THIS IS FUN: After winning a season-best eight games in a row, the FredNats have the opportunity tonight to win their 10th game out of 12 in this stretch with no off days in the series finale with the Delmarva Shorebirds, Single-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. The FredNats have had the Shorebirds' number this year in the Carolina League's version of the Beltway Series, winning 13 out of 14 matchups this year. Tonight, RHP Bryan Polanco starts for the third time in this 12-game stretch after taking a perfect game into the 7th inning last time out in Salem. He's tied for the team lead in wins, and he just finished up the month of June with a 1.71 ERA in five starts. Polanco faces Trey Gibson, who has already been beaten by the FredNats in this series.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Travis Sthele earned his second straight win, allowing just four base runners in five scoreless innings against the Shorebirds to continue the recent dominant stretch for FredNat starting pitching. Nate Rombach hit his first FredNat homer, and FXBG led 4-0 in the 7th before ultimately pulling away late for a 7-4 victory. The 2, 3 and 4 hitters in the FredNat lineup combined for six hits and two RBIs, and Sammy Vasquez picked up his fifth save of the season.

UTTER DOMINATION: The FredNats have totally and completely dominated the season series with the Delmarva Shorebirds through the first 13 matchups. Fredericksburg is 13-1 against Delmarva, outscoring the Shorebirds 88-36. FredNat pitching has a 2.15 ERA this year against the 'Birds as well. FXBG has been nearly perfect on the base paths in the season series as well, going 41-for-45 stealing bases against Delmarva. Brandon Pimentel has 18 RBIs this year against the Shorebirds as well, hitting .320 with an .831 OPS.

LEADING OFF FOR AMERICA: John McHenry's leadoff homer on the 4th of July was the first time all season the FredNats got a leadoff bomb, and his multi-homer game was the second of the year for FXBG, the first one coming less than a week ago during this current winning streak last Saturday in Salem. On the 4th of July last year in Delmarva, McHenry drove in the go-ahead run in the 8th inning.

DOMINANT ARMS: After heavily relying on the bullpen for the first two months of the season, the FredNat starting rotation has majorly improved over the last three series. Since June 11, FredNat starters have logged 107 2/3 innings and allowed just 19 earned runs for a group ERA of 1.67. In the three weeks prior to that, the starting rotation's ERA was 5.70. In this series alone, FredNat starting pitching has allowed just six hits and two runs in 24 innings against Delmarva.

THIRTY SIX AND 0H: The FredNats remain perfect when leading after seven innings this season, with last night's win getting them to 36-0 when leading after seven, and also a perfect 38-0 when leading after eight innings. The winning formula all season has been the offense taking a lead in the middle innings, and the bullpen holding onto that lead each time.

OH SYKORA: After making his professional debut on May 1 with Fredericksburg, 2023 Nationals third round pick Travis Sykora has taken the Carolina League by storm in the first two months of his professional career. Including last night, he's pitched five complete innings in each of his last four starts, and has allowed just four runs in that time frame with 33 strikeouts and seven walks, and he set his new careerhigh with nine punchouts in last night's start.

FORMULA FOR SUCCESS: The FredNats are 35-5 this season when scoring first, including 31 out of the last 32 wins. FXBG did not score first in any of its losses the last two weeks, but did score first in each of the four wins last week in Salem, plus every game of this series so far.

THE SKIP IS BACK: The FredNats' leader from the last two seasons returns to the Managerial role for 2024. Jake Lowery is back for another year in the 'Burg. Lowery, 34, was selected by Cleveland in the fourth round of the 2011 Draft out of James Madison University, where he was given the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher. The Midlothian, Virginia native played in the Nationals organization from 2016 to 2019, including parts of two seasons with the Potomac Nationals. Lowery reached the Iriple-A level in 2018 and transitioned to a managerial role in 2021 after nine seasons in the minor leagues. Lowery is the 28th manager in franchise history dating back to 1978. Lowery is 187-154 in his two-plus years as Manager in Fredericksburg, including the 2022 Carolina League playoffs.

THE STAFF: The majority of the 2023 coaching staff returns for 2024, with the lone exception being Hitting Coach Mike Habas. Pitching Coach Justin Lord, Development Coach Carmelo Jaime, Performance Analyst Josh Freligh, Strength & Conditioning Nathan Sier and Athletic Trainer Jake Meyer are all back from last year's staff. Lord, 44, will begin his fourth season coaching in the Washington organization. The Florida State alum pitched six seasons professionally before transitioning to coaching, spending time in the Baltimore organization prior to joining the Nationals.

Habas, 33, begins his first season in the Washington organization after spending the last four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization. He was the hitting coach for the ACL Brewers the last two seasons, and was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats and Head Coach at Prarie State Junior College prior to his time with Milwaukee. Jaime, 38, was Detroit's 24th round selection in the 2008 Draft out of Miami Dade College. The Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic native reached Double-A in his three-year minor league career, and has served as the first base coach and infield coach with the FredNats the past two seasons, roles he will continue in 2024. Meyer is in his seventh year with the Nationals overall and second with the FredNats, he spent his first five years at the facility in West Palm Beach, FL. Sier is in his second year with FXBG after previous stops with 2SP Sports and Macomb Community College (MI).

TODAY'S START: Bryan Polanco is set to make his 10th start of the season, this afternoon against the Delmarva Shorebirds. Polanco made a spot start at the end of April against Delmarva, and his since taken over a starting role after the promotion of Jose Atencio.

NOTHING NEW: While Polanco had been primarily a relief arm with Fredericksburg this year, starting games is a role he's more than familiar with. In his MiLB career, 17 of Bryan's 33 career appearances have been as a starting pitcher. In 2022 and '23 in particular, he started 16 games compared to just six relief appearances.

Further simplifying the transtition, Polanco has served as the "bridge guy" out of the FredNat bullpen this year, capable of handling longer outings. Of his five relief appearances, Polanco has worked three innings once, 4+ innings three times, and even logged a five inning relief outing on 5/1 vs Down East.

ROAD TO THE FREDDIES: Polanco began his professional career with a rough debut in the DSL in 2021, but he returned in '22 and cut his ERA in half (7.04 to 3.51) while striking out 49 hitters in 41.0 IP. He jumped to the FCL and faced some struggles, but joined the FredNats late in 2023 for a pair of starts.

LAST TIME OUT: Polanco retired the first 17 men he faced against Salem last week, the longest no-hit bid by a single FredNat this season. The Sox registered just one hit, while Polanco racked up seven strikeouts.
