Tonight: The Lugnuts play the fourth game in a six-game series against the TinCaps, the fourth of 18 meetings between the two clubs this season. 24-year-old right-hander Reid Birlingmair makes his third start of the season, taking on Fort Wayne right-hander Anderson Espinoza, returning to the mound this year for the first time since 2016. The TinCaps defeated the Lugnuts in each of the first two games of the series, outscoring the Nuts 19-4 in total, before the Lugnuts came back to win in a romp yesterday.

Last Night: Lugnuts 12, TinCaps 1. 20-year-old Jordan Díaz homered for the third straight day, Michael Guldberg homered and made a leaping catch at the wall, and four Lugnuts pitchers struck out 18 'Caps hitters in an overwhelming triumph at Parkview Field. Richard Guasch struck out seven TinCaps hitters in five scoreless innings, Seth Shuman fanned five in two innings, Jack Weisenburger whiffed all five batsmen he faced, and Michael Danielak rang up Luis Almanzar to end the game, leaving the Lugnuts pitching corps one strikeout shy of the team record for K's in a game, set on April 29th, 2001, vs. South Bend.

Last Transaction: The Nuts have made only one roster move this year, placing starting pitcher Jeff Criswell on the Injured List and adding relief pitcher Brandon Withers from Extended Spring Training on May 12th. Withers, the 835th player in Lugnuts team history.

What's New in 2021: Entering this season, the Lugnuts' stadium name changed from Cooley Law School Stadium to Jackson® Field™, the Nuts moved up to the High-A Central, and they accepted an invitation to affiliate with the Oakland Athletics, the Nuts' fourth MLB partner, following the Kansas City Royals (1996-98), Chicago Cubs (1999-2004) and Blue Jays (2005-2020). The Athletics had previously partnered with Lugnuts rivals Burlington (1963-1974, 2011-2012), West Michigan (1994-1996), Kane County (1993-2010) and Beloit (2013-2020).

Meet the Boss: Scott Steinmann is the 16th manager in Lugnuts team history. Born in Dayton, Steinmann joins the Lugnuts after three straight seasons assigned to manage Double-A Midland (though the 2020 season was canceled). Steinmann previously managed against the Lugnuts with Wisconsin (2005), Clinton (2009, 2014-15) and Beloit (2017).

Pitching Success, but...: The Lugnuts' pitching staff leads the High-A Central with a 2.68 earned run average despite allowing the second-most hits in the league (114) thanks to issuing only 44 walks, fewest in the league. Yesterday marked the sixth time already this year that Lugnuts pitchers have held the opposition to two runs scored or fewer. The Nuts additionally lead the league in GO/AO ratio (1.59).

Offensive Outburst: The Nuts had scored exactly 12 runs total in their last six games before erupting for 12 runs last night. Lansing leads the High-A Central in at-bats (501) and has the fourth-most hits (113), the fourth-highest slugging percentage (.375), the second-most total bases (186) and the most doubles (36).

Individual Excellence: Infielder Jordan Díaz, who has homered in all three games of this series, now is tied for fourth in the High-A Central with four roundtrippers, tied for fourth in extra-base hits with seven (tied, by the way, with teammates Michael Guldberg and Jake Suddleson), and third in the circuit with 14 RBIs. Shortstop Max Schuemann scored four runs yesterday and stole three bases, giving 12 runs scored this year (tied for second) and 10 steals (second-most).

A Slew of Starters: The Lugnuts have used eight starting pitchers this season, with a ninth on the horizon, namely: Seth Shuman (May 4, May 15); Brady Basso (May 5, May 12); Richard Guasch (May 6, May 20th); Reid Birlingmair (May 7, May 14); Jeff Criswell (May 8); Stevie Emanuels (May 9, May 16); Rafael Kelly (May 11, May 18); and Shohel Tomioka (May 13); with Colin Peluse scheduled to start for the first time on Saturday.

Major League Lugnuts. Part I: Two former Nuts have made their Major League debuts this season, pitcher Tv Tice '18 and outfielder Josh Palacios '16-'17. with the duo making their first MLB appearance in the same game for the Toronto Blue Jays on April 9th. It was the seventh time in team history that two Lugnuts made their MLB debut in the same game, with the first occurring on September 14, 1998: Carlos Febles and Carlos Beltrán for the Kansás City Royals.

