- Things started promising for Dunedin on Saturday night, but the Hammerheads finished on top with a 5-1 victory.
- Tucker Toman put the Blue Jays on the board in the first inning, turning a 95-mile-per-hour fastball on the inside corner into a solo homer down the right-field line against Marlins No. 1 prospect Noble Meyer.
- After a scoreless first from Dunedin starter Lazaro Estrada, Jupiter tied the game at one with a double steal that allowed Yeral Martinez to score from third.
- Jupiter took the lead in the third, on a throwing error by new pitcher Jerry Huntzinger that allowed Brock Vradenburg to score from second base
- Still trailing 2-1 in the seventh, the Jays put men on second and third with one out but failed to score.
- Jupiter put the game out of reach with a three-run eighth inning, scoring on two wild pitches and a Tony Bullard RBI single.

#### SLLLLLLIDING

After ripping off six consecutive victories from April 6 through April 12, the Blue Jays have dropped eight straight, dating back to last Friday vs Clearwater. These streaks mark the first instance of Dunedin having a win streak and losing streak longer than five games in the same month since July 2019, when a 10-game win streak was immediately followed by a five game losing streak. The losing skid is the Blue Jays' longest since a nine-game slide from July 5 through July 18, 2023.

#### **OFFENSIVE OUTAGE**

Dunedin's offense has sputtered across its eight game losing streak, scoring just 18 runs (2.2 per game) while batting .190 with an OBP of .288. In the eight games prior to the losing streak, the Jays tallied 57 runs (7.1 per game).

#### **DEATH BY PAPERCUTS**

Last night's 5-1 defeat marked the largest margin of defeat in Dunedin's eight game losing streak. Each of the prior seven games were decided by three or fewer runs.

#### MANUEL THE MAGNET

Manuel Beltre's hit by pitch last night pushed his tally to five on the season - good for the team lead and second in the Florida State League (behind St. Lucie's Christopher Suero with six). As a team, Dunedin's 21 HBPs are tied for second in the FSL.

#### **POWER SURGE**

Tucker Toman has belted three homers in 16 games played in 2024. In 2024, Toman homered just five times in 114 games. Despite a .176 batting average, Toman has hit the ball hard consistently, boasting a 48.1% hard hit rate (percentage of balls hit 95 MPH or harder). The mark ranks second in the FSL among players with more than 30 plate appearances.

### FREE PASSES GIVETH, FREE PASSES TAKETH AWAY

While Dunedin has racked up 103 walks at the plate (5.1 per game), ranking second in the Florida State League, the team has struggled with command on the mound, issuing 108 walks (5.4 per game), tied for first in the FSL.

### FIRST 10 VS LAST 10

Through the first 20 games of the season, Dunedin has seen noticeably different results between the first 10 games (8-2 record) and the last 10 games (1-9). Through the first 10 games, the Jays hit to a team OPS of .743 with 9 homers. In the last 10 games, Dunedin's team OPS is .538 with 2 homers. The Blue Jays' 8-2 start was the team's best 10-game start since 2014.

### REHAB CITY, USA

With his start last Saturday, Lazaro Estrada became the sixth player to make a rehab appearance with Dunedin this season. MLB rehabbers Alek Manoah and Erik Swanson both pitched on April 7 against Lakeland.

#### YOUNG GUN

Dunedin shortstop Arjun Nimmala is the second-youngest player in the Florida State league to open the season, at 18.5 years old (behind Daytona's Alfredo Duno at 18.2). Maykel Minoso joins Nimmala as the second 18 year old on the Blue Jays' roster.

#### COMING UP THE PIPELINE

The D-Jays Opening Day roster is loaded with eight of the Blue Jays' top-30 prospects, according to MLB Pipeline. The 30-man roster includes the Jays' last two first round draft picks; LHP Brandon Barriera (2022) and Infielder Arjun Nimmala (2023). Nimmala is ranked as the third-best prospect in the system, while Barriera is ranked fourth. Opening Day starter Fernando Perez is Pipeline's No. 24 Blue Jays prospect, after leading the FCL Blue Jays in innings pitched in 2023.
