SECOND HALF PATS: The Somerset Patriots secured their third straight win on Sunday to clinch their third five-win series this season. Sunday's win was also Somerset's second win of the series when being out-hit, improving to 5-31 in such games. The streak started with Somerset winning back-to-back games in which they trailed entering the ninth inning on Friday and Saturday. The back-to-back walk-off wins were Somerset's first two this season when trailing after eight innings, improving to 2-25 in such games. In the second half of the season, the Patriots are 3-1 in one-run games, matching their total of wins in one-run games during the first half, when they had a record of 3-10. Since Somerset's last trip to New Hampshire on 6/17, the Patriots' 13-5 record is the best in the Eastern League over the last 18 games. TO PEACH THEIR OWN: Yankees top prosepct George Lombard Jr. will represent the Yankees at the 2025 MLB All-Star Futures game at Truist Park in Atlanta. Lombard becomes the seventh Somerset Patriot to suit up in the game, joining Luis Medina (2021), Anthony Volpe (2022), Ken Waldichuk (2022), Jasson Dominugez (2021-22), Clayton

**SECOND HALF PATS:** In two home starts this season, Lagrange has tossed 8 IP over which he has allowed 10 H, 9 R, and 12 BB while recording 6 K with a 10.13 ERA at home. In three road starts this season, Lagrange has worked 17.1 IP in which he has allowed 8 H, 5 R, and 5 BB with 28 K for a 2.60 ERA on the road.

HAVING A FIELD DAY: Since the start of the second half, the Somerset Patriots have committed four errors in 12 games, which is good for a .991 fielding percentage, trailing only Richmond (.993) for the highest fielding percentage in the Eastern League in the second half. **SUMMER WINS:** With his first win of the season on Sunday, Trystan Vrieling became the Somerset Patriots' all-time career wins leader with his 14th career win for Somerset. In 2024, Vrieling set the Patriots' single-season wins record by going 13-7. Following Indigo Diaz's seventh win of the season on Saturday night, he has tied the Patriots' all-time single-season wins record by a reliever (Barrett Loseke - 7. 2022)

**NEW SHADE OF INDIGO:** Indigo Diaz threw 1.2 scoreless innings on Saturday to earn his team-best seventh win of the season and his second of this series. Since 5/11 @AKR, Diaz has thrown 20.1 IP over which he has allowed 6 H, 1 R, 8 BB and recorded 19 K. In this stretch, Diaz has posted a 0.44 ERA, a 0.69 WHIP and a .094 BAA. His 0.44 ERA since 5/11 is the second-best mark in the Eastern League among pitchers with 20+ IP (A. Magno - ERI, 0.38 ERA).

THE ROC IS COOKIN': Roc Riggio ended his career-best four-hit

performance on Saturday with a two-run walk-off single in the bottom of the ninth inning. Riggio became the fourth Patriot this season to amass a four-hit game (T. Hardman - 4/29 @RIC, S. Jones - 6/20 @ NH, B. Jones - 7/3 @REA). Riggio went 9-for-21 (.429 AVG) during last week's series with 7 RBIs (1st in the Eastern League) to go along with 5 XBH, 15 TB and 4 BB.

#### 2025 SOMERSET PATRIOTS COACHING STAFF

#### RAUL DOMINGUEZ: Manager (3rd year)

Raul Dominguez enters his third consecutive season as manager for the Somerset Patriots, 11th overall as a manager and 19th coaching in the Yankees organization. He led the 2023 Patriots to a Double-A best record of 84-53 and a +211 run differential, which ranked first among all MiLB teams. Under his leadership, the Patriots finished with the Eastern League's top record in both halves of the season and clinched their second straight playoff berth. In 2024, Dominguez led the Patriots to their third consecutive playoff berth and their second appearance in the Eastern League Championship Series with an overall record of 75-62. Dominguez's Patriots erased a 6.0-game deficit in the final 30 games of the regular season by going 22-8 to end the campaign and clinching the Eastern League Northeast division's second half title with a second half record of 43-25. Before joining Somerset, Dominguez spent the prior two seasons (2021-2022) as a defensive coach for Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre. He previously served as defensive coach for Trenton (2018-2019) and Tampa (2017). He gained prior managerial experience with the GCL Yankees East (2016), DSL Yankees 1 (2011-15) and DSL Yankees 2 (2009-10). An outfielder during his playing career, Dominguez spread four minor league seasons for with the Yankees between the DSL and the GCL. He began his coaching career in 2008 with the DSL Yankees 2, after spending 2007 as a Yankees' tryout scout in the Dominican Republic.

