NOTES AND NUGGETS

2ND HALF SLUGGERS

While Omaha has had a slow start to the 2nd half, a couple of hitters have had a hot start offensively to the back half of the season.

Carter Jensen joined Omaha for the 2nd half and despite a slow start, he leads the club with 8 homers and 22 RBI since arriving and ranks 2nd with 52 total bases, with 13 of 23 hits going for extra-bases (5 doubles + 8 homers) ... his 15 walks lead the team, while batting .250 (23-for-92) with the Storm Chasers.

Dairon Blanco is hitting .259 (22-for-85) since June 24 ... 12 of his 22 hits have gone for extra-bases, with 7 doubles, 1 triple and 4 home runs ... his 43 total bases are 3rd on the team this half.

THAT'S WHAT SPEED DO

The Storm Chasers are not near the league lead in stolen bases, but Omaha has one of the highest success rates on the basepaths in the Minors.

Omaha has successfully stolen 131 bases this year, and only been caught 24 times ... 131 steals rank 6th in the International League and 10th in Triple-A.

131-for-155 in steal attempts is a 84.5% success rate, the 2nd-best stolen base rate at the Triple-A level and 6th-best among the 120 full-season Minor League teams (1st: New Hampshire Fisher Cats, 86.8%, 99-for-114).

A MATTER OF TRUST

Since July 8, Omaha has been the best defensive team both in the International League and at the Triple-A level.

Across the last 21 games (since July 8), the Storm Chasers have committed just 7 errors in 747 chance, for a Triple-A best .991 fielding percentage ... that ranks as the highest of any team in Triple-A since July 8.

On the season, Omaha has a .981 fielding percentage, tied 8th-best at the Triple-A level overall this year ... in the second half (since June 24), the Chasers' fielding percentage is .986 (16 E in 1181 TC), the 2nd-best at the Triple-A level.

Outfielder MJ Melendez has not been charged with an error in 488.0 innings in LF, the most errorless innings of any Storm Chaser at a single position in 2025.

VICTORY FIELD SCREECH

Omaha has won a pair of games this year at Victory Field, a stadium where Omaha has played exceptionally ... since 2021, Omaha has won 21 of 33 games in Indy.

Going back to 2023, the Storm Chasers have won 16 of their last 21 games at Victory Field, the most wins Omaha has at any opposing venue in the last 3 years.

In 2023, Omaha won all 8 games it played in Indy, sweeping a 3-game series March 31 to April 2, then winning all 5 from June 6 to 10... in 2024, the Chasers lost to the Indians on May 27, before winning 6 straight between May 29 and June 2. Since 2021, Omaha's 4.25 ERA (130 ER in 275.1 IP) is the club's best among the

7 ballparks where the Chasers have played 20+ games over the last 5 seasons.

Dairon Blanco's 26 hits are the most of any visiting player at Victory Field since 2023 ... he is 26-for-53 on the road against the Indians, a, .491 average ... **Tyler Gentry**'s 15 RBI as a victory at Victory Field rank as the 3rd-most.

NEVER GONNA GIVE YOU UP

Dallas Keuchel made his Storm Chasers debut July 12, becoming the latest player with significant Major League service time to appear in a game for Omaha in 2025.

With 10 years and 30 days of MLB service, Keuchel is the 2nd most-experienced MLB pitcher to play for Omaha this year, trailing only **Rich Hill** (14 years, 141 days MLB service), who made 9 Omaha starts ... Keuchel is the 11th player to appear in a game for the Chasers this year with 4 or more years of MLB service (through 2024).

Joey Krehbiel's Omaha debut two weeks ago makes him the 15th player to appear in a game for Omaha this year at the age of 30 or older ... by comparison, Omaha had 9 players in their 30's appear in a game both last year and in 2023. Today is Keuchel's 5th start for Omaha ... between Keuchel, Hill, John Gant, Thomas Hatch and Stephen Nogosek, 44 of Omaha's 107 games this season (41%) have been started by a pitcher age 30 or older.

WHAT A RELIEF

While Omaha's starting pitching has struggled at times in 2025, the bullpen has stepped up to help win games for the Storm Chasers.

Omaha's relievers have combined for a 4.78 ERA (256 ER in 481.2 IP), while the starting pitchers have pitched to a 6.07 ERA (299 ER in 443.1 IP) ... the starters rank 19th of the 20 teams in the IL in ERA, while the bullpen ranks 12th ... the relievers are tied 5th in the league in K/9 (10.04) and K/BB (2.28).

The bullpen has combined for 22 scoreless efforts, most recently 3.0 innings in Sunday's loss to Louisville ... the relievers had back-to-back scoreless games last Tuesday and Wednesday, for 8.0 consecutive scoreless innings against the Bats, the only 2 scoreless games from the bullpen in July.



- Keuchel is making his 5th start with Omaha this season ... he signed a Minor League contract with Kansas City on July 9, 2025 and was assigned to Omaha on July 12.
- Playing his 17th professional season this year ... Royals are Keuchel's 9th MLB organization, has previously spent time with the Astros, Braves, White Sox, Diamondbacks, Rangers, Twins, Mariners and Brewers, as well as time in Japan ... he has pitched in the big leagues for HOU, ATL, CWS, AZ, TEX, MIN and MIL.
- Omaha is the 5th Triple-A club Keuchel has pitched for, following Oklahoma City, Round Rock, St. Paul and Tacoma ... he has pitched against Omaha 3 times twice in 2012 with Oklahoma City and in 2023 with St. Paul.
- Keuchel has appeared in 282 MLB games (267 starts) across the last 13 seasons ... since making his MLB Debut with the Astros in June 2012, he has made at least 2 starts every season (not including this year).







Scorigami: A portmanteau of score and origami, a scorigami is a scoring combination that has never happened before in a team, sport or league's history. The term was originated by SB Nation writer Jon Bois for NFL scores.

Above is a matrix of every final score that has happened in a Triple-A Omaha game <u>since 2000</u>. Green squares represent Omaha wins, while red squares represent Omaha losses. The number inside the square refers to the number of times that result has occurred. Empty squares represent a scoring combination or result that has not happened.

Since 2000, there are **58** results in Triple-A Omaha games that have only happened once. **34** of those results (wins or losses) are a true scorigami, a scoring combination that has only happened once. Recent scorigami occurrences are listed to the right, with true scorigamis in bold.
