THIS DATE IN HISTORY

On June 3, 2021, Nashville's Jace Peterson hit two home runs as the Sounds routed Charlotte 15-4 at Truist Field. The win was Nashville's 15th-straight, putting them at a stellar 21-5 to start the season. The winning streak came to an end the next night.

Tonight's Game: The Nashville Sounds take on the Durham Bulls in game four of a six-game series at Durham Bulls Athletic Park tonight. The Bulls outslug the Sounds for a 9-7 win on Thursday. Right-hander Caleb Boushley hopes to replicate his win last Saturday at Toledo, going against right-hander Tommy Romero.

Caleb Boushley: 28-year-old Caleb Boushley makes his 11th start for the Sounds tonight. The right-hander is 5-2 with a 3.66 ERA (51.2 IP/21 ER) in 10 starts. Entering the day, Boushley is tied for third in wins among International League pitchers. He also ranks among league leaders in innings pitched (T-4th), WHIP (5th, 1.14), opponent batting average (8th, .228) and ERA (10th). The Hortonville, Wis. native tossed 7.0 scoreless innings for a win at Toledo on May 28. He allowed just three hits and one walk while striking out four on 94 pitches (56 strikes). Boushley was selected by Milwaukee in the Triple-A Phase of the 2021 Rule 5 Draft from San Diego. In 2021, the Madison, Wis. resident went 5-11 with a 5.21 ERA in 24 games (23 starts) with Triple-A El Paso (16) and Double-A San Antonio (8) in the Padres organization. Boushley was drafted by San Diego in the 33rd Round of the 2017 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of Wisconsin-La Crosse.

Tommy Romero: 24-year-old Tommy Romero starts for the Bulls in game four of the series. The right-hander is 2-3 with a 5.12 ERA (31.2 IP/18 ER) in 8 games (7 starts) with Durham. He's also pitched in two games (one start) for Tampa Bay in 2022 (0-0, 9.82 ERA, 3.2 IP, 4 ER). Romero got roughed up in his last start on May 28 vs. Charlotte, allowing seven runs (all earned) on eight hits and one walk in 2.0 innings. He struck three in the loss, tossing 59 pitches (36 strikes) and allowing three homers. The Fort Lauderdale, Fla. native comes in at No. 18 on the Rays prospect list, according to MLB Pipeline. He combined to go 8-2 with a 2.61 ERA in 23 games (21 starts) between Durham (12) and Double-A Montgomery (11) last season. Romero was drafted by the Mariners in the 15th Round of the 2017 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of Eastern Florida State College.

The Nashville List: Monday's win for Rick Sweet was his 180th as manager of the Nashville Sounds. It's the sixth-most managerial wins in franchise history. Pete Mackanin is fifth on the list with 186 wins.

Rehab Watch: In his first appearance with the Sounds, Brewers shortstop Willy Adames went 1-for-3 with a single last night. The former Tampa Bay infielder was placed on the injured list on May 16 with a high left ankle sprain.

Power Surge: Last night, the Sounds hit three home runs, with Mark Mathias hitting a two-run blast in the first, Garrett Whitley hitting a solo shot in the fifth and Tyler White crushing a ball in the seventh. It's the sixth time they have hit at least three home runs in a game this season.

He Gets On Base: Jonathan Davis reached base safely in his 16th-straight game on Thursday, going 1-for-5 with a stolen base. During the 16-game streak, Davis is hitting .292 (19-for-65) with 11 runs, 4 doubles, 2 home runs, 8 RBI, 12 walks and 5 stolen bases. It's the 6th-longest active streak in the International League. His .426 OBP on the season is the best in the International League.

Not Homer Happy: Yesterday was the first time the Sounds have given up six home runs in a game since July 21, 2010 vs. Albuquerque (lost 14-5). It is also just the fourth time since 2005.

Earn It: Nashville's team ERA sits at 3.55 (438.2 IP/173 ER), despite giving up nine earned runs yesterday. The 3.55 ERA is the best mark across Triple-A Baseball, ahead of Iowa's 3.88 as second-best. Nashville's seven shutouts also leads Triple-A Baseball.

The Future Brew Crew: Nashville has four players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects. Infielder Brice Turang is the No. 4 prospect, catcher Mario Feliciano is the No. 20 prospect, right-handed pitcher Alec Bettinger is the No. 22 prospect and right-handed pitcher Dylan File is the No. 24 prospect.

AGAINST OPPONENT: Boushley last (and only) appearance against Durham came on April 6 at First Horizon Park. He took the loss, allowing four runs on five hits and two walks in 4.1 innings. He struck out four Bulls in his first start of the season.