#### MIKE FRANSOSO: Hitting Coach (1st year)

Hitting coach Mike Fransoso enters his first season as a Double-A coach in Somerset and with the Yankees organization. He spent the past five years as a member of the Seattle Mariners organization, most recently with the Double-A Arkansas Travelers as the team's hitting coach. On 8/13/24, Fransoso took over as the Travelers' interim manager and led the team to clinch a second-half playoff berth en route to winning the 2024 Texas League Championship. He also previously served as the hitting coach for High-A Everett (2023), Class-A Modesto (2022) and the AZL Mariners (2021). During his playing career, Fransoso played for the Somerset Patriots in 2018 and 2019 when the team was independent. Prior to his stint playing for the Patriots, he spent three seasons in the Pittsburgh Pirates organization after being a 27th round pick of the team in 2013 MLB Draft out of the University of Maine.

#### PETER LARSON: Pitching Coach (1st year)

Pitching coach Peter Larson enters his first season in Somerset and with the Yankees organization. He spent the past six seasons as a member of the Minnesota Twins organization, including the last two with the Triple-A St. Paul Saints (2023-2024). For Minnesota, Larson also previously served as the pitching coach for Double-A Wichita (2022) and Low-A Fort Myers (2019). In 2020, he was slated to be the pitching coach for Low-A Cedar Rapids, before the Covid cancellation of the minor league season. His first season with the Twins, he served as the minor league rehab pitching coach (2019). Prior to his professional career, Larson worked as a pitching coach at the collegiate level for Fordham University (2018) and the University of Albany (2017). He also served as an assistant coach for Siena College (2016) and King University (2015).

#### **DEREK WOODLEY:** Defensive Coach (1st year)

Derek Woodley enters his first season in Somerset and his third with the Yankees organization. He spent the last two seasons as the defensive coach for High-A Hudson Valley (2023-2024). Following the 2024 season, he represented the Yankees at the Arizona Fall League as an extra coach for the Salt River Rafters. Prior to joining the Yankees organization, Woodley spent 30 seasons as a college baseball coach, racking up over 300 wins and most recently as the head coach for Defiance College for 15 seasons from 2008-2022. He also served as the school's athletic director from 2019-2022.

#### **UZIEL VILORIA:** Defensive Coach (1st year)

Uziel Viloria enters his first season in Somerset and in the Yankees organization. He began his coaching career in 2024 as a coach in the Phillies organization. During his playing career, Viloria signed with the Phillies as an international free agent in 2019 and went on to play 112 games in four seasons as an infielder in the organization (2019-2023), making it as high as High-A Jersey Shore.

**CARLOS LAGRANGE'S HIGHS** 

#### 2025

Started the 2025 Spring Breakout Game for the Yankees on 3/15 @BAL. Over 4.0 IP, Lagrange allowed 2 H, 2 R (1 ER) with 2 K and 0 BB. Began the season with High-A Hudson Valley. In eight starts, he posted a 4.10 ERA with 64 K and 12 BB in 41.2 innings. Promoted to Double-A Somerset on 6/3. At the time of his promotion, Lagrange was third in the South Atlantic League in K (64), fifth in WHIP (1.03) and eighth in BA (.203).

#### 2024

Limited to nine appearances due to a back injury, topping out at Single-A Tampa. Over nine total starts, Lagrange was 0-1 with a 6.86 ERA with 27 K and 20 BB in 21.0 IP. Following the season, he pitched in the Arizona Fall League. In 8.2 IP against advanced competition, Lagrange posted a 2.08 ERA in his five appearances for the Salt River Rafters, earning him Fall League All-Star honors.

#### 2023

2022

Moving to the FCL Yankees in 2023, Lagrange made 12 appearances (11 starts) and posted a 4.97 ERA with 63 K and 24 BB in 41.2 IP with a .214 BAA and 1.39 WHIP. The first time he hit triple digits on the radar gun was during 2023 in the FCL.

Lagrange spent all of his professional debut season with the DSL Yankees, making 11 appearances (10 starts), going 0-1 with a 3.00 ERA, 43 K, 19 BB, .094 BAA and 0.88 WHIP.
