chesapeake Baysox." This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stenciled outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince George's Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.



BOWIE PIT BEEF

The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization's Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022.
