HAPPY PRIDE NIGHT: After dropping two games in a row to Kannapolis, the FredNats aim to get even in the series tonight on the franchise's first Pride Night at the ballpark. It's also a Copa night, so the FredNats will become the Fundadores de Fredericksburg for the third time this year tonight. RHP Yoel Tejeda Jr. starts on the mound for Fredericksburg, and he has been a revelation for the FredNats in his first professional season after a 14th round selection last summer out of Florida State. Among qualified Carolina League pitchers, Tejeda has the eighth-best ERA (3.65) and seventh-best WHIP (1.24).

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Kannapolis won its second game in a row after breaking an 11-game losing streak on Wednesday, beating the FredNats 7-3 in 11 innings. The FredNats had multiple chances to win the game in both the 9th and 10th innings and couldn't find a way to do it, mustering just four hits in 11 offensive innings. Davian Garcia did not allow a hit in five innings pitched, and the FredNat bullpen covered six innings, allowing just three earned runs out of the seven allowed. Fredericksburg made three errors defensively.

CANADIAN CONTRIBUTIONS: Ontario, Canada natives Nate Ochoa and Francesco Barbieri have majorly contributed to the FredNat offense in the last week. Ochoa has eight RBIs in his last four games which is tied for the most in all of Single-A baseball, and Barbieri in that same time frame has three hits, four RBIs, four walks, and he's tied for second in Single-A with four stolen bases. Ochoa and Barbieri both played for the same travel baseball organization in Canada - the Fieldhouse Pirates.

THIS BULLPEN IS INSANE: The FredNat bullpen has been central to the team's efforts all season, but the group has taken it to a new level in the month of June. FBG's bullpen ERA this month is 2.33, which is number two in all of Minor League Baseball (120 total teams) behind Pittsburgh's Double-A affiliate Altoona (1.99). Fredericksburg's eight saves this month is tied for the third-most in MiLB as well.

DON'T EVEN TRY IT: The FredNat catching duo of Kevin Bazzell and Nate Rombach has been prolific at throwing out potential base stealers this season. As a team, Fredericksburg's 56 caught stealings is tied for the MiLB lead with Fayetteville. Among the top four teams in that stat category, Fredericksburg has allowed 42 fewer total stolen bases than the next team. Last night, Bazzell took the lead among qualified MiLB catchers with 35 caught stealings and owns the best CS% of all MiLB catchers who have played at least 300 innings this year, throwing out 40% of would-be base stealers. Rombach has 21 caught stealings himself, a top-10 mark in the Carolina League, and is throwing out 32% of potential base stealers this year.

SECOND HALF FREDDIES: The FredNats have won the second half title in the North two out of the last three seasons, including last year's Carolina League championship season. Including last night's game, Fredericksburg is 119-81 (.598) in the second half, and those 119 wins are the second most in that time frame (since '22) in Single-A and High-A behind Charleston (126).

THREE BALL: The FredNats turned the second triple play in Fredericksburg franchise history Friday night at Salem. Randal Diaz, Carlos Tavares and Luke Dickerson went 4-3-6 to turn it. The franchise's first triple play was also at Salem on May 26, 2023.

NEW OWNERSHIP: On Monday, June 9, it was announced that the Silber family sold the majority stake in the Fredericksburg Nationals to Diamond Baseball Holdings (DBH), becoming the 44th MiLB team DBH has purchased since its founding in 2021. The FredNats will remain the Nationals' Single-A affiliate in the Carolina League. Seth Silber has kept a minority ownership stake and will take on the President/CEO role overseeing day-to-day operations moving forward, and DBH has retained the entire front office staff.

THE STAFF: After Jake Lowery's third season as Manager of the FredNats ended in a Carolina League championship in 2024, the FredNats welcome Billy McMillon as the third Manager in Fredericksburg franchise history. McMillon, 53, has spent the last three seasons in the Nationals organization as the Development Coach for Triple-A Rochester. He also played parts of six seasons in the Major Leagues with Oakland, Detroit, Philadelphia and Florida. He's joined on the staff by returning Pitching Coach Justin Lord, returning Hitting Coach Mike Habas, Development Coach Luis Ordaz, returning Athletic Trainer Jacob Meyer, Strength & Conditioning Coach Mike Reiskind, and Performance Analyst Samantha Unger.

A LASTING LEGACY: The Fredericksburg Nationals adopt the franchise history of their predecessors in the Carolina League dating back to 1978...the Alexandria Dukes (1978, 1980-83) and Alexandria Mariners (1979) played at Four Mile Run Park in Alexandria, Virginia...the Prince William Pirates (1984-1986), Prince William Yankees (1987-1988), Prince William Cannons (1989-1998), Potomac Cannons (1999-2004) and Potomac Nationals (2005-2019) played at G. Richard Pfitzner Stadium in Woodbridge, Virginia...the franchise has won six Carolina League championships, as the Dukes in 1982, as the Yankees in 1989, and as the Nationals in 2008, 2010 and 2014. The franchise won its first league title as the Fredericksburg Nationals in 2024, defeating the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers two games to one to win the title at Virginia Credit Union Stadium.

