**TODAY'S GAME:** The Memphis Redbirds take on the Gwinnett Stripers in the series finale of a six-game set on Sunday afternoon at AutoZone Park. LHP Connor Thomas makes the start against LHP Dylan Dodd. First pitch is slated for 2:05pm CDT.

**ABOUT YESTERDAY:** The Memphis Redbirds capitalized on a big seventh inning to take a 7-4 win over the Gwinnett Stripers on Friday evening at AutoZone Park. With the top of the order up in the seventh inning and the game tied at three, three Redbirds drew walks to load the bases ahead of Nolan Gorman. Gorman, who hit his first home run since returning to Triple-A in the second inning, delivered a sacrifice fly to put Memphis ahead for good. The next batter, Moises Gomez, delivered a two-run RBI single to make the score 6-3. Austin Allen followed with an RBI base hit of his own to plate the final Redbird tally. On the mound, Johan Quezada earned the win after tossing a scoreless top of the seventh inning. Reliever Genesis Cabrera earned his second save of the year, striking out the final batter of the game with the tying run on deck.

**GOIN GOMEZ:** Moises Gomez set a new Cardinals' minor league home run record in the fifth inning, slugging a two-run shot for his 38th home run of the season. With the home run, Gomez passed Tyrone Horne (1998) and Felix DeLeon (1962) to become the Cardinals' minor league single-season record holder. Gomez also ranks second in slugging percentage (.630), fifth in OPS (1.004) and seventh in total bases (262) in all of MiLB. After going 11 games from August 23-September 13 without hitting a home run, Gomez has now hit five homers in his last eight games. It's been a torrid last month for the outfielder, who has hit .250 with three doubles, five home runs and 13 RBIs in September while reaching in 16 of 18 contests.

**CLINT IN STINTS:** Clint Coulter continues to mash this season. He hit his 9th home run of the season on Friday after slugging his 8th on Wednesday. Since June 10, Coulter has hit .342 with 13 doubles, nine home runs and 29 RBIs. His .667 slugging percentage and 1.064 OPS over that span leads all Redbirds' players with at least 100 plate appearances. This year, Coulter has reached base safely in 46 of 51 games played. Coulter has seen time all over the diamond: he's made starts in left field (20), right field (4), catcher (11) and third base (5) while DHing 7 times.

**HAMMERIN' HURST:** Over his last 10 games, Scott Hurst has hit .229 with three home runs and seven RBIs while walking nine times. Since June 9, Hurst .304 batting average ranks 8th in the IL while he leads the league with a .425 OBP and ranks 3rd with a .912 OPS. In those 66 games, Hurst has slashed .304/.425/.487 with 10 doubles, a triple, 10 home runs, 32 RBIs and 44 walks to 46 strikeouts. His best month came in July when he hit .307 with six home runs, 16 RBIs and a 1.002 OPS over 19 games.

**AGAINST GWINNETT:** The Redbirds have posted an 10-16 record against Gwinnett this season, their second worst record against a club this year. The Redbirds split the opening series against Gwinnett to start the 2022 season but since have won seven of their last 20 meetings, with 13 of those games decided by two runs or less. In the 26 meetings between the two teams this year, the Stripers hold the run advantage 121-115 and have the pitching edge with a 4.44 ERA and 11 saves. Since joining the International League last season, Memphis has posted a 16-28 record against Gwinnett.

**BALDO-WHAT?:** Roberto Baldoquin recorded a season-high three hits on Thursday night. Since returning to Memphis on July 30, Baldoquin has reached in 15 of 18 games played with the Redbirds, hitting .268 with four RBIs and 10 walks. The infielder was sidelined for almost a month but has seen an increase in playing time since his return on September 10, starting in eight of the last 10 games. This September, Baldoquin is hitting .286 with a .444 OBP in nine games.

**TOMMY BOY:** Tommy Parsons' 11 wins this season are one shy of the International League lead. The last Redbird to lead the league in wins was Dakota Hudson in 2018 when he won 13 games with Memphis over 19 starts before making his MLB debut on July 28. Parsons is the eighth Memphis Redbird since 2010 to win 10 or more games, joining Hudson, Luke Weaver ('18), Nick Greenwood ('15), Tim Cooney ('14), Shelby Miller ('12), Lance Lynn ('10) and Brandon Dickson ('10). Parsons won 11 games across four levels in 2019.

