EARLY LEAD EVAPORATES IN 5-3 LOSS

Jacksonville scored three runs in the second, but could not tally another for the rest of the game in a 5-3 Wednesday loss at Nashville. A **Brian Miller** RBI single, **C.J. Hinojosa** RBI ground out and **Jake Mangum** RBI base hit made it 3-0 in the second in favor of the Jumbo Shrimp. However, the Sounds scored three times in the third to tie the game. **SaI Frelick's** RBI fielder's choice put Nashville in front in the sixth inning and **Alex Jackson's** RBI single made it 5-3 Sounds in the seventh. Mangum lashed three hits in the effort for Jacksonville, but the Jumbo Shrimp stranded nine runners in the defeat.

X MARKS THE SPOT

Xavier Edwards was optioned to Jacksonville on May 30 by Miami, but has been on a tear in his return to Triple-A. In the 35 games he's played since he's been optioned, the Coconut Creek, Fla., native is 57-for-147 at the plate, slashing .388/.431/.490/.921 with six doubles, three home runs, 22 RBIs and 31 runs scored. This hot streak has pushed Edwards up to the league leader in the International League in batting average (.360) and fifth in OBP (.431). Among the 276 players in the IL this season with at least 100 plate appearances, Edwards ranks second in swinging-strike rate (3.8 percent).

AUSTIN POWERS

Austin Allen entered play on April 28 just 2-for-his-first-47 (.043) on the season. In the 45 games, since, however, the St. Louis native is 46-for-157 (.293/.376/.688/1.064) at the plate with nine doubles, one triple, 17 home runs, 43 RBIs and 30 runs scored. After striking out in 25.1 percent of his plate appearances at the Triple-A level last season, Allen is fanning just 19.8 percent of the time in 2023.

NEED FOR SPEED

Xavier Edwards stole a pair of bases successfully on Wednesday, pushing his personal streak to 22 attempts in a row without getting caught. The Jumbo Shrimp as a whole have been one of the best teams in baseball in stealing bases; Jacksonville's 84.5 percent stolen base success rate is second in Triple-A to Norfolk and fifth out of the 120 full season MiLB teams. No Jumbo Shrimp has not been caught stealing since July 9.

FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

Following their 5-3 loss to Nashville on Wednesday, 13 of Jacksonville's last 20 games have been decided by three runs or fewer. Of the Jumbo Shrimp's 91 games played thus far in 2023, 50 have been decided by these slim margins. Jacksonville is 23-27 (.460) in these contests this season, but they excelled in them during an 80-69 2022 campaign, going 44-38 (.537). In 2021, when the club went 75-55, Jacksonville was 49-28 (.636) in games decided by three runs or fewer.

ODDS & ENDS

Jacksonville looked like world beaters in a six-game series at Charlotte from July 4-9. The Jumbo Shrimp took five out of six games from the Knights - their most wins in a series since 2022 - and outscored Charlotte by a whopping 58-28 margin. In the other 11 games of the second half of the season, Jacksonville is just 4-7, with all four of those victories coming by no more than two runs. In those seven defeats, the Jumbo Shrimp have lost by a combined 28 runs. Thus, while the club was +30 in their run differential in the Queen City, they are at -23 against their other second-half opponents (Durham, Worcester & Nashville).

MINIMUM EFFICIENCY

Over the entirety of their six-game series at Charlotte from July 4-9, the Jumbo Shrimp walked just 20 Knights. Jacksonville has followed that up with a whopping 41 walks over their last five games, including 11 on Saturday against Worcester, which matched a season-high. The Jumbo Shrimp have thrown 944 pitches during the 44 innings they've played since that series (21.5 per inning). In comparison, the WooSox and Sounds have tossed 750 in 45 innings over the five games, an average of 16.7 per inning. Jacksonville has stunningly walked at least seven batters in five consecutive games.

SHRIMP BITES

Following a four game winning streak to start their series in Charlotte from July 4-7, Jacksonville has lost five of their last seven games... The Jumbo Shrimp are 7-6 against the Sounds this season, but Nashville has outscored Jacksonville 66-54 in those games... Jeff Lindgren has given up three runs or fewer in four of his last six starts.

-A graduate of Illinois State University, Lindgren was mainly a reliever in college, starting in just 17 of his 83 appearances. He went 8-14 with a 6.02 ERA over his four seasons. However, entering 2023, he has already totaled 45 minor league starts in 63 career games.

-Jeff comes from an athletic family; His father, John, played football at Henderson State University in Arkadelphia, Arkansas.

-An alumnus of Illinois State University, Jeff followed in his sister Allyson's footsteps in attending school in Bloomington-Normal, Illinois. Allyson is a fellow graduate of Illinois State.

2022 SEASON

-Lingren played for the Pensacola Blue Wahoo's between stint with Jacksonville. In 2022 combine, Lingren posted a 7-4 record with 116 strikeouts in 136.2 IP.

2021 SEASON

-With the bases empty, opponents hit .234 (59-for-252) with a .740 OPS. However, with runners in scoring position, Lindgren buckled down for a .211 (16-for-76) opponents' average and .598 OPS.

-Lindgren got off to slower starts in 2021; in the first and second innings, opponents batted .290 (43-for-148). However, in the third and fourth innings, often his second time through the order, Lindgren held opposing hitters to a .183 (25-for-136).

-When Lindgren got hitters in a 1-2 hole, they were just 7-for-71 (.099) against him with 33 strikeouts.

Interestingly, when Lindgren was pitching from behind on the scoreboard, he performed better, holding opponents to a .176 (24-for-136) average. When his team led, opposing hitters collected a .241 (27-for-112) average.

2019 SEASON

-With High-A Jupiter, lefties hit .297 with a .680 OPS against Lindgren. However, he held right-handed hitters to a .176 average with a .432 OPS.

-With the bases empty, opponents hit .275 (11-for-40) against Lindgren with a .626 OPS. With runners in scoring position, Lindgren limited opposing batters to .194 (6-for-31) with a .508 OPS. Total, with runners on, Lindgren posted a .188 (9-for-48) batting average against with an OPS of .471.

ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES

-At Centennial High School (Champaign, Ill.), Lindgren competed in both baseball and basketball. He served as the baseball team captain, helped win two regional championships and one sectional championship.
