PLAYOFF BOUND

The Omaha Storm Chasers won the International League 1st Half title with a 49-24 record and 3.5-game lead on second-place Syracuse to end the half, the best Minor League team in the 1st half of the 2024 season.

- Winning the first half in the league secures the Storm Chasers home field advantage in the International League Championship Series, a best-of-three series that will be played at Werner Park from September 24 to 26.
- This September will mark Omaha's first appearance in the playoffs since 2014, when the Chasers won their 2nd of back-to-back Triple-A National Championships.
- The Triple-A Omaha franchise has 17 playoff appearances in the last 55 years, including most recently four straight seasons: 2011 to 2014.

NOTES AND NUGGETS

IN GOOD STANDINGS

While the standings reset for the start of the 2nd half on June 25, Omaha's enters today's game 26 games over .500 with a 58-32 record (.644 winning percentage).

- 58 wins are tied for the most of any team in Minor League Baseball this season, tied with the Sugar Land Space Cowboys, Houston's Triple-A affiliate.
- Of 120 full season Minor League teams, Omaha's .644 winning percentage overall this year is tied for the 2nd-best in the Minors, trailing the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers (.653 / .647), Milwaukee's High-A team.
- The Chasers have still been 1st or 2nd in the Minors in wins every day since May 25 ... Omaha previously held sole possession of the best winning percentage in full-season Minor League Baseball for 30 days, June 5 to July 5.

TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

57 of Omaha's 90 games this year have been decided by 3 runs or less, including 22 of 32 losses in 2024, with 12 of 32 losses by just one run (39%).

- Close games have been a struggle for Omaha in recent weeks, with the bullpen converting just 7 of its last 15 save opportunities, since June 5 (47%).
- Omaha is 18-12 in 1-run games this season, which ranks as the 3rd-most 1-run wins of any Minor League team.
- As a team, Omaha's 27 saves are tied for the 5th-most of any Minor League team and 2nd-most in Triple-A ... **Will Klein's** 9 saves individually rank 4th in the International League, this season, while seven different Storm Chasers pitchers have 2 or more saves in 2024.

I'M DIFFERENT, YEAH, I'M (RUN) DIFFERENT(IAL)

Omaha has outscored its opponents 521 to 416 this season, a +105 run differential.

- A +105 run differential this year ranks as the best mark both in the International League and at the Triple-A level.
- Omaha ranks 6th in Minor League Baseball in run differential ... the Greensboro Grasshoppers lead the Minors at +161 (537 to 161).

DAZZLING DEFENSE

Omaha's defense has had its ups and downs this season, but the team is on one of its best stretches in the field this season.

- Over Omaha's last 30 games (since June 9), a .989 fielding percentage (11 errors in 1,034 total chances) is the 2nd- best in Minor League Baseball over that span.
- Overall this year, a .981 fielding percentage is tied 7th in the league, tied 10th in Triple-A and tied 13th of the 120 full-season Minor League teams.
- The Storm Chasers have not made an error in 12 of the team's last 17 games, with a streak of 6 errorless games snapped last Friday ... early in the season, Omaha went 7 straight games without making an error, March 31 to April 7.

COMEBACK KIDS

Omaha has 32 come-from-behind wins this season, meaning over half (55%) of this year's wins have been games where the Chasers trailed at some point.

- The Storm Chasers have come back from down as many as 5 runs to win and have overcome a 3+ run deficit to win on 10 occasions.
- Omaha has trailed for three innings or more in 11 of the 32 comeback wins, with five victories where the club had to overcome multiple deficits ... the team has 8 wins in games where they trailed after the 6th inning.

RELIEF AID

Omaha's bullpen has been one of the best across the entire Triple-A level in 2024.

- The Storm Chasers relievers are second among all Triple-A bullpens with a 3.86 ERA, 1.36 WHIP and an opposing slash line of .213/.326/.357 ... the .213 opponents' average is the 8th-best in the Minors ...
- Omaha's bullpen has combined to not allow a run in 21 games this year, roughly one in every 4.29 games ... a stretch of 16 consecutive games without a scoreless bullpen effort ended with Thursday's 4-0 win over Toledo.
- Evan Sisk** has been one of Omaha's most reliable relief pitchers over the last month... Sisk has not allowed an earned run since June 9, a stretch of 13 games and 10.2 innings ... in that span, he's allowed just 4 hits with 12 strikeouts.

TODAY'S START

- Lynch IV is making his **15th Omaha start**, **18th overall start** and **20th overall appearance** this season ... Lynch is on his 4th stint in Triple-A with Omaha, previously with the Storm Chasers March 29 to May 4, May 10 to May 29 and May 31 to June 1.
- Has 6 quality starts in his last 7 starts with the Storm Chasers ... at the Triple-A level since May 19, Lynch IV has a 2.64 ERA (13 ER in 44.1 IP) with 36 strikeouts to just 9 walks, for a 1.04 WHIP and .230 opponents' average.
- Added the 'IV' to his surname before his July 18, 2023 start vs. Detroit to honor his father, Daniel Lynch III, and grandfather, Daniel Lynch II.

LAST OUTING: TUESDAY, JULY 9 VS. TOLEDO

Made his team-leading 6th quality start of the year ... opened the game with 6.0 scoreless innings ... worked a 1-2-3 inning in the 3rd and 6th innings ... retired 19 of his first 22 batters, one out into the 7th inning, with a leadoff single in the 1st caught stealing, stranded single runners on in the 2nd and 4th, walked two in the 5th but stranded both on ... allowed a 1-out homer in the 7th to Bligh Madris, removed.

2024 HIGHLIGHTS

- Daniel was optioned to Triple-A Omaha on March 20 and started Opening Day for the Storm Chasers, March 29 @ Iowa, his first of 5 Omaha starts that have been 5.0 innings.
- In his second stint with Omaha, Daniel threw back-to-back quality starts for the Chasers, May 19 @ St. Paul and May 25 vs. Columbus ... combined to allow 2 earned runs on 10 hits with 1 walk over 13.2 innings.
