

LAST GAME

The Baysox took down the Richmond Flying Squirrels 3-2 on Friday night, thanks in part to a walk-off home run from Coby Mayo in the bottom of the ninth inning. Mayo's solo shot came with one-out in the ninth and completed the comeback effort for Bowie, who trailed 2-0 in the first inning after a two-run home run for Andy Thomas off Baysox right-hander Garrett Stallings. That would be the only hit and runs allowed by Stallings through five innings, as he walked five, but struck out six. Bowie's comeback charge was led by Donta' Williams, who drove in a pair of runs via a sacrifice fly in the second inning and a solo home run to lead off the fifth frame. Right-hander Peter Van Loon took the back four innings for Bowie, striking out a season-high seven with just one hit and one walk allowed. Van Loon kept Richmond off the board, leading to Mayo delivering Bowie's third walk-off win of the season.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Richmond Flying Squirrels enter today with a record of 27-34 - fifth place in the Southwest division and just a half-game ahead of the Baysox. Since entering their series in Bowie against the Baysox in late April atop the division standings, the Flying Squirrels are 14-27, having lost three of their series, while splitting the other three, and dropping five games out of first place in the process. Richmond has the third-fewest errors (42) in the Eastern League and the fewest home runs hit away from home (21) of any team in Double-A, but are going against a Baysox team with the third-most errors (57) and home runs allowed at home (58) in the league. The Flying Squirrels roster includes 10 of the Giants' top 30 prospects (via MLB Pipeline) - INF Marco Luciano (No. 2 SF/No. 18 overall), OF Vaun Brown (No. 5 SF), LHP Carson Whisenhunt (No. 8 SF), RHP Mason Black (No. 10 SF), RHP Landen Roupp (No. 13 SF), RHP Carson Seymour (No. 17 SF), RHP Randy Rodriguez (No. 25 SF), RHP Ryan Murphy (No. 26 SF), RHP Ox 29 SF), and OF Wade Meckler (No. 30 SF).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Richmond looks to start right-hander Landen Roupp tonight. The No. 13 prospect in the Giants' system, per MLB Pipeline, Roupp has only gone 19.2 innings across his seven starts and has not pitched into the fifth inning yet this season, but has allowed just four runs in that stretch, walking seven and striking out 29. Roupp last pitched this past Sunday against Altoona, where he went four frames, allowing a run on four hits, matching a season-high with seven strikeouts. A 12th round pick of the Giants in 2021 out of UNC Wilmington, Roupp features a low-mid90s fastball, an upper-70s curveball, a tight low-80s slider, and a firm mid-80s changeup.

DOUBLE THE MAYO!

INF Coby Mayo has been a balanced mix of power, patience, and run production at the plate for the Baysox. Mayo sits second at the Double-A level with 21 doubles and 33 extra-base hits. The No. 8 Orioles' No. 99 overall prospect, per MLB Pipeline, has hits in 10 of 11 games, batting .350 (14-for-40) with eight extra-base hits, including last night's walk-off home run. Mayo also leads the Baysox with 36 walks, 32 RBI, a .412 OBP, and a .956 OPS. Mayo has crushed Richmond pitching particularly well in 2023, hitting .387 (12-for-31), with nine of his hits going for extra bases (six doubles, one triple, two home runs).

COMEBACK KIDS

The Baysox already have a pair of come-from-behind victories this week. The Bowie lineup has played inspired, particularly late in games. Of the 17 runs scored this week by the Baysox, 11 of them have come when the team is trailing or the game is tied. 10 of those runs have also come in the fifth inning or later. This season, Bowie has a -22 run differential in the fifth inning or later of games, but have posted a +5 run differential this week.

STARTING STRONG

After a couple of rocky games in Erie last week, Bowie starting pitching has found its footing again this week at Prince George's Stadium. Baysox starters have gone 19 innings over the past three games, allowing just four earned runs (1.89 ERA) on nine hits, while striking out 22 batters in the process. Bowie's 3.68 ERA from starting pitching this season is best in the Eastern League and second-best in all of Double-A.

ON-BASE ENTOURAGE

Coby Mayo extended his on-base streak to 30 consecutive games on Friday night - the second-highest total in the Eastern League this season. Mayo is the third Baysox player to have an on-base streak of at least 29 games, alongside John Rhodes and Heston Kjerstad. The only player in the Eastern League outside of the Baysox to have a longer on-base stretch is Reading's Carlos De La Cruz, who currently has an active on-base streak of 31 games.

Johnson had a brief stint in the major leagues with the Los Angeles Angels back in 2018 and spent parts of nine minor league seasons across the Angels, Reds and Minnesota Twins organizations. Johnson's Japlaying career most recently landed him in independent ball this past season with the Kane County Cougars. Johnson also played two seasons collegiately at Florida State.

Pitching Coach - Forrest Herrmann

Priching Coach - Forrest Herrmann Forrest Hermann joins the Bowie Baysox coaching staff in his second season with the Orioles organization. He served as the pitch-ing coach of the Aberdeen IronBirds during the 2022 season, helping Aberdeen clinch a first-half division title and make it all the way to game three of the South Atlantic League Championship Series. Hermann guided one of the best staffs in the SAL last season, which led the league in strikeouts. Prior to joining the Orioles organization, Hermann spent two seasons as a pitching coach within the Cincinnati Reds organization, Hermann also served as a pitching strategist in 2019 for the Seattle Mariners organization at their facility in Peoria. Hermann also worked with current Orioles left-hander John Means at P3 Premier Pitching Performance center in Missouri. He pitched for three seasons at the University of Evansville prior to his coaching career.

Fundamentals Coach - Tim DeJohn

Tim DeJohn returns to the Baysox in 2023 for a second season as Fundamentals coach. However, DeJohn also received a promotion this season and will also serve as the Minor League Infield Coordinator at all levels. DeJohn has been a part of the Orioles' staff since November 2019. Prior to joining the organization, DeJohn had an extensive background in the college ranks. He served as an assistant coach at the University of Memphis between 2017 and 2019 and was an assistant at the University of Hartford the two seasons prior. DeJohn played at Western Connecticut State from 2003-2008.

Development Coach - Ryan Goll

Ryan Goll, much like pitching coach Forrest Hermann, is making a jump from High-A in 2023. Goll serves as the Baysox develo-other filling the same role for Aberdean last season. Goll has also been promoted to Offseason Camp Coordinator entering 2023. Goll first served as a Player Development Intern for the Orioles organization in 2020, before joining the minor league staff full-time n 2021. Goll attended the University of Minnesota, where he began as a bullpen catcher and Head Student Manager from 2015-2018, before moving on to be a Student Undergraduate Assistant Coach in September of 2018.