Major League Lugnuts, Part II: Who has been the best Lugnut in the Majors this year? Let's make two cases: Pitcher Kendall Graveman '13-'14, who went from Lansing to the Majors in one season in 2014, has turned into a relief ace for the Seattle Mariners: 16 2/3 scoreless innings, allowing six hits in 54 at-bats (.111) with only three walks and 17 strikeouts (0.54 WHIP). First baseman Vladimir Guerrero, Jr. '17 leads Major League Baseball with 2.6 WAR (according to Fangraphs) and is second to Mike Trout in wRC+ (188 to Trout's 198).

Today in Lugnuts History

2014: With all eyes on him and a Thursday night crowd of 9,823 in attendance, rehabbing Mark Prior made his first appearance since the 2003 National League Championship Series, beginning his road back to the Majors. Prior faced the minimum in three innings, striking out five and issuing one walk — to Drew Macias, who was then caught stealing by catcher Jake Fox to end the second inning. The Lugnuts defeated the Fort Wayne Wizards, 2-1, on two runs in the bottom of the ninth. Brian Dopirak tied the game with a two-out RBI double. Three batters later, Fox drew a walk-off walk to bring in Dopirak. Future Major Leaguer Carlos Marmol picked up the win, allowing one run in six innings and striking out eight.

Familiar Settings: 14 of the 30 Lugnuts players came through the Midwest League in Beloit on their way up the Athletics' ladder, and coaching staff members Scott Steinmann, Don Schulze and Anthony Phillips all have experience in the league.

A Pleasant Peninsula Surrounds You: Max Schuemann (Portage Northern H.S.) is the first Lugnut from Eastern Michigan University, and Jeff Criswell (Portage Central H.S.) and Jack Weisenburger (Rockford H.S.) are the fourth and fifth Michigan Wolverines to play in Lansing (following Troy Miller, Jake Fox and Rich Hill).

Finally: Pitchers Jeff Criswell, Stevie Emanuels and Shohei Tomioka, catchers Jared McDonald, Drew Millas and William Simoneit, first baseman Patrick McColl, and outfielders Michael Guldberg and Jake Suddleson are all making their pro debut this season

Front Office Connections: Lugnuts pitching coach Don Schulze was drafted 11th overall by the Chicago Cubs in 1980, 12 picks before Oakland Executive Vice President of Baseball Operations Billy Beane was drafted by the New York Mets. Lugnuts first baseman Patrick McColl set a new Harvard baseball single season record with 70 hits in 2019, breaking the previous record held by Athletics General Manager David Forst.

Clubhouse of Higher Learning: The Ivy League is well represented on the Lansing roster. Outfielder Jake Suddleson and first baseman Patrick McColl played for Harvard, reliever Michael Danielak was drafted from Dartmouth and catcher William Simoneit spent four years at Cornell before grad-transferring to Wake Forest.

Power Five Baseball: The Lugnuts also represent the ACC (Michael Guldberg, Georgia Tech); Big 12 (Brady Basso, Oklahoma State); Big Ten (Jeff Criswell and Jack Weisenburger, Michigan; Dalton Sawyer, Minnesota); and the SEC (Cobie Vance, Alabama, and Ryan Gridley, Mississippi State); and the Pac-12 (Stevie Emanuels, Washington).

International Appeal: In addition to 15 different states represented by Lugnuts players and coaching staff, seven nations are represented: USA, Colombia, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Japan, South Africa and Venezuela.

Teammates Then, Teammates Now: Several of the Nuts are familiar with one another. **Jake Suddleson** and **Patrick McColl** played together at Harvard, **Reid Birlingmair** and **Charlie Cerny** pitched together at the University of Illinois at Chicago, and **Jeff Criswell** and **Jack Weisenburger** pitched together in Ann Arbor. The Lugnuts also have a pair of Wake Forest Demon Deacons, but **William Simoneit** played only one year at Wake, 2020, thus missing **Colin Peluse** by a year. Simoneit has caught Peluse twice this season, forming a full Demon Deacon battery.



Pronunciation: Reid's last name is pronounced "BIR-ling-MY-er."

Last Outing: Started Friday, May 14th at Dayton... charged with one run in four-plus innings, walking four and striking out three... allowed leadoff single to Brian Rey in 1st inning but coaxed double play from Quincy McAfee in facing the minimum in a scoreless frame... pitched around a two-out walk to Michael Siani in a scoreless 2nd... with one out in the 3rd, walked Jacob Hurtubise and gave up a single to Rey; catcher Drew Millas caught Hurtubise stealing third base; Quincy McAfee walked, but got Jose Tello on a pop-out to escape... worked around a leadoff walk to Eric Yang and a Micael Siani single in a scoreless 4th... departed after allowing leadoff single to Miguel Hernandez in the 5th inning... Hernandez scored against reliever Charles Hall on a sacrifice bunt by Hurtubise and a sacrifice fly by Rey... used 75 pitches, 44 for strikes... Lugnuts went on to lose, 3-1.