LAST TIME OUT: Yoel Tejeda Jr (Pronounced: Yo-ell Tay-hay-duh) starred in his last start, striking out a career high eight in five one-run innings on the road at Salem. He lowered his ERA to 3.65, the eighth-best mark in the Carolina League.

MAY I?: Tejeda was named the FredNats Pitcher of the Month for May by Nationals Player Development after posting a 3.28 ERA across his five starts in the month. He struck out 24 hitters in 24.2 IP.

EXECUTIVE DECISION: Tejeda has recently been working on his mental game with a sports psychologist, developing the mindset to be an "executioner" on the mound, attacking hitters without any fear.

ON FLORIDA TIME: Tejeda pitched for two different Florida schools at the collegiate level. The righthander had a 5.56 ERA in 22.2 IP as a primary starter for Florida in 2023 and a 5.95 ERA in 19.2 IP as a reliever for Florida State in 2024 after transferring.

TOP SHELF: At 6-foot-8, Tejeda is tied with Jackson Rutledge ('21, '22) as the tallest player to ever play for the FredNats.

BROKE OUT: Tejeda got an offseason opportunity to pitch in the Nationals' Spring Breakout prospect game against the Mets. In his first professional outing, the righty fired two scoreless innings.

COSTUME AND CAPE: Tejeda played in the historic Cape Cod League for the Wareham Gatemen last summer, putting up 4.76 ERA in 11.1 IP with 16 K's.

BILLY MCMILLON - MANAGER

1st Season | Previously: Development Coach, Triple-A Rochester

McMillon, 53, joined Washington in 2022 and has spent the last three seasons as the Development Coach for Triple-A Rochester. McMillon played parts of six Major League seasons with four different organizations, including the Oakland Athletics (2001-04), Detroit Tigers (2000-01), Philadelphia Phillies (1997), and Florida Marlins (1996-97). The former Clemson Tiger was a three-time International League All-Star and the 1996 IL Rookie of the Year with Charlotte, earning him induction into the IL Hall of Fame in 2019 and Charlotte's Round Table of Honor in 2022. McMillon was initially selected in the eighth round of the 1993 MLB Draft by Florida. He replaces Jake Lowery, who managed the FredNats the last three seasons, culminating in a championship last year. Lowery will manage High-A Wilmington in 2025.

Prior to joining Washington, McMillon coached in the Boston Red Sox organization for over a decade. He managed the Worcester Red Sox (Triple-A) in their inaugural season in 2021 after managing Boston's former Triple-A affiliate Pawtucket in 2019. He was set to lead the PawSox again in 2020 before the cancellation of the MiLB season. Prior to managing at the Triple-A level, McMillon was the Minor League Outfield and Baserunning Coordinator for Boston from 2016-18 after managing for six seasons in the organization with Double-A Portland (2014-15), High-A Salem (2012-13), and Single-A Greenville (2010-11). His coaching career began in 2008 when he was Greenville's Hitting Coach.



JUSTIN LORD - PITCHING COACH

3rd Season | Previously: Pitching Coach, Double-A Harrisburg

Lord, 45, returns to Fredericksburg for a third season in 2025 after leading the FredNats' championship pitching staff last season, including the 2024 Carolina League Pitcher of the Year Travis Sykora.

This is Lord's fifth total season coaching in the Washington organization after a six-year professional playing career and several seasons coaching in the Baltimore system. The Alabama native and Florida State alum was scheduled to be the Fredericksburg Pitching Coach in the canceled 2020 season, and was the Pitching Coach for one season in Double-A Harrisburg prior to joining the FredNats in 2023.



MIKE HABAS - HITTING COACH

2nd Season | Previously: Hitting Coach, ACL Brewers

Habas, 34, returns to Fredericksburg from the 2024 championship staff for his second season with Washington after leading the FredNat offense to a highly successful season, finishing in the top third of the league in virtually every meaningful offensive category.

Prior to joining the Nationals, he spent spending the previous four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization, most recently as the Hitting Coach for the ACL Brewers in 2022 and 2023. Prior to joining Milwaukee, he was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats. While coaching with Gary, he was also the Head Coach at Prairie State College, a Junior College in the Chicago area.



LUIS ORDAZ - DEVELOPMENT COACH

1st Season | Previously: Manager, FCL Nationals

Ordaz, 49, joins the FredNat coaching staff in the Development Coach role after managing the Florida Complex League Nationals in 2024.

He played parts of seven seasons in the Major Leagues, appearing in 206 career games with the St. Louis Cardinals, Kansas City Royals and Tampa Bay Devil Rays. Ordaz has coached in the Washington organization for over a decade, and was the Hitting Coach for the Potomac Nationals for four seasons from 2016-19. He replaces Carmelo Jaime, who will manage the FCL Nationals in 2025 after three seasons in Fredericksburg.
