### LAST GAME

The Baysox took down the Richmond Flying Squirrels 3-2 on Friday night, thanks in part to a walk-off home run from Coby Mayo in the bottom of the ninth inning. Mayo's solo shot came with one-out in the ninth and completed the comeback effort for Bowie, who trailed 2-0 in the first inning after a two-run home run for Andy Thomas off Baysox right-hander Garrett Stallings. That would be the only hit and runs allowed by Stallings through five innings, as he walked five, but struck out six. Bowie's comeback charge was led by Donta' Williams, who drove in a pair of runs via a sacrifice fly in the second inning and a solo home run to lead off the fifth frame. Right-hander Peter Van Loon took the back four innings for Bowie, striking out a season-high seven with just one hit and one walk allowed. Van Loon kept Richmond off the board, leading to Mayo delivering Bowie's third walk-off win of the season.

### TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Richmond Flying Squirrels enter today with a record of 27-34 - fifth place in the Southwest division and just a half-game ahead of the Baysox. Since entering their series in Bowie against the Baysox in late April atop the division standings, the Flying Squirrels are 14-27, having lost three of their series, while splitting the other three, and dropping five games out of first place in the process. Richmond has the third-fewest errors (42) in the Eastern League and the fewest home runs hit away from home (21) of any team in Double-A, but are going against a Baysox team with the third-most errors (57) and home runs allowed at home (58) in the league. The Flying Squirrels roster includes 10 of the Giants' top 30 prospects (via MLB Pipeline) - INF Marco Luciano (No. 2 SF/No. 18 overall), OF Vaun Brown (No. 5 SF), LHP Carson Whisenhunt (No. 8 SF), RHP Mason Black (No. 10 SF), RHP Landen Roupp (No. 13 SF), RHP Carson Seymour (No. 17 SF), RHP Randy Rodriguez (No. 25 SF), RHP Ryan Murphy (No. 26 SF), RHP Jose Cruz (No. 29 SF), and OF Wade Meckler (No. 30 SF).

### TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Richmond looks to start right-hander Landen Roupp tonight. The No. 13 prospect in the Giants' system, per MLB Pipeline, Roupp has only gone 19.2 innings across his seven starts and has not pitched into the fifth inning yet this season, but has allowed just four runs in that stretch, walking seven and striking out 29. Roupp last pitched this past Sunday against Altoona, where he went four frames, allowing a run on four hits, matching a season-high with seven strikeouts. A 12th round pick of the Giants in 2021 out of UNC Wilmington, Roupp features a low-mid90s fastball, an upper-70s curveball, a tight low-80s slider, and a firm mid-80s changeup.

### DOUBLE THE MAYO!

INF Coby Mayo has been a balanced mix of power, patience, and run production at the plate for the Baysox. Mayo sits second at the Double-A level with 21 doubles and 33 extra-base hits. The No. 8 Orioles' No. 99 overall prospect, per MLB Pipeline, has hits in 10 of 11 games, batting .350 (14-for-40) with eight extra-base hits, including last night's walk-off home run. Mayo also leads the Baysox with 36 walks, 32 RBI, a .412 OBP, and a .956 OPS. Mayo has crushed Richmond pitching particularly well in 2023, hitting .387 (12-for-31), with nine of his hits going for extra bases (six doubles, one triple, two home runs).

### COMEBACK KIDS

The Baysox already have a pair of come-from-behind victories this week. The Bowie lineup has played inspired, particularly late in games. Of the 17 runs scored this week by the Baysox, 11 of them have come when the team is trailing or the game is tied. 10 of those runs have also come in the fifth inning or later. This season, Bowie has a -22 run differential in the fifth inning or later of games, but have posted a +5 run differential this week.

### STARTING STRONG

After a couple of rocky games in Erie last week, Bowie starting pitching has found its footing again this week at Prince George's Stadium. Baysox starters have gone 19 innings over the past three games, allowing just four earned runs (1.89 ERA) on nine hits, while striking out 22 batters in the process. Bowie's 3.68 ERA from starting pitching this season is best in the Eastern League and second-best in all of Double-A.

