## INDY BITS

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Ji Hwan Bae launched a leadoff home run, Matt Gorski hit a tape-measure shot 478 feet and Henry Davis homered twice to carry the Indianapolis Indians to a triumphant 16-10 win over the Toledo Mud Hens on Saturday night at Victory Field. Bae started the slugfest with a bang, homering to straightaway center field on the third pitch he saw against Ty Madden. The Indians extended their lead to 4-0 thanks to a two-run single by Bae and basesloaded walk by Jake Lamb in the ensuing frame. The Mud Hens got on the board in the third inning on a run-scoring single by Jace Jung. The visitors pulled with one in the fourth on an Anthony Bemboom RBI single and Parker Meadows three-bagger, but Indianapolis maintained its lead with single runs in the bottom of the fourth and fifth to carry a 6-4 advantage into the final four innings, which featured a combined 16 runs and four home runs between both clubs. Davis cleared the left-field wall with his first home run of the game, Gorski brought home two runs on a triple and Canaan Smith-Njigba notched an RBI single to make it 10-4, and Gorski and Davis each smacked three-run shots in Indy's final at-bat.

ABOUT THE HOME RUNS, PART II: Last night marked the first since since May 11, 2021, vs. Toledo, that the Indians hit four home runs at Victory Field and the sixth time that they've recorded four-plus homers at home (also: $6 / 28 / 17$ vs. Durham, $5 / 28 / 13$ vs. Pawtucket, three instances in 2012) since launching a Victory Field era five on June 27, 2010, vs. the Mud Hens.

THE LONGEST BALL IN THE IL: Two days after hitting the longest home run by an Indians batter this season, Matt Gorski topped himself with the longest homer by an Indian since Statcast data began being tracked in 2022 and the longest homer in the International League this season with a 478-foot shot. His home run bested Buffalo's Orelvis Martinez' 469-foot shot, the league's previous longest. Gorski also finished a single shy of the cycle, going 3-for-4 with a fifth-inning double, two-run triple in the sixth and his eighth-inning blast. His career-high five RBI marked the second five-RBI performance by an Indians batter this season (also: Ji Hwan Bae, 5/9 @ LOU).

HANK FOR TWO: Henry Davis wasted no time adjusting to a position player pitching for Toledo last night, launching a solo home run in the sixth inning and a three-run shot in the seventh inning for his fourth career multi-homer performance (first since $7 / 21 / 23$ with PIT at LAA). He went 2 -for-4 with a career-high tying four RBI. He has now homered three times in his past four games, including a solo home run to begin the series in Game 1 on Thursday. His first home run of the series was his first of the season with either Indy or Pittsburgh.

LEADING OFF: Ji Hwan Bae launched his second leadoff homer of the season to spark a 4-for-6, three-RBI performance last night vs. Toledo. The leadoff shot sailed 441 feet and was the fourth of his Indians career, moving him into a tie with Max Moroff for the most leadoff home runs by an Indian in the Victory Field era.

ALVAREZ FOR THREE: Andrés Alvarez joined the multi-hit parade last night, going 3-for-4 with three runs to set new season-highs in both categories between Indy and Single-A Bradenton. The infielder has now hit safely in three consecutive games this series, going 5-for-9 with an RBI. In 14 total games between levels, he owns a .261 batting average (12-for-46) with eight runs, three doubles, one homer and five RBI.

MALCOM ON BASE: Malcom Nuñez extended his on-base streak to 16 games yesterday after going 2 -for- 5 with two runs - marking his fourth multi-hit performance in his past eight games. In those 15 games since April 24 at Omaha, he owns a 267 batting average ( 16 -for- 60 ) with six runs, two extra-base hits, seven RBI and six walks. His on-base streak is the third longest by an Indians batter this season and trails only Jake Lamb (20) as the second-longest active streak.

JAKE ON BASE: Jake Lamb extended his current on-base streak to 20 games since April 18 with a walk last night vs. Toledo. During that streak - which is the second-longest by an Indian this season (trailing Nick Gonzales, 21 games) and the longest active team streak - he is hitting . 343 (24-for-70) with 12 runs, eight doubles, one home run, 16 RBI, .425 on-base percentage and .925 OPS. He has now reached base safely in 31 of 32 games this season.

TODAY: With the series knotted at two games apiece, the Indians and Mud Hens will close out their six-game series with a Sunday afternoon doubleheader today beginning at 12:35 PM ET. Toledo took five of six games in their first meeting at Fifth Third Field from April 9-14, after the Indians won the season series a year ago, 14-4. Taking the mound for Indianapolis in Game 1 today is RHP Domingo Germán ( $0-0,----$ ), who was signed by the Pirates as a minor league free agent in March. Countering for the Mud Hens is major league rehabber RHP Kenta Maeda ( $0-0,-.--$ ).

DOMINGO: Domingo Germán is set to make his second start in the Pirates organization in today's opener vs. Toledo. He made his org debut with Single-A Bradenton, tossing 4.0 one-run innings with four strikeouts on $5 / 14$ at Tampa. He made 20 appearances ( 19 starts) with New York (AL) last season and went $5-7$ with a 4.56 ERA ( 55 er/ 108.2 ip) and 114 strikeouts. Today will mark his Victory Field debut, never having pitched in Indianapolis across 20 games (17 starts) in Triple-A with Scranton/Wilkes-Barre.

THIS DATE IN 1998: The Indians put up nine runs in the eighth inning at Pawtucket en route to an 18-6 win. Center fielder Pat Watkins led off for Indianapolis and went 4 -for-5 with a double, home run, three RBI and four runs scored. Shortstop Aaron Boone also had a game-high five RBI after going 3-for-6 with two home runs. The Indians pounded out 19 total hits with five going as homers, and five players recorded three-plus knocks,