2021 with Lansing: Started the fourth game of the season, May 7th vs. Lake County, tossing five innings and allowing three runs on six hits and a walk, including a solo home run to Austen Wade... picked off Joe Naranjo from first base in the 4th inning... departed with Nuts trailing 3-0... Lugnuts lost, 6-2.

Professional Career: Made his professional debut in the AZL in 2018 (1.45 ERA, 18 2/3 IP, 5 R, 6 BB, 25 K) before moving up to Vermont on August 8 (2.25 ERA, 5 G, 3 GS, 16.0 IP, 10 BB, 8 K)... spent full 2019 in Beloit (4.02 ERA, 123 IP, 108 H, 50 BB, 120 K), pitching at least six innings in nine games, topping out at 7-IP, 1-R, 8-K on July 24th... faced the Lugnuts once (3 IP, 0 R) on May 4th... had overall numbers skewed by one bad month: 1.46 ERA in 24.2 IP in May, 10.72 ERA in 22.2 IP in June, 2.78 in 35.2 IP in July, 2.36 in 34.1 IP in August.

Teaching on the Side: Reid is an instructor at the K's Training Academy in the offseason, located in Normal, as is college/Lugnuts teammate Charlie Cerny (pronounced "Cher-nee").

Draft Day: Selected 833rd overall in the 28th round from the University of Illinois at Chicago (the "Flames") in 2018, signed for \$50,000 (one round in front of Lugnuts teammate Drew Millas)... signed by Derek Lee... drafted 21 rounds after Cerny... the 2018 draft was fruitful for the Lugnuts roster, also producing Bryce Nightengale (16th round), Cobie Vance (18th round), Max Schuemann (20th round), Aiden McIntyre (22nd round).



Life as a Flame: Reid struggled as a freshman (8.81 ERA, 17 G, 3 GS, 31 2/3 IP, 33 R, 24 BB, 27 K, 11 HBP) but bounced back to have a strong sophomore season (3.10, 15 GS, 1 ShO, 93.0 IP, 34 R, 25 BB, 81 K, 5 HBP) and an even better junior season (2.12, 10 G, 8 GS, 51.0 IP, 12 R, 21 BB, 57 K, 5 HBP), though he missed time from March 23-April 24 with an injury.

Baseball Over Nursing: In an interview with White Cleat Beat, Reid shared that nursing had been his first pursuit, starting with volunteering at OSF St. Joseph Medical Center, Carle BroMenn Medical Center, and Camp Quality (serving children with cancer and their families). He applied to the nursing school at UIC as a sophomore before turning his attention fully toward baseball, majoring in liberal arts with a minor in psychology.

Major League Standouts: Only three UIC Flames have ever made the Majors, but each one is notable: Pete Mackanin (1973-1981), who managed the Pirates in 2005, the Reds in 2007 and the Phillies in 2015-2017; Ken Holtzman (1965-1979), who threw no-hitters for the Chicago Cubs in 1969 (despite not striking out a batter) and 1971 and was an American League All-Star with the Oakland Athletics' World Series champions in 1972 and 1973; and three-time All-Star Curtis Granderson (2004-2019), who was taken by the Detroit Tigers in the third round in 2002 and collected exactly 1800 hits in his 16-year MLB career.

High School Success, On and Off the Field...: Pitched and played shortstop at Normal West High School, where he was named 3x 1st Team All-Big 12 and the Big 12 Conference Pitcher of the year as a Senior... in the 2015 Illinois Coaches Association (ICA) All-Star Game, he played second base... he was also a member of the National Honor Society and Spanish Honor Society.

A Normal Background Check: Birlingmair's hometown, Normal, was originally named North Bloomington in 1854. The name changed in 1865 to reflect its place as the home of Illinois State Normal University, a teaching school, now called simply Illinois State University. (Teaching schools were known as "normal schools" because their purpose was to instruct the students, future teachers, in properly understanding and instilling the societal norms at the time. Many state schools began as normal schools, like UCLA, which was originally named the Los Angeles California State Normal School.) Normal is the home of the Normal Cornbelters, a member of the Frontier League from 2010-2018 and now a member of the Prospect League, playing their home games at The Corn Crib.