**EVEN STEVEN:** On September 7, Memphis fell below .500 for the first time since May 11. Since then, Memphis has spent 17 days below the .500 mark, the longest they've been below .500 this season. At their peak, the Redbirds were 11 games over .500 on July 14, four days before the All-Star break. Since that point, the Redbirds have posted a 23-36 record, the third worst mark in the International League and the 15th worst win percentage in MiLB. The Redbirds have greatly struggled in close contests over this span, going 7-19 in games decided by two runs or less. The pitching staff has posted a 4.57 ERA (10th) with an opponent OPS of .743 (11th) and 465 strikeouts (19th) while the offense has slashed .264/.352/.417 with 61 home runs (T-12th) and 292 runs scored (11th).

**ERR, MMMHH, ERR:** The defense has struggled this month, posting an error in 11 of the 22 games played in September. Overall this season, Memphis has committed 85 errors, seventh fewest in all of MiLB. Memphis (.983 fielding percentage) trails Tacoma (.985), Nashville, Hartford, Reno, and Toledo for best fielding percentage in MiLB. Scott Hurst currently has a 58 game errorless streak, the longest errorless streak for a Redbird this season. Hurst also leads the team with seven outfield assists. Memphis outfielders have recorded 35 total outfield assists this season, tied with Redbirds catchers who have caught 35 would-be base stealers, tied 91st in MiLB.

**LEAGUE LEADERS:** Tommy Parsons earned his 11th win of the season last Tuesday against Iowa and trails Caleb Boushley for most wins in the International League. His .200 batting average against ranks best in the league, while his 1.16 WHIP is 3rd best and his 4.27 ERA is 9th best among qualified pitchers. Zach McAllister's 55 relief appearances are T-3rd in the league. Connor Thomas is currently 10th with 129.1 innings pitched, the most in his career. With seven strikeouts on Thursday night, Matthew Liberatore now has 110 on the season which ranks 9th in the IL. Offensively, Luken Baker's 21 home runs are 9th most while Kramer Robertson ranks 3rd with 82 walks this season, the most in his career. Alec Burleson's .331 batting average ranks best in the league; if that holds through the end of the season, it will be the first time a Redbird has won a league batting title in franchise history.

**MINOR LEAGUE LEADERS:** Alec Burleson's .331 batting average ranks 5th overall in the minors. On the pitching side, Zach McAllister's 55 appearances are T-5th most, while Zach Lee (Albuquerque, Triple-A) leads with 63 games. Kyle Leahy currently ranks 8th with 144.2 innings pitched.

**FALL BALL:** Last week, the St. Louis Cardinals announced eight prospects that will participate in the Arizona Fall League this year. LHP Connor Thomas, who has thrown a career-high in innings pitched this season, RHP Ryan Loutos and C Pedro Pages are the three members of the Redbirds heading to Phoenix at season's end. Springfield's hitting coach Tyger Pederson will represent the organization on the coaching staff. RHP Kyle Leahy, recently promoted to Memphis, will also participate in the fall league. OF Jordan Walker, SS Masyn Winn, RHP Tink Hence and OF Mike Antico are the remaining prospects headed to the AFL.

**FRESH TOP-30:** MLB Pipeline released its brand-new top-30 prospects for each organization last week and the Memphis roster continues to be loaded with top prospects. In the St. Louis Cardinals organization, Memphis rosters three of the top-10 and eight of the St. Louis top-30. LHP Matthew Liberatore (4), OF Alec Burleson (5) and C Ivan Herrera (7) find spots in the top-10 while RHP Jake Walsh (21), RHP Freddy Pacheco (22), LHP Connor Thomas (24), RHP Ryan Loutos (26) and OF Moises Gomez (30) round out the list. In the top-100, Liberatore (85) and Burleson (93) represent Memphis overall.

**DINGERS:** Nolan Gorman added his 16th home run at Triple-A on Saturday afternoon. The Redbirds' season home run total has improved to 193, the second most in the International League. The Redbirds are chasing their 2019 mark of 200 home runs, which set a franchise record. Memphis trails Albuquerque (232), El Paso (218), Tacoma (214), Sacramento (209), Durham (206), Sugar Land (206), Somerset (205), and Tulsa (196) for most home runs in the minor leagues. Out of the 193 homers, 99 have been solo shots, 57 have been two-run homers, 32 have been three-run jacks and three have been grand slams. The Redbirds became the first professional baseball team to hit 50 home runs in 2022, doing so in 26 games. They also became the fastest team to hit 100 home runs, accomplishing the feat in 60 games. The Redbirds also homered in 17-straight games from 5/21-6/9 in which they hit 33 home runs. Memphis hit 47 home runs in April, falling short of the franchise record 54 homers in a month (August 2019). Overall, Memphis has hit a home run in 103 of 146 games this year.

## MANAGER BEN JOHNSON

**Ben Johnson** enters his fourth season as manager of the Memphis Redbirds and his fourth year in the Cardinals organization.

