The Frisco RoughRiders bested the Midland RockHounds 2-1 on Wednesday night from Riders Field. RoughRiders starter **Kohl Drake** (2-2) earned the victory, spinning 5.1 innings while allowing just one unearned run and whiffing seven batters. Frisco (23-17) manufactured two runs on a pair of two-out hits. **Theo Hardy** splintered an RBI single in the bottom of the first and Luis Mieses pounded an RBI double in the bottom of the fourth to garner a 2-0 lead. Midland (24-17) then countered in the top of the sixth when Henry Bolte plated Junior Perez on a fielding error, trimming the Riders lead to 2-1. Frisco reliever **Gavin Collye**r proceeded to retire the side and finish with 1.2 scoreless innings. In the top of the ninth, RoughRiders closer **Skylar Hales** issued a lead-off walk to Colby Halter. Hales then recorded two strikeouts and a game-ending popout to notch his second save of the year. RockHounds starter Kade Morris (1-3) took the loss despite earning his fourth quality start, allowing two runs across six innings.

KNOCK THAT STARTER OUT ASAP:

The RoughRiders have been much better against the bullpen on offense than they have been against starting pitchers. Against starters, the RoughRiders are slashing .242/.317/.383/.700 with the second-fewest RBIs in the league (68). When the Riders face opposing bullpens, they are hitting .252/.348/.387/.735 with a league-best 111 RBIs and 20 HR (T2nd).

SWINGING IT:

Over the last seven games, the Riders are averaging 6.1 runs per game, better than their season average of 5.1. Over this span, the Riders are slashing .261/.351/.437/.788 with 10 home runs. **Abimelec Ortiz** and **Sebastian Walcott** both hit three home runs last weak the Riders.

RISP-ECT THIS:

The RoughRiders overall are hitting .234 with runners in scoring position, but have struggled over their last 23 games. In that stretch, the Riders are just 11-12, batting .182 (36-for-197)/.262/.288/.550 with RISP. Their .182 batting average is last in the Texas League and 29th among 30 Double-A teams

ABIM-ELECTRIC ORTIZ:

Abimelec Ortiz has been on fire at the plate for the Riders. While having reached in his last 11 games, Ortiz is hitting .395 (17-for-43)/.490/.698/1.188 with four doubles, three home runs and 13 RBIs. Last Wednesday, he clubbed the first walk-off grand slam in franchise history while driving in six runs. His six RBIs were the most in a game since 2022 (Josh Stowers). On Friday, he hammered a game-tying home run in the bottom of the ninth before the Riders eventually won 6-5 in 11 innings on a Josh Hatcher RBI single. He is eighth in the Texas League in May average (.328), third in RBIs (16), tied for third in home runs (four) and third in OPS (1.021). For his efforts and three home runs, Ortiz was named Texas League Player of the Week.

MAY FLOWERS AND HOMERS:

The RoughRiders have both hit and given up their fair share of long balls this month. They have hit 14 this month, which is eighth in the league and have allowed 21, which is the most. Frisco's 4.54 ERA is fourth in the league during the month while they are just 9-8 in May.

DOUBLE-A DOUBL-A RON:

Aaron Zavala has been on fire at the plate for the Riders. After a dreadful start, batting just .077 (2-for-26) through 10 games, he is hitting .315 (23-for-73)/.463/.521/.984 over his last 22 games. He leads the Texas League in walks (34) and is second in OBP (.438) while leading the league in walk rate (24.8 percent), a mark which also ranks 2nd in Minor League Baseball (min. 130 PA). He is currently on an 14-game on-base streak, batting .367 (18-for-49)/.516/.551/1.067 with 15 runs scored, a double, a triple, two home runs, 11 RBIs and 15 walks. During the streak, he has reached multiple times in 11 of the 14 games. In May, he is hitting .340/.485/.509/.994, ranking sixth in average and seventh in OPS in the Texas League.

HOUND HUNTING:

The Riders struggled against the Midland RockHounds a season ago. On top of being knocked out the postseason by Midland last year, they went just 6-12 during the regular season against the A's affiliate. Frisco was held to a .219/.291/.305/.596 slashline against the RockHounds. Since 2015, the Riders have had just one winning season against Midland, going 97-126 (.434) against the A's affiliate.

BRATT SUMMER IS BACK:

Mitch Bratt has been one of the stronger arms for Frisco to start the year. Through his first seven starts, his 2.21 ERA is second in the Texas League. His 4.1 percent walk rate is the best in the Texas League while 7.83 K/BB is also first.
