**About the Last One:** Bowie split Saturday's doubleheader with Richmond in dramatic fashion, as the Baysox rallied from being down 9-5 in the bottom of the seventh of game one to win 10-9. **Patrick Dorrian's** two-RBI double gave Bowie their fourth walk-off win of the season. In game two, Bowie only mustered two hits, one of them being a **Johnny Rizer** solo home run, as Richmond went on to win 10-1.

**Adley Promoted:** Recently named the No. 1 overall prospect in baseball, **Adley Rutschman** has been promoted to the Triple-A Norfolk Tides. He played in 80 of Bowie's 82 games, and hit .271 for the Baysox with 18 home runs.

**Playoff Push:** The top two teams in the Double-A Northeast League by winning percentage, regardless of division will compete in a Best-of-5 playoff series beginning the Tuesday after the regular season concludes. With 32 games remaining in the season after today, Bowie sits 0.5 games out of the second playoff spot. Currently, the top two teams are the Akron RubberDucks and the Somerset Patriots.

**Gray's Day:** Making his first appearance since August 3rd will be Bowie right-hander **Gray Fenter**. This will be his fifth appearance of the season against the Flying Squirrels. In his previous four, he has allowed ten total runs, and the Flying Squirrels are hitting .222 against him. For more information on Fenter, see page two.

**In the Other Corner:** Making his second start of the series and his fourth appearance of the year against the Baysox will be righty **Trenton Toplikar**. On Tuesday, Toplikar threw six innings and allowed two runs on five hits with a walk and five strikeouts in a 6-2 Richmond win. It was just his second win of the season. On the year, the Baysox are hitting .275 against him.

**This Day in Baysox History:** In 2014, current Bowie manager Buck Britton went 2-4 with a home run as the Baysox narrowly defeated Erie 5-4.