- Oversaw a franchise record 15-game winning streak in 2021 (7/9-7/25); tied for longest in MiLB that season
- Oversaw a franchise record 200 home runs in 2019; team won 29 of final 40 games and were in contention for division until 2nd to last day of the season
- Spent 2018 as third base coach for the Durham Bulls (Rays' Triple-A)
- Spent 2014-2017 as a scout in the Arizona Diamondbacks organization
- Coached at Millenium HS in Goodyear, AZ from 2011-2013
- Previously managed Arizona Centennials in the Independent League in 2012

### PLAYING CAREER

- Drafted by the Cardinals in the 4th Rd. of 1999 Draft; traded to Padres in 2000
- Made MLB debut on June 26, 2005 with the Padres; played 98 games over next three seasons with the Padres and Mets
- Named Padres Minor League Player of the Year in 2005 when he hit a career-high .312 with 25 home runs and 83 RBIs as a member of the Portland Beavers

## PITCHING COACH DERNIER OROZCO

**Dernier Orozco** enters his fifth season as pitching coach for Memphis and his 17th season in the Cardinals organization, serving at five different levels.

- Led 2018 Redbirds staff to a 3.54 ERA, 1.28 WHIP and 44 saves which paced the Pacific Coast League; Dakota Hudson won PCL Pitcher of the Year and Cardinals Minor League Pitcher of the Year
- Spent 2015-17 as pitching coach for Peoria; 2014 with State College
- Coached in the Venezuelan Summer League from 2006-08

### PLAYING CAREER

- Played in six pro seasons in the Red Sox organization
- Final season was 2003 in the Gulf Coast League; went 4-2 in 14 games

**Brandon Allen** enters his third season as hitting coach for Memphis and his sixth year in the Cardinals organization.

**TODAY'S START:** Connor Thomas is scheduled to start the finale of the series against the Gwinnett Stripers on Tuesday night.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Thomas allowed a season high four walks across three-plus innings of work on Tuesday night against the Gwinnett Stripers. The left-handed pitcher has now lost six consecutive decisions and eight of his last nine. His last win came in a complete-game shutout of Indianapolis on 8/11.

**BALL IN PLAY:** Thomas embraces contact on the mound. Among qualified pitchers in the International League according to Fangraphs, the lefty currently ranks 4th with a 50.6% ground-ball rate and has the highest BABIP against at .353 among qualified pitchers (MLB average is .291 in 2022).

**AMONG THE LEADERS:** Thomas currently has the 7th lowest walks per 9 innings mark at 2.64 and is 6th fewest walks allowed (38). His 2.05 ground ball to fly ball rate is also third highest in the IL.

**2021:** Thomas had an outstanding campaign with the Redbirds last season, posting a 3.10 ERA that ranked second-best in Triple-A East among pitchers with 100 IPs. The left-hander made four starts in Double-A Springfield before he was promoted to Memphis in late May. In total, Thomas struck out 116 batters and walked just 33 in 122 innings pitched, which ranked second among Cardinals farm hands.

**TO START OR TO RELIEVE?:** Thomas started his professional career in a relief role, making 18 appearances out of the pen. After the pandemic year, Thomas started four games with Springfield and was promoted to Triple-A, where he initially bounced between the rotation and bullpen. The southpaw finally settled back into a starting role, where he posted a 3-3 record and a 2.75 ERA in 14 starts with Memphis. As a reliever in eight appearances, Thomas went 3-1 with a 4.10 ERA.

**THEY SAID IT:** On his style: "I'm absolutely a groundball pitcher. I think I was top-5 in the minors last year in groundball rate [60.5% GB rate ranked 2nd among 155 MiLBers w/ 100 IPs]. I really just go after them, throw it after them. My stuff moves enough..." On learning at each level: "... when I first got drafted, the M.O. from all of these guys was to throw strikes and be competitive with every pitch. I took that with me, and then AA, it was competing and making sure you weren't falling behind counts- trying to always be in plus counts, like 0-1, 0-2. And then AAA, it was OK, we're facing major league caliber hitters. How do we sequence, when do we throw each pitch, what not to throw in different counts. Really learning how to pitch and how to be a professional..." On what he is working on: "I would say two-seam command, in general. Last year I struggled when I would get tired, I would lose the feel for it..."

**GET TO KNOW 'EM:** Drafted by the Cardinals in the 5th round of the 2019 Draft out of Georgia Tech... Set school record with 1.55 BB/9 over his career and did not walk more than two batters in any of his 2019 starts... Made first college pitching appearance at Truist Park in Atlanta against Georgia.