### ON-BASE ENTOURAGE

Coby Mayo extended his on-base streak to 30 consecutive games on Friday night - the second-highest total in the Eastern League this season. Mayo is the third Baysox player to have an on-base streak of at least 29 games, alongside John Rhodes and Heston Kjerstad. The only player in the Eastern League outside of the Baysox to have a longer on-base stretch is Reading's Carlos De La Cruz, who currently has an active on-base streak of 31 games.

- Ranked as the 19th overall prospect in the Orioles' system, per MLB Pipeline, entering the 2023 season.
- Acquired by the Orioles this past July as a part of the Trey Mancini trade. Final start as an Astros farmhand was against Aberdeen, the team he would join four days later.
- Older brother Sean played in the NBA for the Memphis Grizzlies during the 2020-21 season

CAREER NOTES

- Pitched to a 6.08 ERA in Bowie across 6 starts and 26.2 innings last season. Held opponents to a .179 average but struggled with 20 walks and 7 home runs given up in a Baysox uniform.
- Made his Double-A debut for Bowie on 8/17 after making two brief appearances with High-A - his first two in the Orioles system. Surrendered 14 earned runs in his first two starts (8 IP) for Bowie, before finishing the season by allowing 4 ER in his final 4 starts (18.2 IP).
- Played two-plus seasons at Ball State. Originally drafted by the Houston Astros in the 4th round of the 2021 draft. Struck out 199 batters for Ball State in two seasons, across 139 innings. Redshirted his first season at Ball State in 2018 while recovering from Tommy John Surgery.
- Comes from a long legacy of Indiana basketball. Older brother Sean, played in the NBA for the Memphis Grizzlies during the 2020-21 season, and collegiately at Butler. Mother, Kim, played at Indiana State. Grandfather, Alan Danner, was a high school basketball coach who won two Indiana state titles, also in the Indiana Basketball Hall of Fame. Uncles, Linc and Tige, played at Purdue and Appalachian State, respectively. Uncle Linc was head men's basketball coach at D2 Florida Southern and won a national championship in 2015 - also coached Wisconsin-Green Bay and reached the March Madness tournament in 2016. Linc was Associate Head Coach at Ball State in 2022.

NOTES BY OUTING

- 4/12 Allowed a leadoff single in the first inning, but worked a double play. Allowed two doubles, but did not allow any runners to third base. After an efficient opening, 25 pitches in the fifth inning kept him from going further.
- 4/18 Labored over 21 pitches and two baserunners in the first inning, but retired eight consecutive batters into the fourth. Struck out five over four innings, but an error helped cut his fifth inning short, and a reliever allowed two inherited runners to score.
- 4/25 Relieved Houston Roth in tandem, allowed a triple to the first batter he faced, and a double to the same batter later (Tyler Fitzgerald) Both runs came from the same batter.
- 5/2 Walked first batter and allowed a home run to the second. Allowed a second home run later in the inning. 28 pitch first inning followed by six strikeouts over the next three scoreless innings.
- 5/7 Struck out the first four batters, then allowed a single and two-run home run. Did not allow any more hits while Bowie used two three-run home runs to win.
- 5/13 Worked around two two-out singles in the first inning. Allowed a two-run home run in the second, and had to escaped bases loaded in the fourth.
- 5/19 12th No-Hitter in Franchise History (Fifth Nine-Inning) Walked two of the first three batters faced, and then the first two batters of the fourth inning. Did not allow a hit. Nolan Hofman and Easton Lucas each added two perfect innings of relief.
- 5/26 For the second-consecutive start, fired five hitless innings, but walked six more batters. Collected two outs to start the sixth, but allowed a single and two-run home run. Bowie only scored one run.
- 5/31 Once again started with three hitless innings, but walked three batters. Walked a fourth batter in the fourth before allowing a single and sacrifice fly.
- 6/8 Allowed an early run through two early hits and a ground out. Only allowed one more hit over the next four innings.
- 6/11 Allowed runs in the second and third innings, both with two outs. Retired the side in the fourth.
